FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS • VOL. 6

CAMPAIGN DETAILS

Can you clarify the goals of the campaign and the project costs?

Yes. Our ultimate goal is to raise \$15 million – which is the total estimated cost of construction for the new gathering space, pastoral center and landscaping.

HERE ARE HOW THE GOALS BREAK DOWN:

\$ 4 million	Allocated from parish savings (\$736,921 from the 2000 campaign + just over \$3 million from savings)
+ \$ 8 million	Our initial campaign goal for the <i>Expanding to Love and Serve</i> Capital Campaign
\$12 million	TOTAL NEEDED TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION
\$12 million	
+ \$ 3 million	Potential loan to meet costs
\$15 million	TOTAL PROJECT COSTS

The parish's current cash flow projections show that we will be able to service any financing of up to \$3 million. Thus, our goal to begin construction will be to raise at least \$8 million from parishioners donating to this campaign.

How did the parish come up with the ask amounts?

Ask amounts are determined based on historical offertory giving, what you may have indicated in the planning study and a confidential review with Fr. Brendan. This is an extraordinary campaign in the history of the parish and to accomplish our goals requires extraordinary gifts. More than anything, our hope is that you will give a gift that is sacrificial and meaningful for you. Only you know what that amount is.

Can I make a gift using my IRA Required Minimum Distribution?

Yes! Retirees can give up to \$100,000 to charity, including this campaign, tax-free from an IRA and have it count as their required minimum distribution for the year. Here's what you need to know. RMD is a great option to give if you are 70 ½ or older; it decreases your income tax burden from your IRA. If you make a tax-free transfer from your IRA to charity, you can't also deduct that money as a charitable contribution. But the tax-free transfer could give you extra benefits. You don't need to itemize your deductions to get a tax benefit from the gift (and many people who no longer have a mortgage don't itemize their deductions). Making the tax-free transfer also keeps the money out of your adjusted gross income.

Will there be any commemoration of the current buildings before demolition?

Yes. The parish will have a ceremony prior to demolition that honors the past and commemorates the buildings and traditions that have helped shape St. Edward. This will likely occur in Spring 2019.

Will the donated funds for this project be accessible by the diocese for any purpose or be available by any future pastors to go to any other purposes?

No. Funds raised are held in a separate restricted bank account that has no connection to the diocese. They are not co-mingled with any other funds at the parish. Campaign funds are held in a separate custodial account that belongs to campaign purposes alone. The reorganization of the Diocese of Orange following recent lawsuits in the wake of the sexual abuse crisis separated parishes into distinct legal entities. Among other protections, one of the results is that funds are not available to the diocese for any purpose. The parish's 2018 PSA obligation will come from campaign funds and be sent to the Orange Catholic Foundation to support the many ministries of our diocese. That amount is \$245,000. All other funds raised will go toward the stated goals of the campaign. Our Finance Council has advisory oversight of any funds. What is the best way to give?

Any way you choose to give for your situation, the parish will be flexible and work with you. For ease of processing donations, we encourage parishioners to give through your WeShare (formerly Parish Pay) account.
