Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

On the first and third Monday of the month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration at San Felipe de Jesus Chapel on the first Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Muchas gracias a todos los que ayudaron, en sus diversos ministerios, con las liturgias; Y gracias a usted por estar aquí para celebrar con nosotros. El domingo después de Navidad celebramos la fiesta de la Sagrada Familia de Jesús, María y José. Esta fiesta centra nuestra atención en el hecho de que el Hijo de Dios vino a la tierra en el contexto de la vida familiar. De hecho, vivió la mayoría de sus años en el contexto inmediato de su familia. Esto nos muestra cuán importante, realmente esencial, es la vida familiar en la mente de Dios.



Todos nosotros estamos familiarizados con las alegrías y, a veces, con los desafíos de la vida familiar. Nuestra segunda lectura de hoy nos da una buena lista de las cualidades o virtudes que nos ayudan a disfrutar de lo que es agradable y soportar lo que es desagradable en la vida familiar. San Pablo escribe: "Ponte, como elegidos de Dios ... compasión sincera, amabilidad, humildad, gentileza y paciencia, soportándonos unos a otros y perdonándonos unos a otros ... Y sobre todo esto, ponte el amor, es decir, el vínculo de perfección. Y deje que la paz de Cristo controle sus corazones ... Y sea agradecido ". ¡Qué lista de valores familiares!

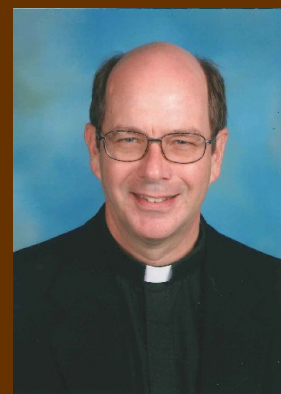
Un aspecto adicional importante de la vida familiar, que se encuentra más adelante en la segunda lectura, es la oración familiar. En la década de 1950, el Padre Patrick Peyton hizo famoso el dicho: "La familia que reza unida permanece unida". Cuando era niña, la oración familiar incluía la gracia antes y después de las comidas y también el rosario cada noche. Es posible que no tenga tiempo de rezar juntos el rosario, ya que todo esto sucede y todos se dirigen hacia diferentes direcciones, pero comer juntos es una forma importante de cultivar la unión y el amor, y orar antes y después de las comidas es una simple práctica. Hoy sería un buen día para revivir esa práctica si se ha quedado en el camino.

¡Que la vida familiar de Jesús, María y José sea nuestra inspiración en esta época festiva y durante todo el año!

The Holy Family

I hope everyone had a good Christmas. Certainly the liturgies here at St. Edward the Confessor and San Felipe de Jesus were glorious. We celebrated the birth of our Savior in fine form! Many thanks to all who helped, in their various ministries, with these liturgies; and thanks to you for being here to celebrate with us. On the Sunday after Christmas we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This feast focuses our attention on the fact that the Son of God came to earth in the context of family life. Indeed, he lived the majority of his years within the immediate context of his family. This shows us how important—essential, really—family life is in the mind of God.



All of us are familiar with the joys, and at times the challenges, of family life. In fact, the Christmas season sheds a bright light on these joys and challenges, as it is a time when family members who might not see each other frequently come together, and those family members who have passed are especially missed.

Our second reading today gives us a fine list of the qualities, or virtues, that help us to enjoy what is pleasant and endure what is unpleasant in family life. St. Paul writes, “Put on, as God’s chosen ones...heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another....And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts....And be thankful.” What a list of family values!

An additional important aspect of family life, found later in the second reading, is family prayer. Back in the 1950’s, Fr. Patrick Peyton made famous the saying, “The family that prays together stays together.” When I was a child, family prayer included grace before and after meals and also the rosary each evening. These days, with so much going on and everyone pulled in different directions, you might not have time to say the rosary together, but eating meals together is still an important way of cultivating union and love, and praying before and after meals is a simple practice. Today would be a good day to revive that practice if it has fallen by the wayside.

May the family life of Jesus, Mary and Joseph be our inspiration at this festive time and throughout the year!

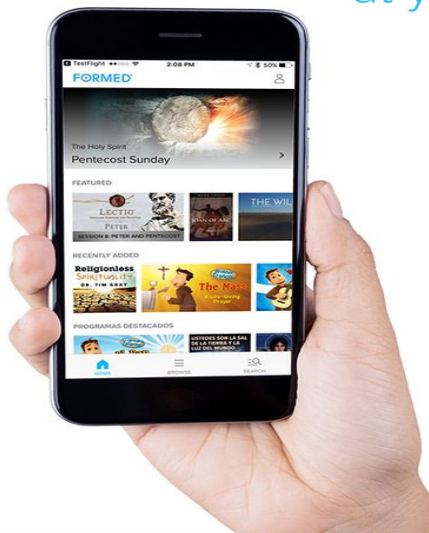

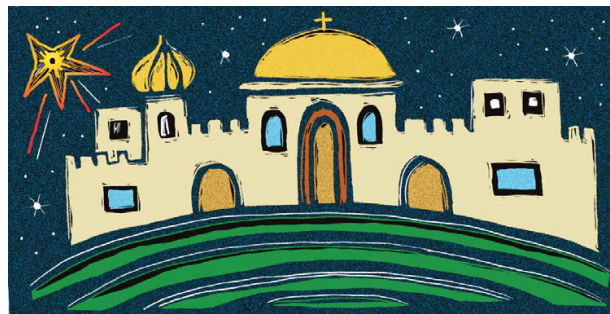

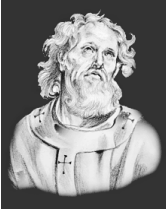
