Sacrament of Matrimony

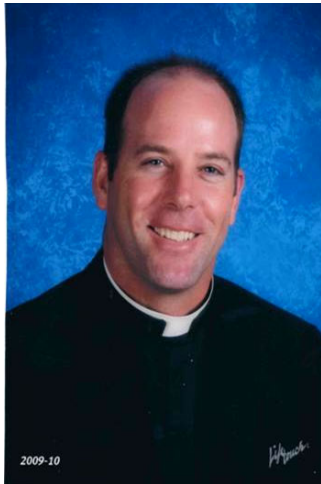

After Lazarus had been dead for four days Jesus said to Mary, the sister of Lazarus, "I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" (John 11:25-26)

Today we gather together with immense joy because, like those first disciples, we have come to believe that Jesus Christ has conquered death and restored us to life.
