Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

My dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

As we arrive at this providential and auspicious occasion, the dedication of our Diocesan Christ Cathedral, I look back on the past 6+ years of this adventure with gratitude to God. When Bishop Tod Brown and his advisors responded to the presenting opportunity to obtain this campus, I imagine, the scope of this project was only a vague outline at best. As it has taken shape, both prayer and work have been essential to the "building" of this Cathedral, this "House of God and Gate of Heaven". I thank the Lord not only for this having been accomplished but for all involved in this great work of worship and love!

From the beginning, there has been a powerful vision of this Cathedral and its campus as a beacon of faith and light for Southern California, even for the world, that it might become a "center of evangelization and mission", and that we the "Mother Church" as Dr. Schuller referred to us would carry this on. In all the work and mission and commitment of the building of this Cathedral, which has resulted in the beautiful Cathedral sanctuary, there has been this larger, concomitant and deeper effort at the heart of the project. We are not just building a beautiful space – we are building a witness and the "City of God" as we sang some years ago! When you view the light shining from the Cathedral at night, which is so spectacularly beautiful, I hope you will be reminded that we also are to be a light to the world. I would encourage everyone to take some time to do just this.

So, now, with the dedication, we have come to an end of this part of the journey and let us celebrate it! But this is, of course, not an end at all but another beginning. As we move into this new reality, this new Cathedral sanctuary, we have recently published our Diocesan Strategic Plan which identified our top priorities for the coming years. Evangelization and Faith Formation are at the top of our list of priorities – and utilizing this campus as a center of evangelization is included under those priorities. So, can we begin?

As we approach this new chapter, we begin with prayer. Our history tells us, Scripture instructs us, the Church teaches us....prayer is essential to our relationship with God and the necessary foundation of all our endeavors. It is through prayer, which begins in our hearts that we enter into intimacy with God. We are thirsty for God and only prayer can quench our thirst. Many of us learned at one time that prayer is the "lifting up of our minds and hearts to God", and in this new time in the life of our local Church we must do just that: each and every day! In every challenging and fractured age, when the people of God have committed anew to prayer, it becomes apparent that indeed the Holy Spirit has renewed the Church. Yes, certainly we live in a challenging age perhaps EVERY age is a challenging age. My study of Church history years ago in Kenrick Seminary under the guidance of Sr. Zoe Glenski, DC taught me this. As the foundation of the former "Crystal Cathedral" was strengthened in the construction, so too our own foundations of faith and worship must be strengthened. And if we are to build the living stones of the Church to fill this Cathedral with worship, prayer is surely our first priority and our first step.

So at this important moment of the life of our Diocese, I would like to announce the beginning of a Year of Prayer in the Diocese of Orange. Various resources will be offered to parishes and schools to promote and strengthen the practices of prayer in the life of the faithful. Each day my staff will pray at noon for the needs of parishes, staffs and all souls entrusted to the care of our Diocese. Departmental staff will also pray regularly for these intentions. I encourage you to pray with others or on your own for these needs as well.

I invite all our parishes, schools and agencies; our houses of consecrated men and women; and all families and individuals to pray that all of us will become more deeply friends of Jesus and a community of witnesses to the world. I would also ask each of us to think of the people who have taught us to pray as we were growing up, as I remember how my mother and father did this for us, each in our own way. Finally, that we may be one community at prayer, praise and worship, I would ask that this prayer be recited at the end of the Prayers of the Faithful (Universal Prayer) during liturgies celebrated in the diocese during our Year of Prayer:

*O God,
May every person within the Diocese of Orange
Come to personally know and love our Lord Jesus Christ
May they grow in maturity as a missionary disciple of Christ,
become actively engaged in the full life and mission of the Church
And joyfully use his or her gifts
To share the Good News and build up the Kingdom of God
For the salvation of souls. Through Christ our Lord. AMEN*

I want to thank each and every one of you for your faithful and faith filled witness. "May the God of Hope fill all with joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope." (Romans 15:13)

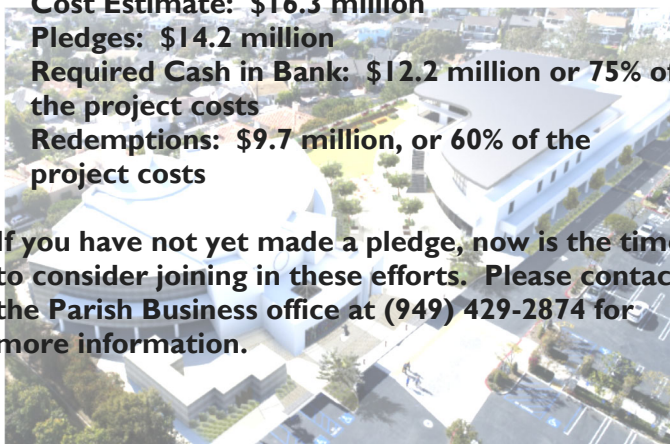

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en el Señor,

Al llegar a esta ocasión providencial y auspiciosa, la dedicación de nuestra Diocesana Catedral de Cristo, miro hacia atrás en los últimos 6 años de esta aventura con gratitud a Dios. Cuando el Obispo Tod Brown y sus asesores respondieron a la oportunidad de presentar este campus, me imagino que el alcance de este proyecto fue, en el mejor de los casos, un esbozo vago. Como ha tomado forma, tanto la oración como el trabajo han sido esenciales para la “construcción” de esta catedral, esta “Casa de Dios y Puerta del Cielo”. Agradezco al Señor no solo por esto, sino por todos los involucrados en ¡Esta gran obra de adoración y de amor!

Desde el principio, ha habido una visión poderosa de esta catedral y su campus como un faro de fe y de luz para el Sur de California, e incluso para el mundo, que podría convertirse en un “centro de evangelización y misión”, y que nosotros “La Iglesia Madre”, como el Dr. Schuller se refirió a nosotros, continuaría con esto.

En todo el trabajo, la misión y el compromiso de la construcción de esta catedral, que ha resultado en el hermoso santuario de la catedral, ha habido este esfuerzo más grande, simultáneo y más profundo en el corazón del proyecto.

No solo estamos construyendo un hermoso espacio; estamos construyendo un testigo y la “Ciudad de Dios” como cantamos hace algunos años. Cuando veas la luz que brilla desde la catedral por la noche, que es tan espectacularmente hermosa, espero que te recuerde que también debemos ser una luz para el mundo. Animo a todos a tomarse un tiempo para hacer esto.

Ahora, con la dedicación, hemos llegado al final de esta parte del viaje y ¡celebrems! Pero esto, por supuesto, no es un fin en absoluto, sino otro comienzo. A medida que avanzamos en esta nueva realidad, este nuevo santuario de la catedral, recientemente hemos publicado nuestro Plan Estratégico Diocesano que identificó nuestras principales prioridades para los próximos años. La evangelización y la formación en la fe están en la parte superior de nuestra lista de prioridades, y la utilización de este campus como centro de evangelización se incluye bajo esas prioridades. Entonces, ¿podemos comenzar?

A medida que nos acercamos a este nuevo capítulo, comenzamos con la oración. Nuestra historia nos dice, y la Escritura nos instruye, la Iglesia nos enseña...la oración es esencial para nuestra relación con Dios y la base necesaria de todos nuestros esfuerzos. Es a través de la oración, que comienza en nuestros corazones, que entramos en intimidad con Dios. Tenemos sed de Dios y solo la oración puede calmar nuestra sed. Muchos de nosotros aprendimos en un momento que la oración es “elevar nuestras mentes y corazones a Dios”, y en este nuevo momento en la vida de nuestra Iglesia local debemos hacer exactamente eso: ¡todos los días!

En cada época desafiante y fracturada, cuando el pueblo de Dios se ha comprometido nuevamente a la oración, se hace evidente que, de hecho, el Espíritu Santo ha renovado la Iglesia. Sí, ciertamente vivimos en una época desafiante; quizás CADA época es una era desafiante. Mi estudio de la historia de la Iglesia hace años en el Seminario Kenrick, bajo la guía de Hna. Zoe Glenski, DC, me enseñó esto. A medida que se fortalecieron los cimientos de la antigua "Catedral de Cristal" en la construcción, también se deben fortalecer nuestros propios cimientos de fe y adoración. Y si vamos a construir las piedras vivas de la Iglesia para llenar esta catedral de adoración, la oración es seguramente nuestra primera prioridad y nuestro primer paso.

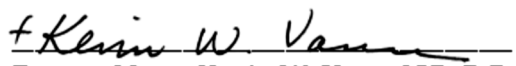
Entonces, en este importante momento de la vida de nuestra Diócesis, me gustaría anunciar el comienzo de un Año de Oración en la Diócesis de Orange. Se ofrecerán diversos recursos a las parroquias y escuelas para promover y fortalecer las prácticas de oración en la vida de los fieles. Cada día, mi personal orará al mediodía por las necesidades de las parroquias, el personal y todas las almas confiadas al cuidado de nuestra Diócesis. El personal departamental también rezará regularmente por estas intenciones. Te animo a orar con otros, o por tu cuenta, por estas necesidades también.

Invito a todas nuestras parroquias, escuelas y agencias; nuestras casas de hombres y mujeres consagrados; y todas las familias e individuos a rezar para que todos seamos más profundamente amigos de Jesús y una comunidad de testigos del mundo. También, pediría a cada uno de nosotros que pensemos en las personas que nos han enseñado a orar mientras crecíamos, al recordar cómo mi madre y mi padre hicieron esto por nosotros, cada uno a su manera. Finalmente, para que podamos ser una comunidad en oración, alabanza y adoración, pediría que esta oración se recitara al final de las Oraciones de los Fieles (Oración Universal) durante las liturgias celebradas en la diócesis durante nuestro Año de Oración:

*Oh Dios, concede que cada persona dentro de la Diócesis de Orange,
pueda conocer y amar personalmente a nuestro Señor Jesucristo,
que crezca en madurez como discípulo misionero de tu Hijo,
que participe activamente en la vida y misión de la Iglesia,
y alegremente, comparta sus dones para llevar la Buena Noticia y construir tu Reino para la salvación
de las almas, Amén.*

Three Archangels

September 29 falls on a Sunday this year, so we celebrate the 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time in our liturgy. However, when it is not a Sunday, September 29 is celebrated as the feast of three archangels who are powerful heavenly friends for all of us: they are Saint Michael, Saint Gabriel, and Saint Raphael.

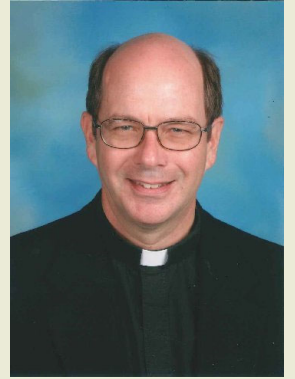
St. Michael the Archangel is the patron saint of fighting against the devil; the Scriptures attest to his effectiveness in this area. For the same reason, St. Michael is the patron of all battles, of the military, of security officers, and police; for less obvious reasons he is the patron of bankers, grocers, and mariners.

St. Gabriel is the patron of communication in all its forms; remember that St. Gabriel brought the world the message of the Incarnation when he announced it to the Blessed Virgin Mary. He is patron of those who work in radio, in television, in all telecommunications, and in the postal service. Related to this, he is also patron saint of stamp collectors.

St. Raphael, as is documented well in the book of Tobit, is the patron saint of travelers, of doctors, nurses, and pharmacists; he is patron of the blind, and he is also the patron of happy meetings.

If all these different activities are protected by three archangels, and if we remember that there are millions of angels and lots of other saints besides, we can see how every area of human activity is touched by divine providence. As often as not, God exercises that providence through his angels. They will assist us as we struggle against evil, and seek to communicate only what is good, and travel through this world to the next. Let's be mindful of their help until we join all the angels and saints in the eternal praise of God.

Tres Arcángeles

Este año el 29 de septiembre cae en domingo, al igual celebramos el 26 domingo del tiempo ordinario en nuestra liturgia. Sin embargo, cuando no cae en domingo, el 29 de septiembre, se celebra la fiesta de los tres Arcángeles, estos son poderosos amigos celestiales para todos nosotros: San Miguel, San Gabriel y San Rafael.

Arcángel San Miguel es el santo patrón de la lucha contra el diablo; Las Escrituras dan fe de su eficacia en esta área. Por la misma razón, San Miguel es el patrón de todas las batallas, de los militares, de los oficiales de seguridad y la policía; Por razones menos obvias, es el patrón de los banqueros, tiendas de comestibles y marineros.

San Gabriel es el patrón de la comunicación en todas sus formas; recuerda que San Gabriel trajo al mundo el mensaje de la Encarnación cuando lo anunció a la Bienaventurada Virgen María. Es el patrono de quienes trabajan en la radio, la televisión, todas las telecomunicaciones y en el servicio postal. Relacionado con esto, también es el santo patrón de los coleccionistas de sellos.

San Rafael como está bien documentado en el libro de Tobit, es el santo patrón de los viajeros, de los médicos, enfermeras y farmacéuticos; él es el patrón de los ciegos, y también es el patrón de las reuniones felices.



Si estas actividades están protegidas por tres arcángeles, y si además recordamos que hay millones de ángeles y muchos otros santos, podemos ver cómo cada área de la actividad humana es tocada por la divina providencia. Casi siempre, Dios ejerce esa providencia a través de sus ángeles. Nos ayudarán mientras luchamos contra el mal, y buscamos comunicar solo lo que es bueno, y viajar a través de este mundo al siguiente. Tengamos en cuenta su ayuda hasta que nos unamos a todos los ángeles y santos en la eterna alabanza con Dios.
