The Original Novena

A novena is typically a nine-day period during which prayers are said each day for a particular intention. Where did the idea of praying for nine days come from? Well, in the Acts of the Apostles St. Luke tells us that the Risen Lord remained on earth for forty days (Acts 1:3); and we know that Pentecost was fifty days after Easter. This leaves an interval of nine days from the Ascension of Jesus until the vigil of Pentecost. And what did the disciples do during those nine days? They "devoted

themselves with one accord to prayer." (Acts 1:14) That was the first Christian novena.

I tell you this now so that you may imitate the disciples and prepare for the feast of Pentecost by praying a novena. If you start on May 26 (which is celebrated as Ascension Thursday in many places), you will finish the novena on June 4, the day before Pentecost. What a great way to prepare for the coming of the Holy Spirit! Certainly we can see the need for the Holy Spirit in our lives, in our community, and in our world. Praying a novena before the feast of his coming is a way to unite ourselves with Christians of all times and places, going all the way back to that first novena prayed in preparation for the first Pentecost.

What prayers should you say during your novena? There are numerous sites on the internet, and numerous apps that contain novena prayers for the coming of the Holy Spirit; or perhaps (like me) you have a prayer book that contains such novena prayers. However you choose to do it, let's all pray that the Holy Spirit may come with his seven gifts and all the graces we need to be truly united to Jesus Christ.

La Primera Novena

Una novena es típicamente un período de nueve días durante el cual se rezan cada día por una intención particular. ¿De dónde vino la idea de orar durante nueve días? Pues bien, en los Hechos de los Apóstoles San Lucas nos dice que el Señor Resucitado permaneció en la tierra cuarenta días (Hechos 1,3); y sabemos que Pentecostés fue cincuenta días después de Pascua. Esto deja un intervalo de nueve días desde la Ascensión de Jesús hasta la vigilia de Pentecostés. ¿Y qué hicieron los discípulos durante esos nueve días? Ellos "se dedicaron a la oración". (Hechos 1:14) Esa fue la primera novena cristiana.

Les digo esto ahora para que imitemos a los discípulos y nos preparemos para la fiesta de Pentecostés rezando una novena. Si usted comienza el 26 de mayo (que en muchos lugares se celebra como el jueves de la Ascensión), terminará la novena el 4 de junio, el día antes de Pentecostés. ¡Qué buena manera de prepararse para la venida del Espíritu Santo! Ciertamente podemos ver la necesidad del Espíritu Santo en nuestras vidas, en nuestra comunidad y en nuestro mundo. Rezar una novena antes de la venida del Espíritu Santo es una buena forma de unirnos con los cristianos de todos los tiempos y lugares, remontándonos a esa primera novena rezada en preparación para el primer Pentecostés.

¿Qué oraciones puedes hacer durante la novena? Hay muchos sitios en Internet y numerosas aplicaciones que contienen diferentes novenas para la venida del Espíritu Santo; o tal vez (como yo) usted tiene algún libro que contiene tales oraciones. Independientemente de cómo elija hacerlo, oremos todos para que el Espíritu Santo venga con sus siete dones y todas las gracias que necesitamos para estar verdaderamente unidos a Jesucristo.


Parish Opportunities
