I am grateful to all who come to keep Our Lord company; I have no doubt that you benefit greatly from your time with Him. This is a source of grace for our entire parish.

Of course, it is necessary for us to have people in the church at all times when the Eucharist is exposed. This includes the late hours of night and the early hours of the morning. 


