Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

On the first and third Monday of the month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration at San Felipe de Jesus Chapel on the first Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

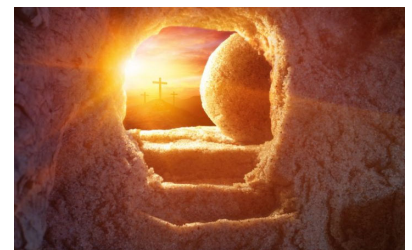

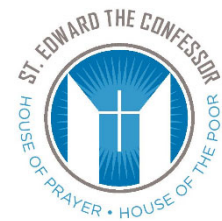

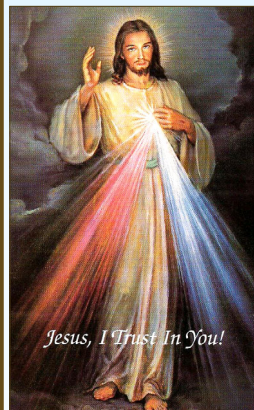

SCHOOL CORNER – BATTLE OF THE BOOKS CHAMPIONS

Congratulations to The Parish School's Battle of the Books (BOB) team who recently won first, second and fourth place at the regional championship. The competition featured More than 100 4th and 5th graders from eight schools, including St. Margaret's, St. Anne's, Serra Catholic and Mission Basilica who collectively read 20 books totaling 5,530 pages throughout the year.

Each team of five students participated in three rounds consisting of 16 questions (eight per team) each starting with the inquiring "In What Book..." question to test their knowledge and comprehension of the fiction and non-fiction titles. Four teams – including three from The Parish School and one team from Mission Basilica – made the semi-finals, with The Parish School's Wonderful Wizard of BOB and Answer Hunters teams competing in the final round with the Wonderful Wizard of BOB claiming the victory. This is the second year in a row that The Parish School won first place!



BOB is run by a dedicated group of parent volunteers who met with the participating 4th and 5th grade learners at 7 AM every Tuesday morning to enjoy reading, book discussion and analysis. Congratulations to the entire BOB team!
