Penitential Almsgiving

The ashes were washed off long ago, but we remain in the season of Lent. In the spirit of Lenten penance, I am going to address something that is not easy for me to address. If it is not easy for you to read, I hope you will receive it in the spirit with which I offer it. Our participation in the diocesan Pastoral Services Appeal is in trouble.



Now, if you already gave to the PSA, thank you and please pray for its success. But if you have not, please know that we need your participation. More specifically, Christ needs your participation. I say that Christ needs your participation because what we do for those in need, we do for Christ (Mt. 25:31-46). Catholic schools (especially tuition assistance), the deaf community, those who are in prison and restorative justice programs, priests and seminarians, the needy who contact Catholic Charities: in all these groups, Christ is calling to you, asking for your response.

Given that our goal this year is lower than last year's goal, I am confident that we can reach and surpass the goal. All funds over the assigned goal of \$221,000 will come back to the parish and be distributed to two worthy causes: 50% will go to our parish outreach programs, and 50% will go towards our Pastoral Center and Narthex project. I also promised a little prize to the parish, which I will deliver on the weekend we meet our goal. If you do not know what the prize is, you may ask a fellow parishioner or listen (on stecast) to my homily of February 16.

Thank you in advance for your generous response to the PSA, and please pray for the success of this important appeal.

Si esto no es fácil para usted leer, espero que lo reciba con el espíritu con el que yo lo ofrezco. Nuestra participación en la Apelación de Servicios Pastorales diocesanos está en problemas.



Ahora, si ya contribuyo al PSA, muchas gracias y ayudemos con sus oraciones para que sea un éxito. Pero si no lo ha hecho, sepa que necesitamos de su participación. Más específicamente, Cristo necesita de su participación. Digo que Cristo necesita su participación porque lo que hacemos por los necesitados, lo hacemos por Cristo (Mateo 25:31-46). Las Escuelas católicas (especialmente para la asistencia de la matrícula), la comunidad sordomuda, aquellos que están en prisión y programas de justicia restaurativa, sacerdotes y seminaristas, los necesitados que contactan a Caridades Católicas: en todos estos grupos, Cristo los está llamando, pidiéndoles su respuesta.

Dado que nuestro objetivo este año es inferior al objetivo del año pasado, estoy seguro de que podemos alcanzarla y superarla. Todos los fondos que superen la meta asignada de \$221,000 regresarán a la parroquia y se distribuirán a dos causas importantes: el 50% se destinará a nuestros programas de extensión parroquial y el 50% se destinará a nuestro Centro Pastoral y al proyecto Narthex. También les prometí un pequeño premio, que entregaré el fin de semana cuando cumplamos nuestro objetivo. Si no sabe cuál es el premio, puede preguntarle a un compañero feligrés o escuchar (en emisión) mi homilía del 16 de febrero.

Gracias de antemano por su generosa respuesta al PSA, y oremos por el éxito de esta importante apelación.

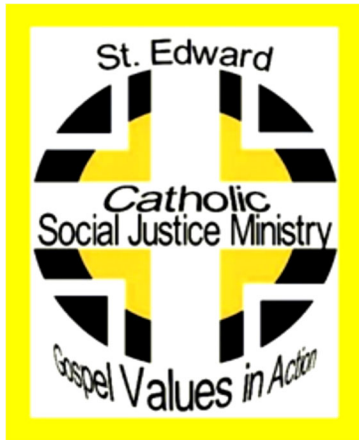

In *Rejoice and Be Glad* [*Gaudete et Exsultate*], Pope Francis writes: “You cannot grow in holiness without committing yourself, body and soul, to giving your best to this endeavor.” The call to holiness, he writes, requires a “firm and passionate” defense of “the innocent unborn.” “**Equally sacred**,” he further states, are “the lives of the poor, those already born, the destitute, the abandoned and the underprivileged, the vulnerable infirm and elderly exposed to covert euthanasia, the victims of human trafficking, new forms of slavery, and every form of rejection.”

Outlet—has “adopted” him because we want him to get to his goal of graduation, and we are hoping that our generous community will help us!

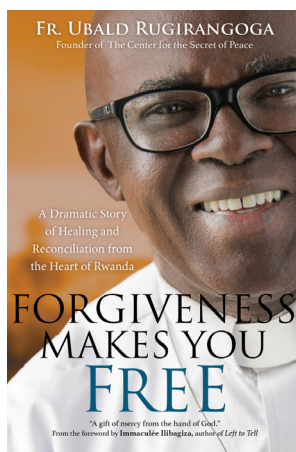

Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga

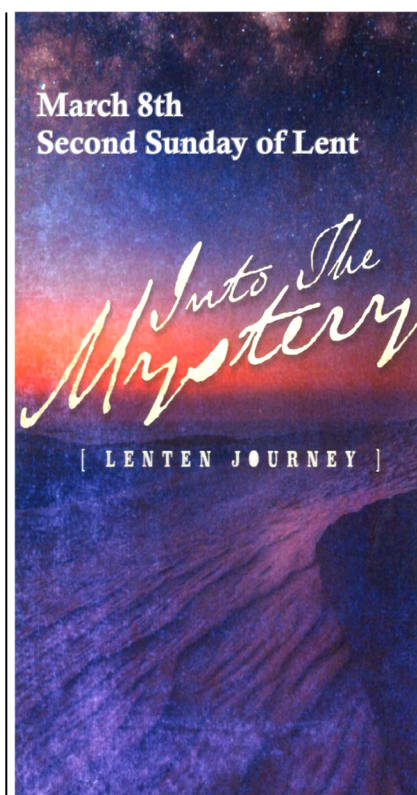
Topic: “Peace & Healing through Forgiveness”

Sunday, March 8 at 7:00pm in the Church

Fr. Ubald Rugirangoga has been a Roman Catholic priest for 25 years in the Cyangugu Diocese of Southeastern Rwanda. During the 1994 genocide Fr. Ubald lost over 80 members of his family and over 45,000 of his parishioners were exterminated. He escaped through the Congo on foot in the middle of the

night. When he left Rwanda he made a promise to his Bishop that he would return to bring healing to his people. He spent 3 months in Belgium during the genocide and he said he cried every day. After a trip to Lourdes where he heard Jesus tell him “Ubald, carry your cross,” he felt a release from the burden of his sorrows and knew he was called to preach healing, forgiveness and reconciliation. Fr. Ubald has a beautiful healing gift and his focus is on healing and evangelization wherever he goes.

Founded by the Council of Orange, Society of St. Vincent de Paul, the Food Bank began providing food for the hungry in October 1983 in Orange, under the leadership of Dan Harney. In 2007, the Food Bank moved to a new facility in Irvine on the old El Toro Marine Base, more than doubling its capacity to meet the needs of Orange County's hungry during the most difficult economic times since the Great Depression. In 2012, the Food Bank became an independent 501c3 corporation. Since its founding, the Food Bank has provided more than 272 million pounds of donated and surplus food to local charities.

For over 30 years, the **SVDP Summer Camp Program** has given an average of 250 children the opportunity to experience the great outdoors in God's green grassy acres away from their urban environment. Conferences in the Diocese of Orange sponsor children from their parish neighborhoods to attend summer camp for one week. In preparation to attending these camps each child receives a free medical physical. At camp, they meet new friends and just have a lot of fun. This program gives these children a chance to see and know another part of life and the great outdoors!



Lights On is a Detention Ministry/Reentry Program to assist individuals who are released from the O.C. Central Jail between the hours of 10PM and 3AM each night. The program provides a safe and sober location for both men and women and a place to find resources for safe return home. We provide food, drinks, clothing, cell phone usage and limited bus transportation for those who have no other resource. The program also attempts to assist individuals find other programs that may help them to fulfill the conditions of release and a first step to "get their lives back on track". Each year, the program serves nearly 10,000 newly released inmates.

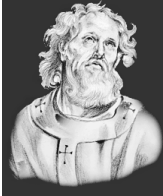
