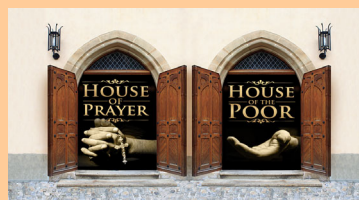


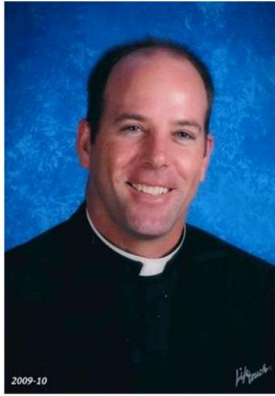

An Account of our Stewardship

Our Lord teaches us through several parables that he has made us stewards of his many gifts and that it is important to give an account of how we have used these gifts. In that spirit, today's bulletin includes our parish annual report which will illustrate how your gifts of time, talent and treasure have been used to do wonderful things.

As is required when there is a change in pastor, an independent financial audit of the parish was conducted last year. The audit confirmed that we are using best practices in our stewardship of money. In addition, I receive counsel and advice from our parish finance council which consists of parishioners who have expertise in finance and accounting.

Neither your family nor our parish family exists in order to raise money. Instead, we work in order to obtain the things that we value - such as food, shelter, education, and leisure - and to provide them for the people we value such as ourselves, our family and the poor. We express our values by how we spend our resources. Today's bulletin is not only meant to provide financial transparency but also to communicate who we are as a Catholic Community and what we value by illustrating how we have used the resources entrusted to us.

I write this letter with a grateful heart to all of the parishioners whose generosity of time and treasure have helped us accomplish great things in the name of Christ. I am confident that you will read this bulletin with pride and a renewed spirit of gratitude and service to God and your parish.

The Scriptures remind us that everything we have belongs to God. Next Sunday, each of us will be asked to renew our commitment to share our time, talent and treasure with our parish community. As a visible sign of our individual and collective commitment to God and our church, each person/family will be asked to complete a commitment card and place it in a basket which will be located in front of the altar. 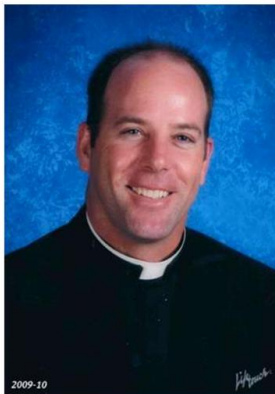
Since 1994, the Diocese of Orange has been collecting funds to support local Respect Life shelters, clinics, and centers that give immediate and long-term care to Orange County

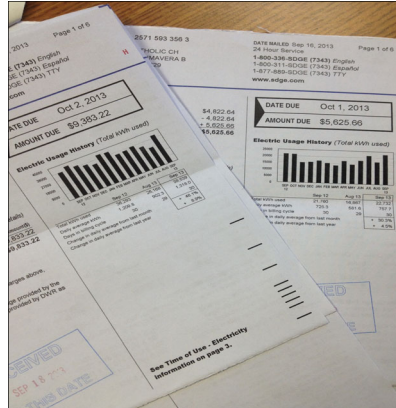

Look What We Did This Past Year!

- **St. Edward the Confessor School completed an extensive renovation project this summer. New playground equipment was purchased to replace outdated equipment that no longer met the current safety standards.**
- **The 30 year old restrooms were renovated and made compliant with ADA requirements.**
- **A new lunch area was constructed, seating 250 students in a permanent shaded area that can also be used for other outside functions by the parish.**
- **The Preschool classrooms were moved to allow for a more secure environment.**
- **The Church, Parish Offices and Knight Hall roofs had repairs extending the life to 30 years.**
- **Glass railing was installed in the balcony of the church in compliance with current safety codes.**

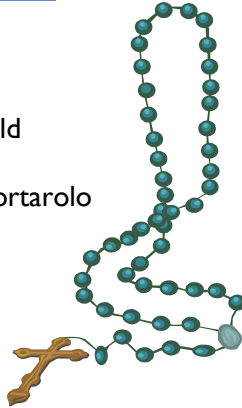
