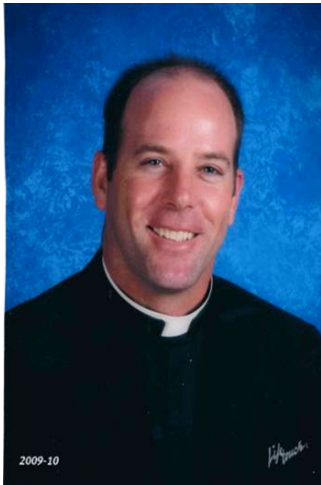
Sacrament of Matrimony

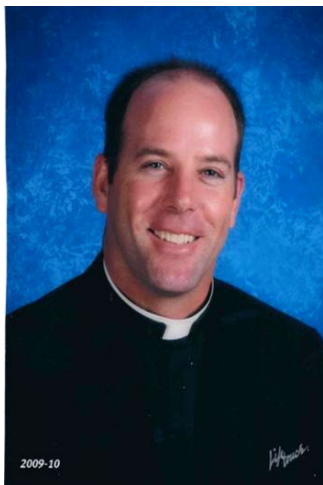

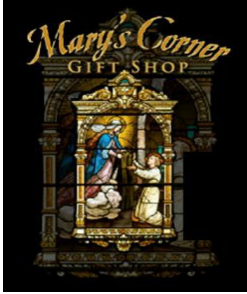

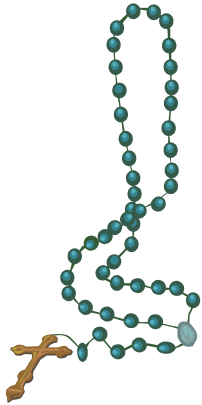
