Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

O Mary, you shine continuously on our journey as a sign of salvation and hope. We entrust ourselves to you, Health of the Sick.

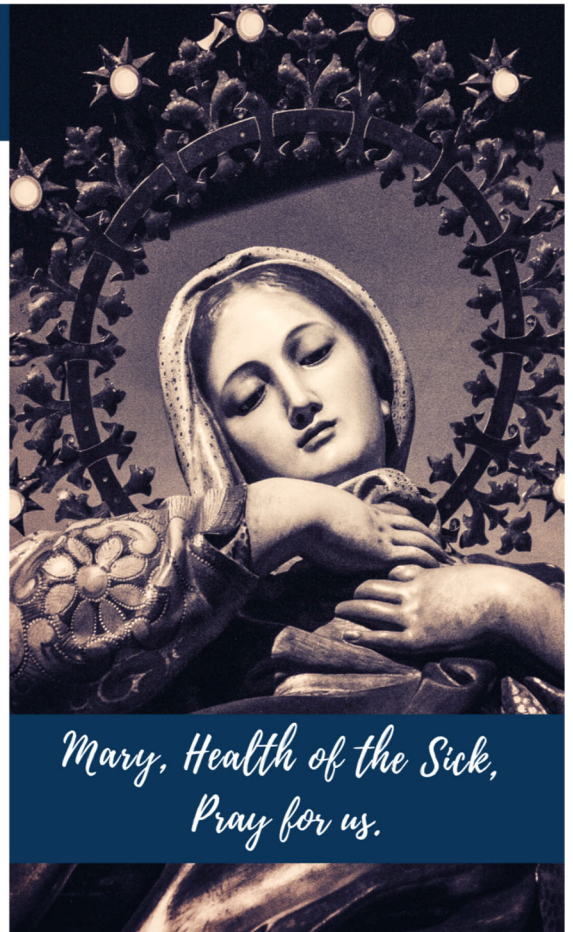

- (1) We have achieved the Diocesan Requirement of 75% of the total cost estimate cash on hand to start the project! \$12,260,000 of the total \$16,345,000
- (2) **Groundbreaking Ceremony with Bishop Kevin Vann scheduled for May 31! 9am Mass followed by the Ceremony**
- (3) Pre-bid meeting was held Wednesday, March 11. Bids due back April 22
- (4) Parish staff preparing for move to modular office unit May 1

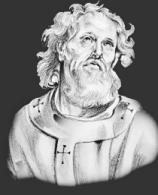
