In particular, we are part of the Diocese of Orange. We share in the responsibility to provide for the ministries and services of the Diocese. Many of those ministries and services enrich us directly, as the Diocese offers support to parishes and schools. Other ministries, like detention ministry and restorative justice programs, seminarian formation, and ongoing education for priests and deacons, affect us indirectly. All of them promote the lively faith of our Diocese.

This is why I sincerely hope that everyone in our parish will support this year's Pastoral Services Appeal. You might have already received a mailing from the Diocese asking for your support; in addition, we are providing information and making a direct appeal to all of our parishioners on the weekend of February 15-16. I am very grateful for your support in the past, and I thank you in advance for your support this year. Incidentally, any funds beyond our assigned goal (which is lower than last year's goal) will come back to the parish: we will use half of those funds for our Pastoral Center and Narthex project, and half for our parish Outreach ministries and assistance. Nuestra Fe. Nuestro Futuro.

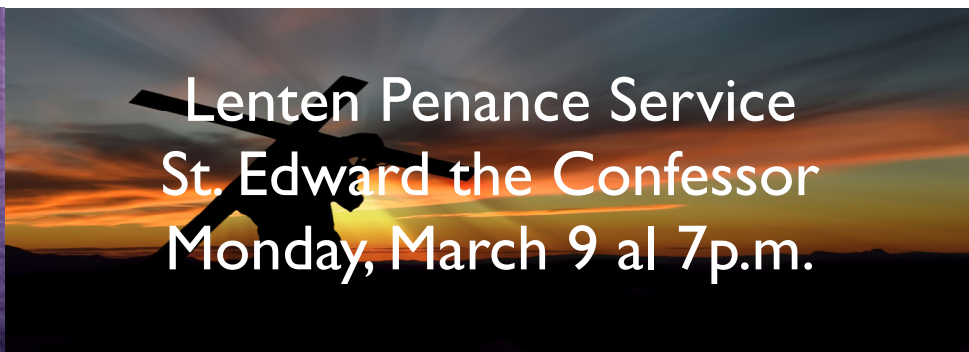

Liturgical Changes During Lent

During this penitential season, our liturgical environment is simplified to help us enter into a “desert” encounter and lead us to a more prayerful & penitential disposition. While it is not mandated by the Church, our parish incorporates praying the Apostles’ Creed in place of the Nicene Creed, and Greek (Kyrie) & Latin Mass parts (*Sanctus*, Memorial Acclamation, *Agnus Dei*) to clearly set apart the liturgical season of Lent.

Here are some additional changes you may have noticed.

- ❖ Church décor is simplified; only 2 altar candles; simple violet decorations
- ❖ Music has been toned down as well; no drums; no closing song (just simple instrumental)
- ❖ The Gloria is omitted during Lent except on Feasts and Solemnities
- ❖ “Alleluia” is not said/sung during Lent; “Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!” is used as the Gospel Acclamation
- ❖ Longer pauses before prayers and between scripture readings
- ❖ Chanted “The Word of the Lord,” “The Gospel of the Lord,” and the Our Father
