The Gift of a Home by Deacon Al Scaduto

At dawn on the morning of April 26th thirty St. Edward parishioners, accompanied by Fr. Brendan, gathered near the Mexican border. The group of men and women, ages 18 to 70, volunteered to “build a home in a day” for the Valencia de La Cruz family.

Fellow parishioners, Tom and Nancy McMillen, who are long time associates of a charitable organization called Corazón, led the volunteers. They routinely make several trips a month to Mexican border towns to build houses for families living in poverty. Corazón has been constructing homes in these communities for nearly 40 years, but also strives to enhance opportunities for families to end the cycle of poverty. They work with families selected by their neighbors who have demonstrated a sincere dedication to building productive communities and are focused on improving their lives as well as seeking a formal education for their children.

Tom is currently the president of Corazón. He and his wife took us to a small village on the southwest side of Tijuana where running water and electricity is a unique benefit. When we first arrived at the location we were joyfully welcomed by a shy humble family of six who had been living on the floor with relatives in a simple one-room shanty for several years. We could sense the anticipation they were experiencing in knowing that they would be homeowners by the end of the day. It was hard to imagine that by that evening this family would have a sturdy shelter they could call home. Their excitement motivated us to work as hard as we could to fulfill their life long dream.

A 16' X 20' concrete pad had already been prepared with all the building materials ready to go. It was delightful organized chaos as the men nailed and the women cut and painted the wood. Under the direction of Tom and Nancy, within two hours the walls were constructed and raised into place. Throughout the day folks were cheerfully expressing how meaningful it was to be a part of such a wonderful endeavor.

After lunch the roof and shingles were installed as well as a loft for the children to have their very own place to sleep. Windows, trim, paint and a front door were in place by 4 PM.

There were many precious moments that brought to light how the simple things that we take for granted can mean so much to the marginalized of the world. When Mrs. De La Cruz saw that a tile counter top had been installed, she was so thrilled that she could now prepare her meals somewhere other than on the ground. Ten year old Noemi was exclaiming, “ventana ventana!” when she discovered her new house had windows.



At the end of the day they were handed the keys to their new home. They tearfully expressed their gratitude and thanked God for His graciousness. Although many of us are not proficient in Spanish, we came to know them as our brothers and sisters...hugs and handshakes were bountiful.

God blessed us that day by giving us the ability to use our hands to live the Gospel and witness His love in action. In His name, we reached across borders to touch a wonderful and deserving family.

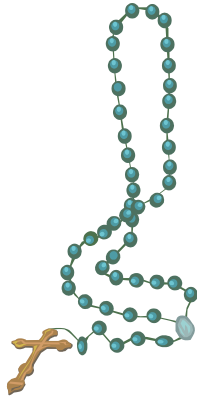
