Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

The Holy Family

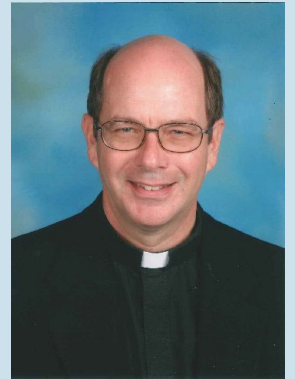
On the Sunday after Christmas, we celebrate the feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. This feast focuses our attention on the fact that the Son of God came to earth in the context of family life. He lived the majority of his earthly years within the immediate context of his family. Clearly, family life is important in the mind of God.

All of us are familiar with the joys and challenges of family life. The Christmas season sheds a bright light on these joys and challenges, as it is a time when family members who might not see each other frequently come together, and we especially miss the members of our family who are no longer with us.

In his Letter to the Colossians, St. Paul lists the virtues that help us to enjoy what is pleasant and endure what is unpleasant in family life. He writes, "Put on, as God's chosen ones...heartfelt compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience, bearing with one another and forgiving one another....And over all these put on love, that is, the bond of perfection. And let the peace of Christ control your hearts....And be thankful." What a list of family values!

May the family life of Jesus, Mary and Joseph be our inspiration at this festive time and throughout the year!

La Sagrada Familia

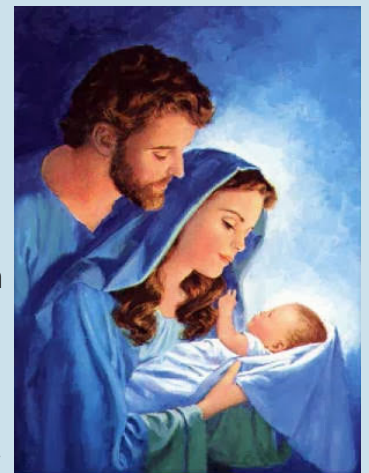
