Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

Fifty Years, Fifty Hours

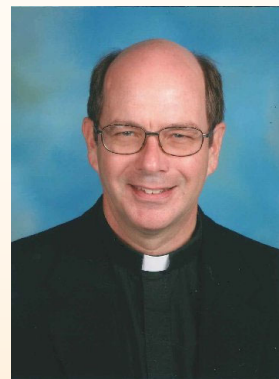
At the end of September, we had our hugely successful Oktoberfest. It was, in part, a celebration of our fifty years as a parish. We celebrated our Golden Anniversary in great form; so much so that many people are hoping for another Oktoberfest next year. Soon, we will mark our Golden Anniversary with a different kind of celebration. I pray that this celebration will be at least as successful as the first.

Our next celebration takes the form of Eucharistic Adoration for fifty hours—one hour for each year of our existence as a parish. We will start the fifty hours on Sunday, December 1, with an Advent prayer service at 7:00 pm. In many ways, that service will set the tone for the hours that follow. The Eucharist will be exposed on our altar continuously until 9:00 pm on December 3. (During Mass times, the Eucharist will be reposed in the tabernacle. Mass is the supreme act of Eucharistic Adoration in itself.)

With the Eucharist exposed for more than two days, it should be possible for us to find a time when we can come to our church and pray. You might come for a few minutes, or you might come for an hour. If you are able to plan it ahead of time, you could sign up for an hour by calling our office or visiting the sign-up table after Mass. Otherwise, you can just come whenever you like, day or night. Some groups in the parish may wish to sign up for the same hour and pray aloud; that is fine. Others may prefer to sign up for an hour when the church is silent. In the space of fifty hours, there should be room for both experiences of prayer.

This prolonged period of Eucharistic Adoration is a call to prayer for all of us. For some, it is a familiar experience. For others, it might be the first occasion that you have spent a significant period of time in silence with Our Lord. What should you do during that time? There are no rules for that, but next week I will share some humble suggestions. In the meantime, please consider joining in this parish-wide observance, which gives thanks and praise to God for our fifty years as a parish.

Cincuenta Años, Cincuenta Horas

A finales de septiembre, tuvimos el Oktoberfest que fue un gran éxito. Fue, en parte, una celebración de nuestros cincuenta años como parroquia. Celebramos nuestro aniversario de oro en grande; tanto que muchas personas esperan otro Oktoberfest el año que viene. Pronto, celebraremos nuestro aniversario de oro con otro tipo de celebración. Rezo para que esta celebración sea al menos tan exitosa como la primera.

Nuestra próxima celebración toma la forma de Adoración Eucarística durante cincuenta horas, una hora por cada año de nuestra existencia como parroquia. Comenzaremos las cincuenta horas el domingo 1 de diciembre con un servicio de oración de Adviento a las 7:00 pm. En muchos sentidos, ese servicio establecerá el tono para las horas que siguen. La Eucaristía estará expuesta en nuestro altar continuamente hasta las 9:00 pm del 3 de diciembre. (Durante los tiempos de la Misa, la Eucaristía será depositada en el tabernáculo. La misa es el acto supremo de la Adoración Eucarística en sí misma).

Con la Eucaristía expuesta por más de dos días, debería ser posible para nosotros encontrar un momento en el que podamos venir a nuestra iglesia y orar. Puede venir por unos minutos, o puede venir por una hora. Si puede planificarlo con anticipación, puede inscribirse durante una hora llamando a nuestra oficina o visitando la mesa de inscripción después de la Misa. De lo contrario, puede venir cuando lo desee, de día o de noche. Es posible que algunos grupos de la parroquia deseen inscribirse en la misma hora y rezar en voz alta; eso está bien. Otros pueden preferir inscribirse durante una hora cuando la iglesia está en silencio. En el espacio de cincuenta horas, debe haber espacio para ambas experiencias de oración.

Este prolongado período de adoración eucarística es un llamado a la oración por todos nosotros. Para algunos, es una experiencia familiar. Para otros, podría ser la primera ocasión en que haya pasado un período de tiempo significativo en silencio con Nuestro Señor. ¿Qué debes hacer durante ese tiempo? No hay reglas para eso, pero la próxima semana compartiré algunas humildes sugerencias. Mientras tanto, considere unirse a esta observancia parroquial, que da gracias y alabanza a Dios por nuestros cincuenta años como parroquia.

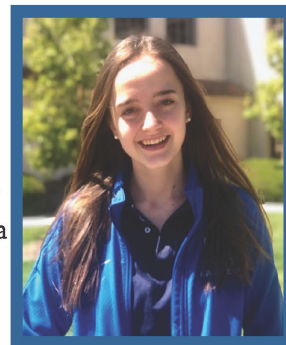
