Stewardship Update

Dear Friends,

Part of responsible stewardship is rendering an account of what we do with our riches. The following pages represent our best effort to render an account of how we have used the goods that you have contributed to your Church. In addition to the sacramental and ministerial information, you will find an account of how your treasures have been allocated.

I give thanks and praise to God, and to you, for your goodness and generosity! Of course, the costs of operating a parish increase every year, as do the costs of maintaining your homes and families. For this reason, we hope that the members of each household in our parish will consider the possibility of increasing their sacrificial offerings in the weekly collection.

An added need in our parish is funding for our Pastoral Center and Narthex project. During the past year, the Building Committee has been very busy, moving forward with designs, drawings, and plans. We are poised to break ground in June of 2020. However, we are required to have \$12.2 million when we break ground, and at the present time we have \$9.8 million. If you continue to honor your generous pledges, we should have the amount we need by June; but we are cutting it very close. Would you consider giving an extra donation now to ensure that we can move forward as planned? The project will benefit all of us; it only makes sense that we should all contribute to make it happen.

Queridos amigos,

Parte de una buena administración es dar cuentas de lo que hacemos con nuestro dinero. Las siguientes páginas representan nuestro mejor esfuerzo para rendir cuentas de cómo hemos utilizado los bienes que usted ha contribuido a su Iglesia. Además de la información sacramental y ministerial, encontrará una cuenta de cómo se han asignado sus tesoros.

¡Doy gracias y alabo a Dios, y a usted, por su bondad y generosidad! Por supuesto, los costos de operar una parroquia aumentan cada año, al igual que los costos de mantenimiento de sus hogares y familias. Por esta razón, esperamos que los miembros de cada hogar en nuestra parroquia consideren la posibilidad de aumentar sus ofrendas en la colección semanal, nosotros sabemos que esto será un sacrificio para muchas familias.

Una necesidad adicional en nuestra parroquia es la financiación de nuestro Centro Pastoral y el proyecto Narthex. Durante el año pasado, el Comité de Construcción ha estado muy ocupado, avanzando con diseños, dibujos y planos. Estamos listos para comenzar en junio del 2020. Sin embargo, se nos exige tener \$12.2 millones de dólares al iniciar la construcción, y en este momento solo tenemos \$9.8 millones. Si continúa cumpliendo sus generosas promesas, tendremos la cantidad que necesitamos para junio; pero ya estamos muy cerca. ¿Consideraría hacer una donación adicional ahora para garantizar que podamos avanzar según lo planeado? El proyecto nos beneficiará a todos; solo tiene sentido que todos contribuyamos para que esto suceda.

For the Year Ended June 30, 2019

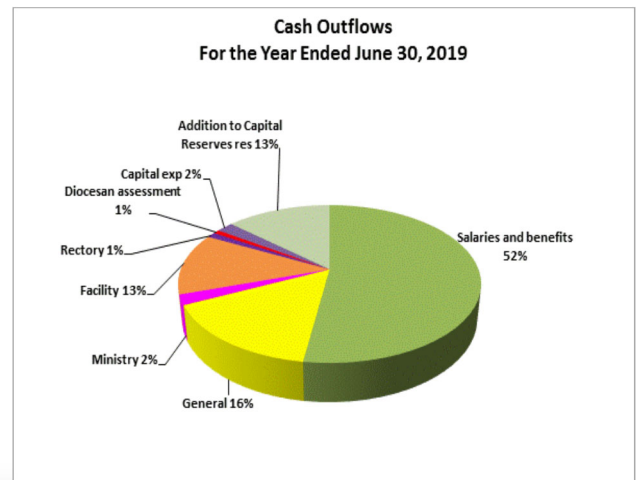

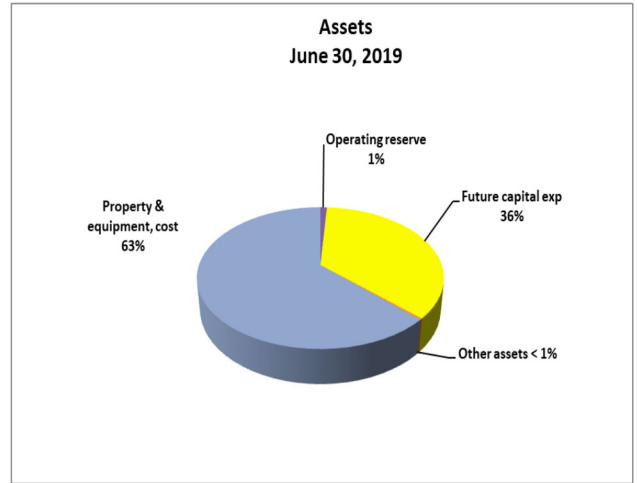

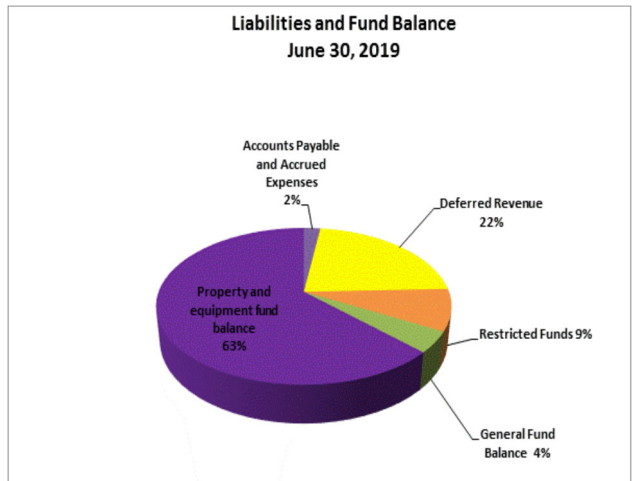

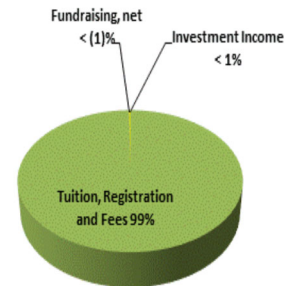

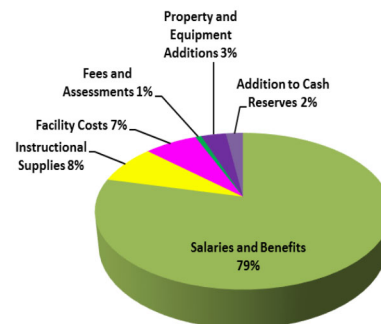

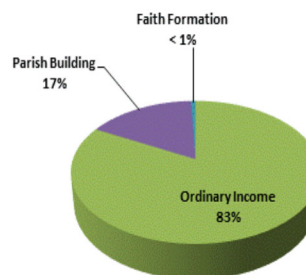

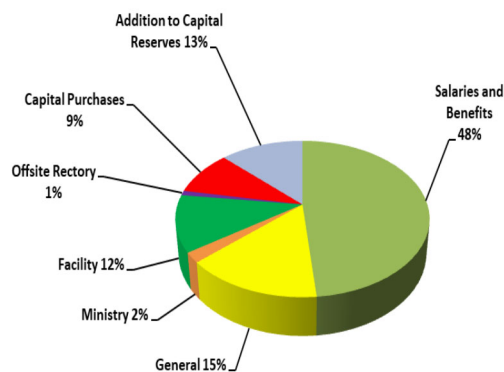

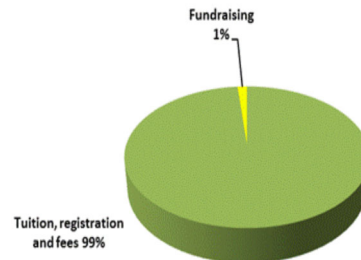

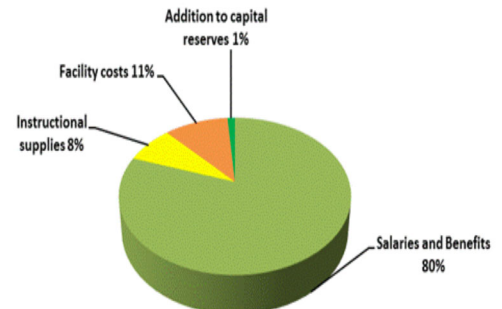

Family Faith Formation, RCIA, Confirmation, Outlet, Insight, Youth Ministry sessions focused on modeling and teaching our faith to all ages. In addition to face-to-face sessions, both take-home books and online resources were provided throughout the year. This is an intergenerational process—we evangelize and minister to the whole family and had 729 children and teens enrolled during the year!

Adult Faith Formation included two on-going Bible Studies (morning and evening), **Catholicism 101** for growth and spirituality for the adults of the parish, **Baptism Prep** for parents and godparents, facebook.stedwardchurch.com, and many opportunities for learning and growth online.

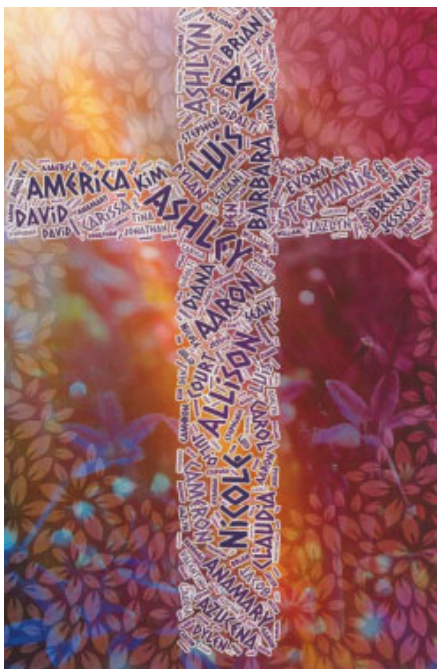

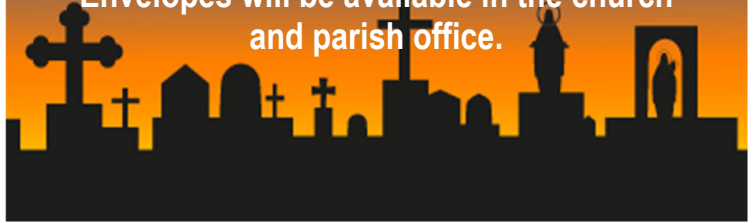
