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The Sacramental Life

From Holy Saturday on, these last few weeks have been marked by a very large number of sacramental celebrations here at St. Edward the Confessor and San Felipe de Jesús. Sixteen people received all three Sacraments of Initiation—Baptism, Confirmation, and First Communion. Ninety-two young people were confirmed by Bishop Freyer. Over a hundred young people have received First Communion so far (and there are more to come); of course, that was preceded by their First

Reconciliation earlier on this year. And all of this is in addition to our usual Baptisms, our regular Confessions and Masses, and a number of weddings and Anointings of the Sick. This is the first meaning of the word “celebrate” in our parish vision of “Celebrate, Serve, and Evangelize.” We celebrate the sacraments.

All of this sacramental activity reminds me that the sacraments are the heart and soul of Catholic living. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* tells us that “the seven sacraments touch all the stages and all the important moments of Christian life: they give birth and increase, healing and mission to the Christian’s life of faith.” (n. 1210) The sacraments are one of the things that sets us apart from most other Christian denominations.

Since the sacraments are the channels of God’s grace in our lives, we cannot live without them. I hope we treasure these special encounters with Our Risen Lord, encounters that are just as real and redemptive as the encounters with the Lord that the Gospels tell us about. Weekly Mass is a special treasure among these celebrations, and hopefully it is a priority in our lives. May we always celebrate the Paschal Mystery with devotion, gratitude, and joy!

La Vida Sacramental

A partir del Sábado Santo, las últimas semanas han estado marcadas por un número muy grande de celebraciones sacramentales aquí en San Eduardo el Confesor y San Felipe de Jesús. Dieciséis personas recibieron los tres Sacramentos de Iniciación: Bautismo, Confirmación y Primera Comunión. Noventa y dos jóvenes fueron confirmados por el obispo Freyer. Hasta ahora más de cien jóvenes han recibido la Primera Comunión (y habrá más); por supuesto, eso fue precedido por su Primera Reconciliación a principios de este año. Y todo esto se suma a los Bautismos habituales, las Confesiones y Misas semanales, un múltiple de bodas y Unción de los Enfermos. Este es el primer significado de la palabra “celebrar” en nuestra visión parroquial de “Celebrar, Servir y Evangelizar”. Celebramos los sacramentos.

Toda esta actividad sacramental me recuerda que los sacramentos son el corazón y el alma de la vida católica. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica nos dice que “Los siete sacramentos corresponden a todas las etapas y todos los momentos importantes de la vida del cristiano: dan nacimiento y crecimiento, curación y misión a la vida de fe de los cristianos. (n. 1210) Los sacramentos son una de las cosas que nos separan de la mayoría de las denominaciones cristianas.

Los sacramentos son los canales de la gracia de Dios en nuestras vidas, no podemos vivir sin ellos. Espero que sepamos valorar estos encuentros con Nuestro Señor Resucitado, encuentros que sean tan reales y redentores como con el Señor de los que nos hablan los Evangelios. La misa semanal es un tesoro entre estas celebraciones, y ojalá sea una prioridad en nuestras vidas. ¡Que siempre celebremos el Misterio Pascual con devoción, gratitud y alegría!
