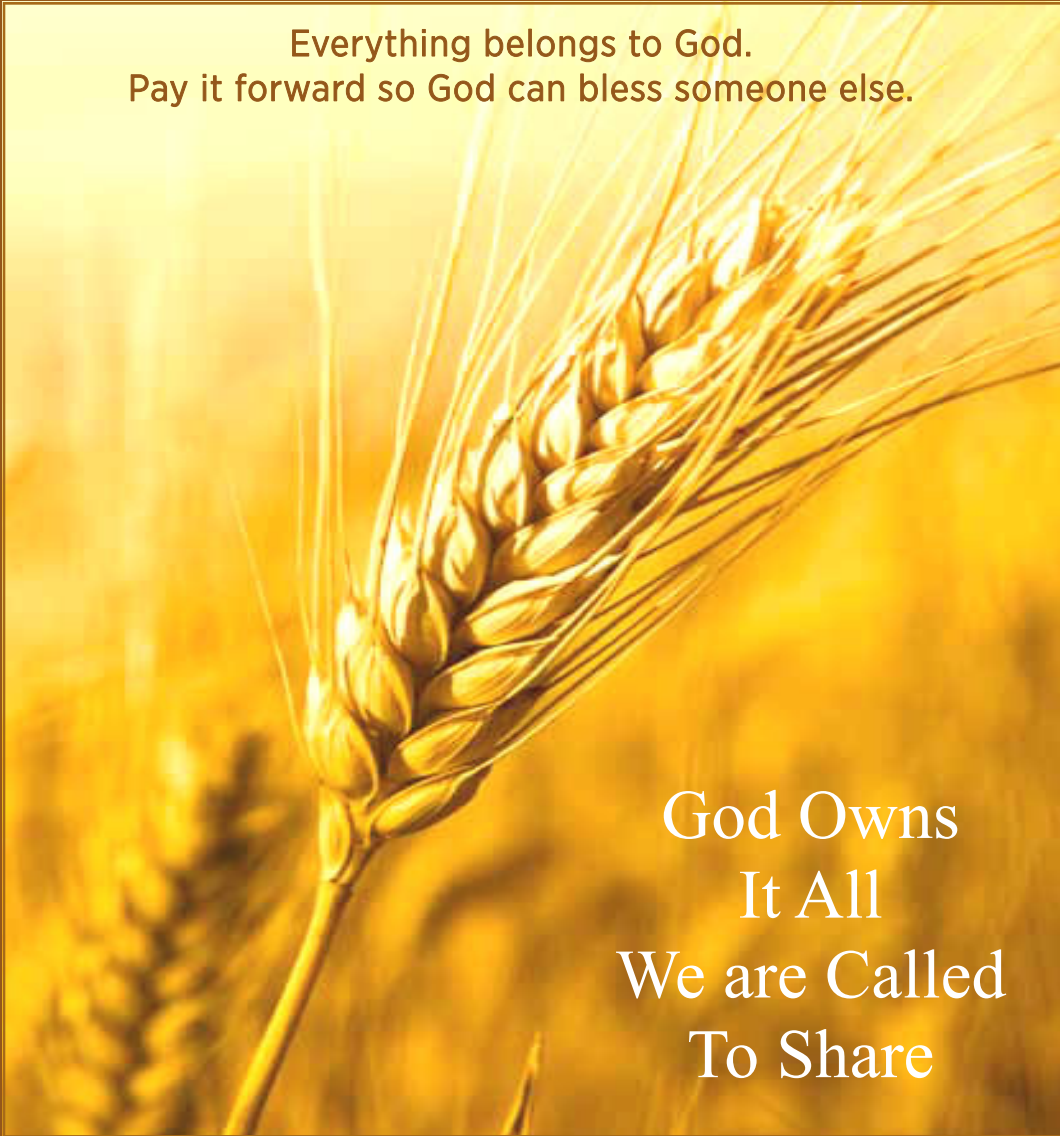

God Owns it All -Responding to God's Generosity-

Two thousand years ago, St. Paul asked his Christian community: "What do you have that you did not receive?" (1 Cor 4:7). Their response – and ours – would have to be: "nothing." When we truly recognize and believe that everything we are and everything we have is an unearned *gift* from God, our hearts and our lives are forever changed. Our first response to God's goodness and generosity is gratitude and joy. Our second response is a desire to respond to God's love.

Aware that everything we have is a generous gift from God we too join the psalmist in asking "How can I repay the Lord for all the good he has done for me?" (Ps 116:12). We can never repay God, because everything belongs to Him. In fact, even our desire to thank God is itself God's gift to us; however, we can respond to God's love by generously and joyfully sharing the gifts He has entrusted to us. We call this Christian stewardship.

Over the last several weeks, we have been encouraged to be good stewards of our God-given **time** and **talents** by sharing them with parish and community outreach ministries that serve God in others. Today, in a spirit of gratitude and joy, we respond to God's love by making a commitment to return a generous portion of our **treasure** to God.

How Much to Give Back?

We give because we have received and we give in the measure in which we have received. The Old Testament tradition of tithing, or giving 10%, is a good *start*. After all, the fact that God gives us 100% and only asks for 10% is a pretty good deal! However, stewardship goes beyond percentages. As Bishop Fulton J. Sheen said, "never measure your generosity by what you give, but rather by what you have left."

Please take a moment to consider what percentage of your income you are giving to God in your Sunday offering. One recommendation is to give 5% to the church and 5% to parish and community outreach ministries such as Christian Services, second collections, PSA, and missionary appeals. If you are currently giving 2% or 3% of your income, please consider increasing it by 1% or 2% each year. If you are already tithing, thank you. Perhaps you could live with a little less so that those with nothing can have a little.

How Should I Give?

When we give a gift to someone we often place it in an envelope, a bag, or nice paper, and we write our name on it. Clearly none of this is necessary; the recipient would gladly accept an unwrapped gift. Nonetheless, the thought and care that goes into preparing a gift becomes part of the gift itself and shows that the recipient is important to us. In the same way, we can put our cash or check in the collection basket at church and it too will be gratefully received and wisely used. I ask that you think about using your church envelope as a way of preparing your gift for God. Like the gifts we give to others, we wrap them up, sign our name and give them with pride and joy.

Many of us take care of our most important financial commitments through electronic giving. Our financial offering to God and our church should be among our primary commitments, giving back to God from our "first fruits," not our left-overs (Cf. Prov 3:9). Please consider supporting your church home by signing up for electronic giving today.

God owns it all. Let's respond with gratitude, joy and generosity.

Dios es dueño de todo

-Respondiendo a la generosidad de Dios

Hace dos mil años, San Pablo le pregunto a su comunidad: "¿Qué tienes que no hayas recibido" (1 Cor 4, 7). Su respuesta - y la nuestra - tendrían que ser: "nada" Cuando realmente reconocemos y creemos que todo lo que somos y todo lo que tenemos es un regalo inmerecido de Dios, nuestros corazones y nuestras vidas cambian para siempre. Nuestra primera respuesta a la bondad y generosidad de Dios es la gratitud y la alegría. Nuestra segunda respuesta es el deseo de responder al amor de Dios.

Conscientes de que todo lo que tenemos es un regalo generoso de Dios nos unimos el salmista (Salmo 116, 12) "¿Cómo pagaré al Señor todo el bien que me ha hecho?". Nunca podremos pagarle a Dios, porque todo le pertenece. Incluso nuestro deseo de dar gracias a Dios es en sí mismo un don de Dios para nosotros; Sin embargo, podemos responder al amor de Dios, compartiendo con generosidad y alegría los dones que Él nos ha confiado. A esto le llamamos generosidad cristiana.

Durante las últimas semanas, hemos sido exhortados a ser buenos administradores de nuestro tiempo y talentos que Dios nos a dado al compartir estos talentos en nuestra parroquia y ministerios al servicio de Dios y de los demás. Hoy en día, con un espíritu de gratitud y alegría, respondemos al amor de Dios al hacer un compromiso y devolverle a Dios una porción generosa de nuestro tesoro.

¿Cuánto devolver?

Damos porque hemos recibido y damos en la medida en que hemos recibido. La tradición del Antiguo Testamento sobre el diezmo, o dar el 10%, es un buen comienzo. Después de todo, Dios siempre nos da el 100% y sólo pide el 10% esto es un buen negocio! Sin embargo, la administración va más allá de los porcentajes. Como dijo el Obispo Fulton J. Sheen, "nunca mida su generosidad por lo que usted da, sino más bien por lo que le queda."

Por favor tome un momento y considere que porcentaje de sus ingresos es el que usted está dando a Dios cada domingo. Una de las recomendaciones es dar un 5% a la iglesia y el 5% a la parroquia y ministerios tales como Servicios Cristianos, PSA y apelaciones misioneras. Si actualmente está dando el 2% o el 3% de sus ingresos, por favor considere aumentarla en un 1% o un 2% cada año. Si ya está dando su parte del diezmo, muchas gracias. Tal vez usted podría vivir con un poco menos, para que los que no tienen nada, puedan tener un poco mas.

¿Cómo se administra?

Cuando damos un regalo a alguien a menudo lo ponemos en un sobre, o en una bolsa de regalo, o lo envolvemos en papel de regalo y escribimos nuestro nombre afuera. Es evidente que nada de esto es necesario; por que el recipiente con mucho gusto aceptaría un regalo sin envolver. Sin embargo, el tiempo y la atención que se invirtió en la preparación de ese regalo se convierten en parte del regalo en sí y demuestra que el receptor es importante para nosotros. De la misma manera, ponemos nuestro dinero en efectivo o cheque en la canasta de la colecta cada domingo y esto también será bien recibido y utilizado sabiamente. Le pido que usted piense acerca del uso de su sobre dominical como una manera de preparar su regalo para Dios. Al igual que los regalos que damos a los demás, los envolvemos y los preparamos, escribimos nuestro nombre y lo damos con orgullo y alegría.

Muchos de nosotros ponemos como prioridad nuestro compromiso financiero con la iglesia a través de donaciones electrónicas. Nuestra ofrenda a Dios y a la iglesia debe estar entre nuestros compromisos primordiales, devolviéndole a Dios nuestros "primeros frutos", no las sobras (cf. Proverbios 3, 9). Por favor considere hoy, apoyar esta su casa que es la iglesia mediante su donación electrónica.

Dios es dueño de todo. Respondamos con gratitud, alegría y generosidad.

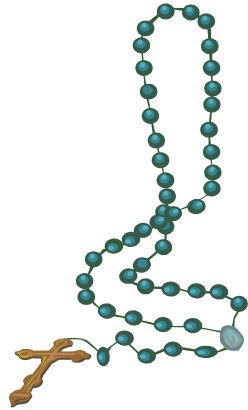

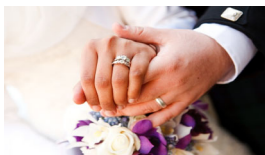
