

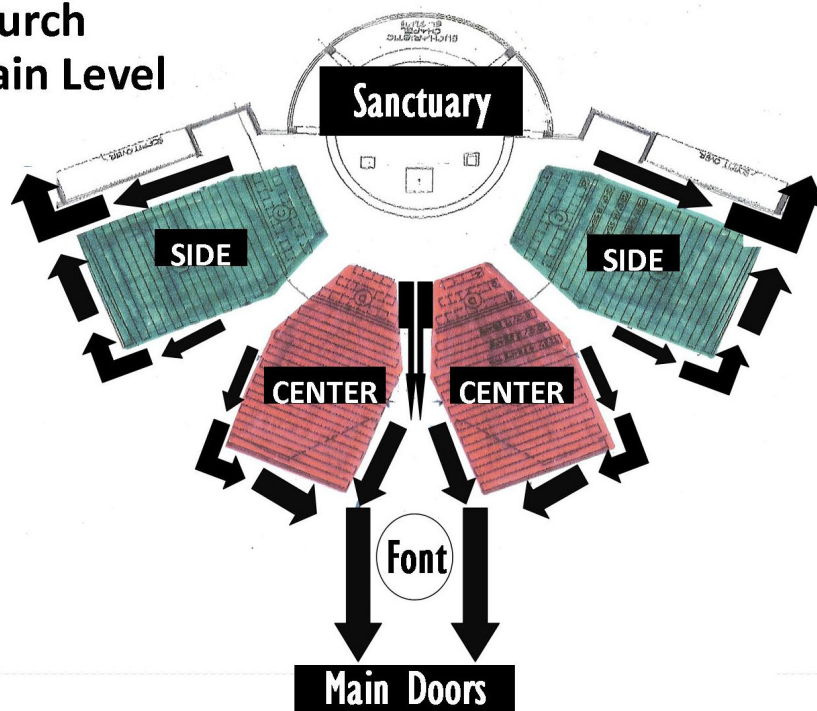

Emergency Evacuation Drill at All Masses This Weekend

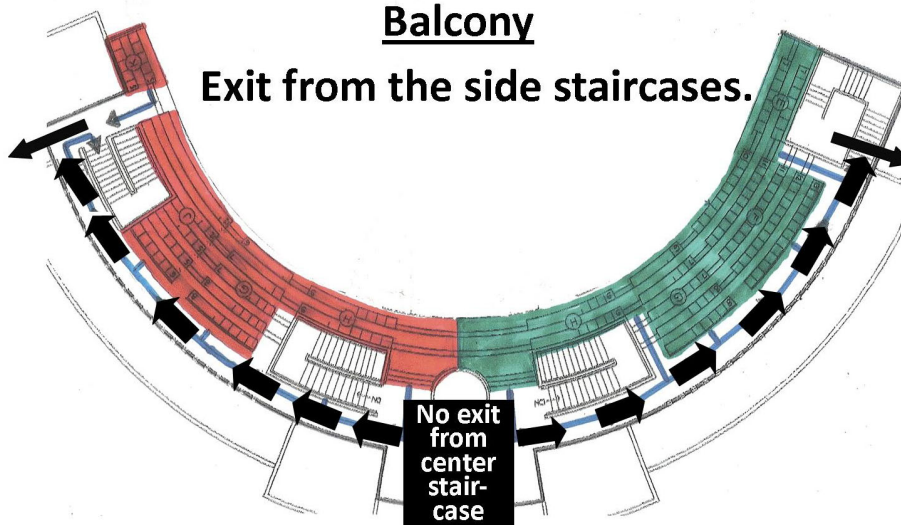

The purpose of the drill is to ensure we are prepared to evacuate everyone from the church for an emergency—be it a fire, earthquake or other emergency. Please review the exit plans on the left so you will know which exit to use based on where you sit in the church.

Sacrament of the Sick

In the event of serious illness or medical emergency, Anointing of the Sick and Eucharist may be arranged by contacting the Parish office. In case of a medical emergency after office hours call **(949) 257-8017**.

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents of infants requesting information about Baptism may contact the Faith Formation office, **496-6011**. Infant Baptisms are celebrated on the first and third Sunday of each month following catechesis for parents and godparents of candidates.

Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish Office, as soon as possible, to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at **496-6011**.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharistic Adoration

On the first and third Monday of each month we gather in prayer and praise before the Blessed Sacrament. The Diocesan intention is that of an increase of vocations to the priesthood and religious life. **Due to the priests' retreat, Adoration on June 2nd will be from 9 a.m.—5:15 p.m.**

SENT TO SERVE

One of the ministries that is completely funded by the Pastoral Services Appeal (PSA) is the **Catholic Restorative Justice and Detention Ministry**. This ministry acts on “when I was in prison and you visited me”. Here’s a summary of this ministry:

Over 300 volunteers (all screened and trained) provide spiritual formation and sacramental life such as Communion Services, Bible Studies, One-on-One visits, Sacramental Preparation, and Retreats.

There are 4,000 Catholic inmates and juveniles on any given day in our county facilities. This ministry tries to see everyone who request visits and those who want to attend classes.

Last year, there were 49,763 people cared for by this ministry with 25,620 hours of services and 56,401 contacts made in four languages at 11 adult jail and juvenile detention facilities in Orange County

This ministry also works with parishes to form support groups to help restore relationships broken by crime including the victim, families, local community and the offender.

Este ministerio actúa "cuando estuve en la cárcel y me visitasteis". He aquí un resumen de este ministerio: Más de 300 voluntarios (todos seleccionados y entrenados) proporcionan formación espiritual y de la vida sacramental, como Servicios de Comunión, estudios bíblicos, visitas de uno-a-uno, Preparación Sacramental, y retiros.

Hay 4.000 presos católicos y jóvenes en un día cualquiera en nuestras instalaciones del condado. Este ministerio trata de ver todos los que soliciten las visitas y los que quieren asistir a clases. El año pasado, había 49.763 personas atendidas por este ministerio con 25.620 horas de servicios y 56.401 contactos realizados en cuatro idiomas a los 11 la cárcel de adultos y centros de detención juvenil en el Condado de Orange.

Este ministerio también trabaja con las parroquias para formar grupos de apoyo para ayudar a restaurar las relaciones rotas por la delincuencia incluyendo a la víctima, las familias, la comunidad local y el delincuente.

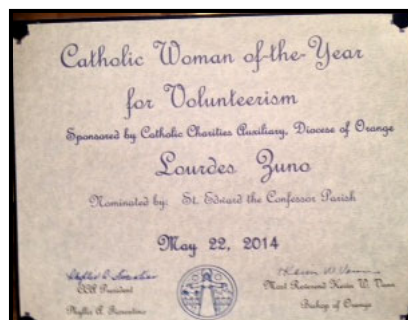
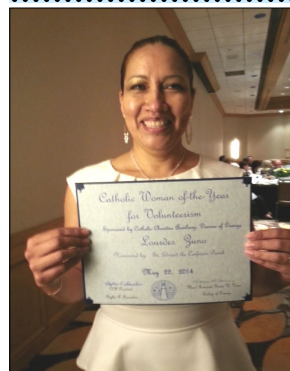

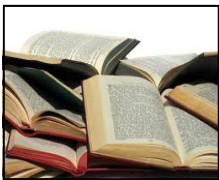

Introducing Dr. Cathy Muzzy—St. Edward Confessor School Principal for 2014-5

Dr. Cathy Muzzy will be the new principal for the 2014-15 school year at St. Edward the Confessor School. As a member of St. Kilian Parish in Mission Viejo, a graduate of St. Catherine of Siena School and Mater Dei High School, Cathy Muzzy has been involved with the Diocese of Orange as a student, parishioner, educator, and parent. Dr. Muzzy and her husband, Steve Muzzy, reside in Coto de Caza with their three children, Tommy (19 – freshman at TCU), Mary (15 – freshman at SMCHS), and Lily (7 – 1st grader at Serra), and their golden retriever, Ellie. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from University of California, Irvine and a Master of Arts in Education with an emphasis in Curriculum and Instruction from Concordia University. She holds a CLAD certificate and a single-subject California Teaching Credential in English.



After eight years of teaching middle school language arts and social studies at Serra Catholic, she moved into an Assistant Principal position where she served for four years prior to accepting the position of Principal, Grades 5-8 in July 2010.

She is an active community member who has served in various leadership roles including South Mission Viejo Little League Board, Santa Margarita Catholic High School Baseball Booster Board, Diocese of Orange Academic Decathlon Planning Committee and Curriculum Committee, SMCHS Consultative Board, SMCHS Pep Squad Team Parent, Eucharistic Ministry at St. Kilian, SMCHS Advancement Committee, Roberto Foundation, and THINK Together. She and her family support several non-profit organizations including those focused on protecting life, encouraging adoption, and developing Catholic education.

Dr. Muzzy has successfully defended her dissertation titled, Implementing Calendar Reform in a Suburban Catholic Elementary School: A Case Study, as the capstone of her doctoral studies in Educational Leadership for Social Justice from Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles. 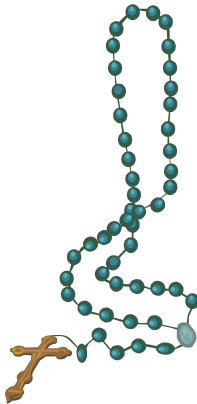

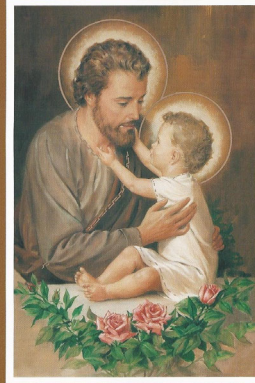
