Infant Baptisms are celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month following catechesis for parents and godparents. Parents of infants should contact the Faith Formation office (949) 496-6011 to enroll.

Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

On the first and third Monday of the month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration at San Felipe de Jesus Chapel on the first Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

- **Commitment Form? Return It!**

If you received a commitment form inside your packet of materials please discern your involvement in the campaign, fill out the card, and return it in the envelope provided.

- **Your Gift Matters!**

Remember, the letter you received from me includes a financial request. It is not an *expectation*. It is an *invitation*. I invite you to pray about your gift. You may not be able to give what was asked; or, you might be able to give much more. The "right" amount is measured by the sacrifice and love with which the gift is given, not the amount of money. No gift is too small or too big. Whatever you decide, please know that your commitment is deeply appreciated and a true blessing to our church!

MONARCH NEWS: LENT PREPERATION

Throughout the 40 days of Lent, The Parish School community is preparing to “Make Room” for Christ by participating in a variety of faith-focused, age-appropriate activities which align with our Parish’s Make Room campaign. Some of the activities include:

- **Make Room for Discipline** – Upon reflection on their personal Lenten promises, learners are collectively presenting their offerings at weekly Friday mass
- **Make Room for Prayer** – Learners are practicing and discovering all forms of prayer and their petitions will be offered up at weekly mass
- **Make Room for Fasting** – Learners are participating in a sacrificial offering of food for Family Assistance Ministries
- **Make Room for Silence & Solitude** – Teachers and students are incorporating silence and mindful meditation in class
- **Make Room for Deep Learning** – While studying scripture, each grade level team will carry a scroll at mass that includes one meaningful scripture passage collectively chosen by the grade level
- **Make Room for Pascal Mystery & Triduum** – Learners will reflect upon and engage in a meaningful Holy Week, including attending Mass, saying Lenten Prayers and participating in a Prayer Partner activity

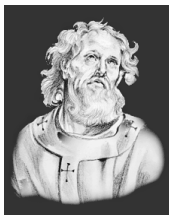

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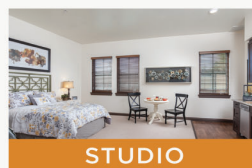
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
