This week we come to another stage of preparation to use our new Pastoral Center and Knight Hall. The building will contain (among other things) thirteen rooms that will be available for ministry meetings and activities. The rooms will all be numbered for easy reference and location, but we want to identify the rooms in another, more meaningful way as well. We want to name each room after a saint!

This is where you come in. You, the parishioners of St. Edward the Confessor and San Felipe de Jesús, are invited to submit the names of five saints you would like to have represented in our naming of the rooms. Each household may submit up to five saints' names, and on August 21st we will tally up how many "votes" each saint gets. In this way we will determine the thirteen most popular saints; their names will go on the thirteen rooms we have available.

This is a good time for you to discuss with your family the possible saints whose names you will submit. I can imagine great conversations in which people discuss their favorite saints and the reasons why they are favorites. The internet is filled with good sites that give the lives of the saints, so there is no lack of reference material. Rosy will keep track of all submissions, and I am really looking forward to August 21st, when we will be able to give meaningful names to the rooms you will be using for many years to come.

Dear Friends,

I would like to update you on the financial status of our Pastoral Center and Narthex project. Every week in the bulletin we have included the project cost estimate, along with current information regarding pledges and donations. The original project cost estimate has been correctly listed as \$16,345,000. However, the latest update I have received from the Project Manager states that the projected cost has gone up to \$17,692,759. The additional \$1,347,759 is the result of rising prices in material and labor, as well as items added to the hall to make it functional. (Remember, the original estimate was made over 4 years ago, and costs have risen since then.)

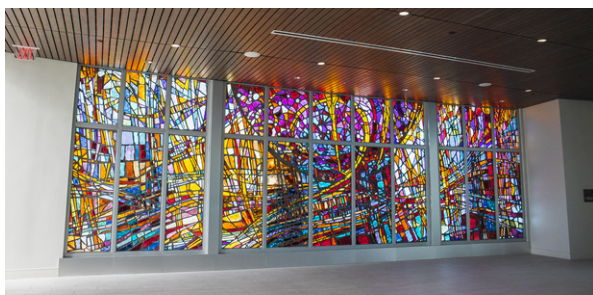
Where will the additional funds come from? Part of the answer lies in a piece of real estate, a condominium in Capistrano Beach that the parish has owned ever since San Felipe de Jesús became part of St. Edward the Confessor. We have been renting out the condo, using the rent money for parish outreach. Along with the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council, I decided to ask the bishop's permission to sell this property and use the resulting income for our Pastoral Center. The bishop has approved this sale. We hope this will bring in close to \$1,000,000.

Another \$1,000,000 is coming to us from an account we set up with the Orange Catholic Foundation several years ago, for the expressed purpose of funding a project such as this. The OCF gladly sent us a check from our account, and with this we feel that the funding of our Pastoral Center and Narthex is secure.

Of course, we are counting on those who have made pledges to continue with their payments, and we also want to offer you a new opportunity to take part in this project. How would you like to sponsor one of the panes of stained glass in the Narthex? There are 22 panes of glass; you may sponsor one of the 11 smaller ones (along the top of the window) for \$5000 apiece, or one of the larger ones (along the bottom of the window) for \$10,000 apiece. You may even choose which of the panels you want to sponsor. A plaque will be set up to the left of the window, giving your name or the name of the person to whom you are dedicating the window.
