Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

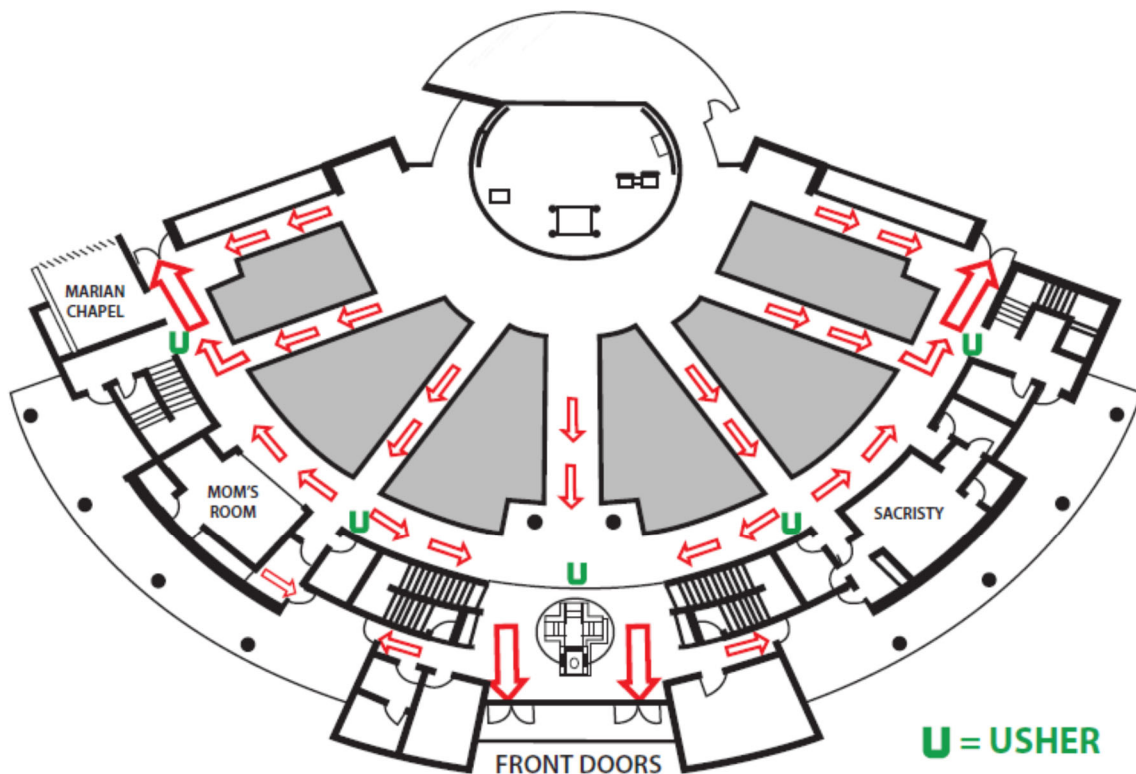
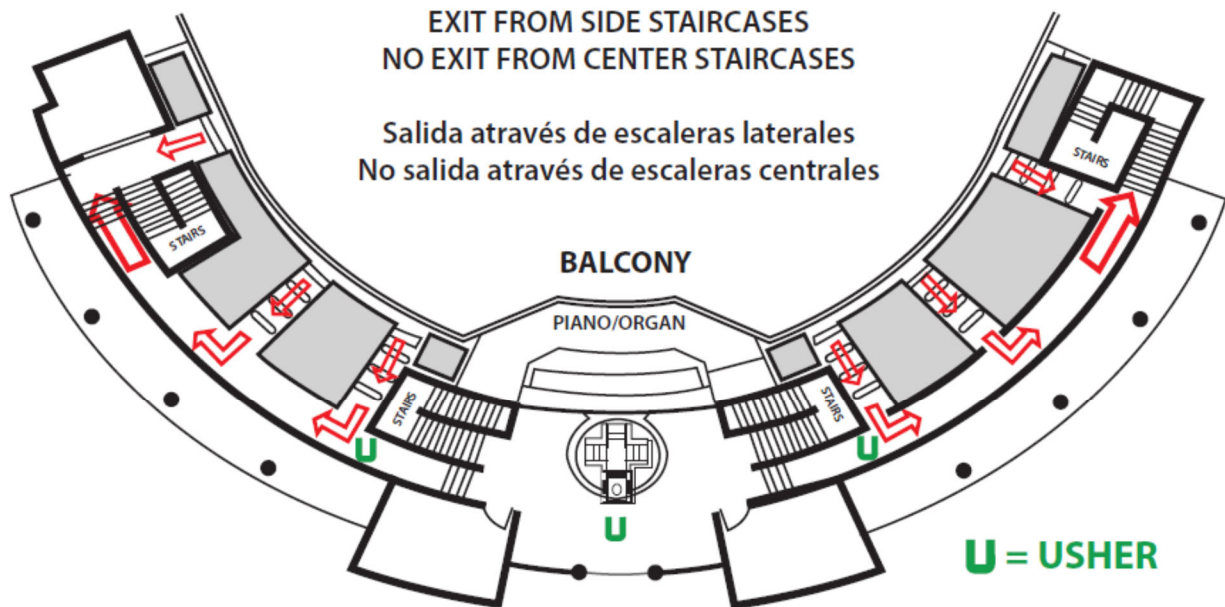

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

1. Remain Calm.
2. In a catastrophic event, a safe place may be under the pew until informed to evacuate the Church.
3. Consider staying hunkered down protecting your head with the pew, your hands, a book, your coat, your purse, etc.
4. When advised to EVACUATE by the Presider or other parish official, please look for your Usher (behind you in the rear/exit aisles).
5. Walk orderly and calmly, taking smaller children by the hand, and proceed to your Usher following all directions to the nearest exit.
6. Upon exiting the Church, proceed to the School-side of the parking lot. When safe, then proceed to your cars.
7. Please keep the parking lot and streets around the parish clear for emergency vehicles to arrive on the scene.
8. Account for all in your party. Report to an Usher or parish official if anyone is missing from your party.

PROCEDIMIENTO DE EVACUACION

1. Mantenga la calma
2. En un evento catastrófico, un lugar seguro puede ser debajo de su banca permanezca ahí hasta que se lo informe evacuar la iglesia.
3. Considere quedarse agachado protegiendo su cabeza debajo de la banca, con sus manos, con un libro, con su abrigo, o su bolso, etc.
4. Cuando el Sacerdote u otro funcionario de la parroquia le pida que EVACUE, busque al Ujier (en los pasillos de salida posteriores a usted).
5. Camine ordenadamente y con calma, tome a los niños más pequeños de la mano, y proceda con el Ujier siguiendo todas las indicaciones hasta la salida más cercana.
6. Al salir de la iglesia, diríjase al lado izquierdo del estacionamiento de la escuela. Cuando este seguro, proceda a su automóvil.
7. Por favor, mantenga el estacionamiento y las calles alrededor de la parroquia despejadas para que los vehículos de emergencia lleguen al lugar.
8. Asegúrese que todos sus familiares estén con usted. Informe a un Ujier o funcionario de la parroquia si falta alguien en su grupo.

Please join us for this Silent Retreat offering a morning of prayer, reflection and inspiration.

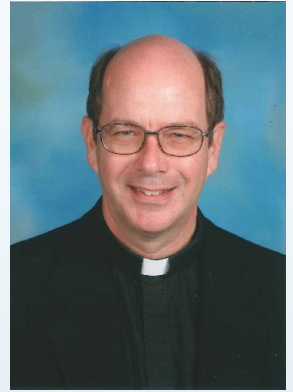

Full of Grace

When the Angel Gabriel spoke to the Virgin Mary at the Annunciation, the angel greeted her with the words, "Hail, full of grace." When we repeat these words in one of our best-known Catholic prayers, we add her name: "Hail, *Mary*, full of grace." The fact that the angel did not use her name does not diminish the greeting given to Mary; it simply shows us the key to her identity: she was filled with the life and love of God.



The Easter Season gives special emphasis to the reality of our Baptism, since it is the cornerstone of our identity as Christians. In Baptism the life and love of God enters us in a particularly strong way, making us "full of grace." As Christians, we have a special relationship with God and also with everyone who shares the life of grace. This includes a special relationship with the Virgin Mary.

Are we still full of grace? Well, we are not perfect. We do our best to cultivate the life of grace God gives us. As we do so, it is only right that we look to Mary, who is the Mother of all Christians. The month of May is especially dedicated to her, so this is a good time to remind ourselves that the Mother of Christ is our mother as well. She looks out for us and prays to her Son with us and for us. Pray an extra "Hail Mary" every now and then during this month as a powerful expression of faith that our holy Mother prays for us "now and at the hour of our death."

Llena de Gracia

Cuando el Ángel Gabriel habló a la Virgen María en la Anunciación, el ángel la saludó con las palabras: "Dios te salve, llena de gracia". Cuando repetimos estas palabras en una de nuestras oraciones católicas más conocidas, agregamos su nombre: " Dios te salve, María, llena de gracia". El hecho de que el ángel no usara su nombre no disminuye el saludo que se le dio a María; simplemente nos muestra la clave de su identidad, estaba llena de la vida y el amor de Dios.

El tiempo de Pascua pone un énfasis especial a la realidad de nuestro Bautismo, ya que es la piedra angular de nuestra identidad como cristianos. En el Bautismo, la vida y el amor de Dios nos entran de una manera particularmente fuerte, haciéndonos "llenos de gracia". Como cristianos, tenemos una relación especial con Dios y también con todos los que comparten la vida de gracia. Esto incluye una relación especial con la Virgen María.



¿Estamos todavía llenos de gracia? Bueno, no somos perfectos. Hacemos nuestro mejor esfuerzo para cultivar la vida de gracia que Dios nos da. Al hacerlo, es justo que miremos a María, que es la Madre de todos los cristianos. El mes de mayo está especialmente dedicado a ella, por lo que este es un buen momento para recordarnos que la Madre de Cristo también es nuestra madre. Ella nos cuida y reza a su Hijo con nosotros y por nosotros. Reza un "Ave María" adicional de vez en cuando durante este mes como una poderosa expresión de fe que nuestra santa Madre ora por nosotros "ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte".

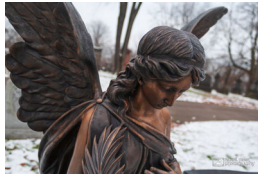

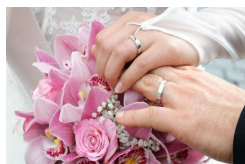

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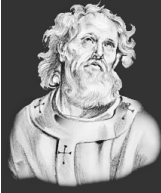
