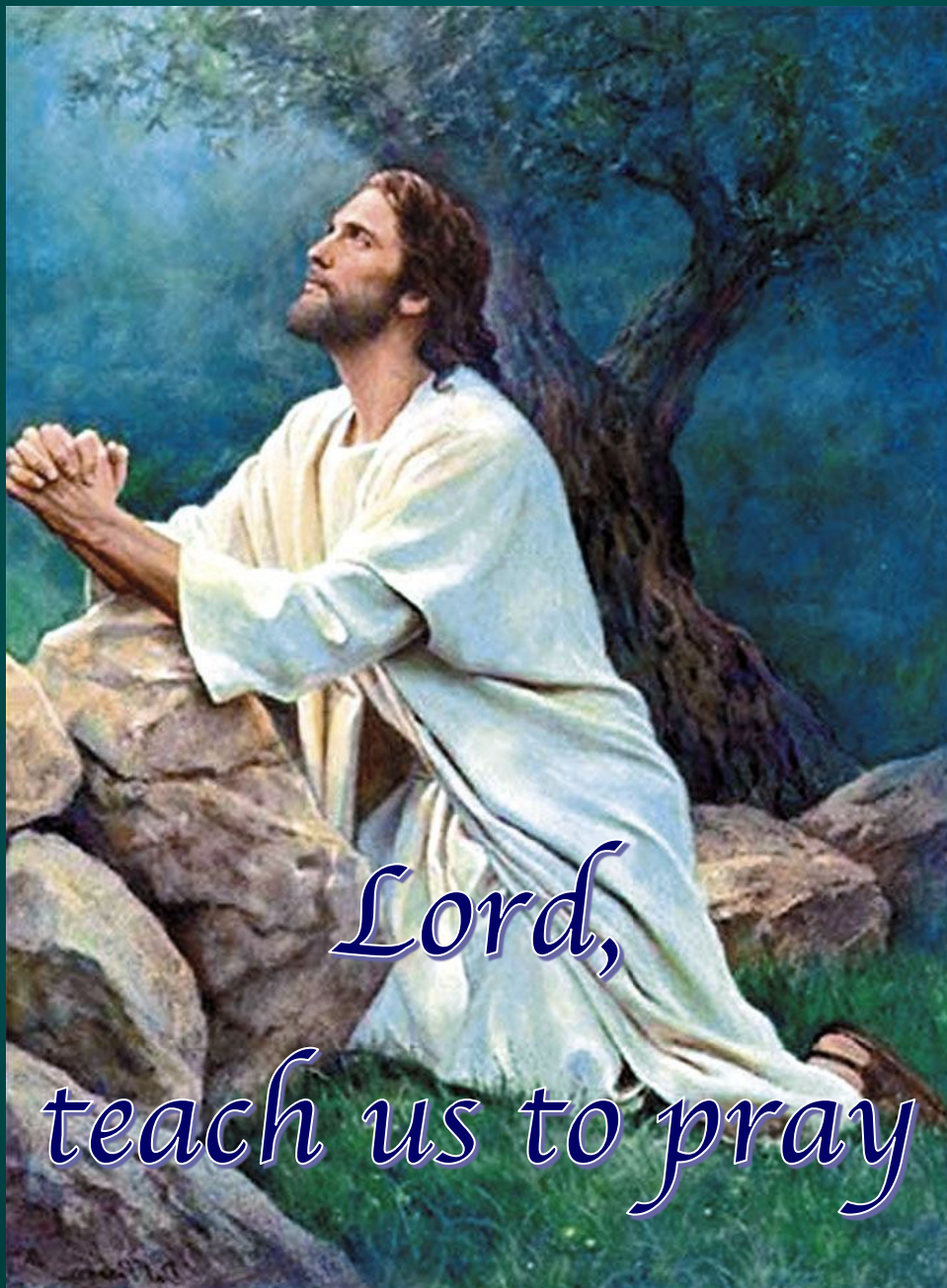

Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

LAUNDRY LOVE

On the first Sunday of every month our St. Edward Social Justice Ministry meets at a local laundromat from noon to two-thirty to help our homeless and working poor neighbors do their laundry. Our St. Edward outreach ministry provides funding for the quarters and detergent which we

provide for them to wash and dry their clothes and bedding. Among them are all the ingredients of the poor and marginalized: families with small children, alcoholics, addicts, the mentally ill, folks living in their cars while holding down jobs, veterans and quiet loners. We enjoy our time with these neighbors in need while the machines hum and spin away the dirt and detritus of living on the hard. We get to hear their stories of woe and humor, of loss and of surprising kindness. We find a distinct joy being with them for this time; a combination of gratitude and unity as Jesus continues to disguise himself among us.

I thank God for this great opportunity that grants me the ability to be with you and to celebrate our faith in the various moments, needs and celebrations together.

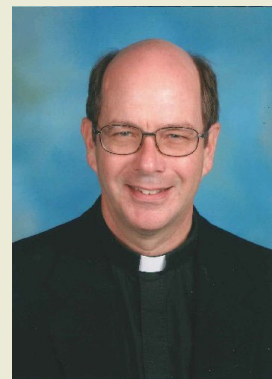

We Must Pray

Several weeks ago, a conversation got me thinking. Someone had been to a weekday Mass and had heard the name of a friend given as the intention of the Mass. Afterward, the person came to the parish office to ask if their friend was okay. As far as I knew, the friend was fine. But that got us talking about the fact that when we are asked to pray for someone, it's easy to assume that something must be wrong with the person. In reality, we might be asked to pray for them because it's their birthday or anniversary, or simply because it is a good and holy thing to support one another with our prayers. The Scriptures repeatedly remind us to pray for one another; this is one of the ways we fulfill the Lord's commandment to love one another.



Jesus teaches us about prayer in the gospel of this weekend. This gives us a good motive to review the place of prayer in our lives. Four reasons for prayer are abbreviated in the word ACTS: Adoration, Contrition, Thanksgiving, and Supplication. The supplication (asking) may be for ourselves or for another; and sometimes our prayer for another is simply that God may bless them in every way.

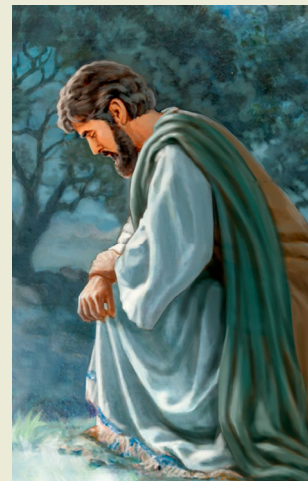
In this spirit, I renew my pledge to pray for you and I humbly ask you to pray for me; and I hope all of us will pray for one another in all circumstances of daily life.
