

I hope you are making time each day for extra prayer as well, and I hope we will all continue to cultivate the Advent spirit of joyful hope all the way to Christmas Eve.



The Advent Season - Week 2

REV. JOSEPH SQUILLACIOTI, S.T.L.



This week's First Reading and Gospel focus on the prophecy of Isaiah and its fulfilment in John the Baptist. The connection between old and new, Isaiah and John work well with the imagery put forth in the Rod of Jesse and the Key of David. They show first the lineage prophesized by Isaiah and role of the Messiah in salvation along with his binding and loosing as the "Key" of David.

O come thou Rod of Jesse's stem ...

This verse gives us an allusion to the history lesson surrounding Jesse (the father of King David) as part of the Davidic Kingdom from which Christ was born. During the Babylonian Exile, the Davidic Kingdom was destroyed. As with any tree which is cut down to the stump, the root continues to live. From this root or family, (Rod of Jesse, O Radix Jesse) a Saviour shall be born. This root for us becomes the Virgin Mary from which its flower (Christ Jesus) comes forth.

O Flower of Jesse's stem, you have been raised up as a sign for all peoples; kings stand silent in your presence; the nations bow down in worship before you. Come, let nothing keep you from coming to our aid.

Isaiah gave this prophecy: But a shoot shall sprout from the stump of Jesse, and from his roots a bud shall blossom. (Isaiah 11:1), and On that day, the root of Jesse, set up as a signal for the nations, the Gentiles shall seek out, for his dwelling shall be glorious. (Isaiah 11:10). Remember also that Jesse was the father of King David, and Micah had prophesied that the Messiah would be of the house

and lineage of David and be born in David's city, Bethlehem (Micah 5:1).

O come thou Key of David, come...

With the Key of David, the Clavis David, we see not the lineage of the Messiah coming from the root Jesse through the kingship of David, but the function of this Messiah. The Messiah in this verse as described by Isaiah has a binding and loosing function. The power of Christ as a deliverer from death and the devil is evident. We pray in this time that this "Key" comes to lead us out of captivity and our prisons of sin, and take us out of the shadow of death.

O Key of David, O royal Power of Israel controlling at your will the gate of Heaven: Come, break down the prison walls of death for those who dwell in darkness and the shadow of death; and lead your captive people into freedom.

Prophesied by Isaiah: I will place the Key of the House of David on His shoulder; when he opens, no one will shut, when he shuts, no one will open. (Isaiah 22:22), and His dominion is vast and forever peaceful, from David's throne, and over His kingdom, which he confirms and sustains by judgment and justice, both now and forever. (Isaiah 9:6).



As the Root of Jesse brings forth the blossoming bud- the Messiah, the Virgin Mary as the Root of Jesse, brings forth the Blossom of her womb, Jesus the Christ.


