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The Pope's Message for Lent

In preparation for this holy season, I read the special message written by Pope Francis for Lent 2022. The Holy Father begins his message by quoting from St. Paul: "Let us not grow tired of doing good, for in due time we shall reap our harvest, if we do not give up. So then, while we have the opportunity let us do good to all." (Gal. 6:9-10) Pope Francis goes on to say, "Lent invites us to conversion, to a change in mindset, so that life's truth and beauty may be found not so much in possessing as in giving, not so much in accumulating as in sowing and sharing goodness."

Meditating on St. Paul's words, "Let us not grow tired of doing good," Pope Francis gives specific applications of these words. He writes, "Let us not grow tired of praying," adding that "we need to pray because we need God." Then the Holy Father writes, "Let us not grow tired of uprooting evil from our lives," adding two specific areas of concentration: "Let us not grow tired of asking for forgiveness in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, knowing that God never tires of forgiving"; and "Let us not grow tired of fighting against concupiscence," in particular the temptation to "addiction to the digital media, which impoverishes human relationships." Finally, Pope Francis says, "Let us not grow tired of doing good in active charity towards our neighbors," adding that "Lent is a favorable time to seek out—and not to avoid—those in need; to reach out—and not to ignore—those who need a sympathetic ear and a good word; to visit—and not to abandon—those who are lonely."

By quoting these points from the message of Pope Francis, I hope to invite you to find specific ways in which you can apply these words to your lives, as I also seek to apply them to mine. May this Lent be a time in which we never grow tired of doing good!

Mensaje del Papa para la Cuaresma

En preparación para esta temporada santa, leo el mensaje escrito por el Papa Francisco para la Cuaresma de 2022. El Santo Padre comienza su mensaje citando a San Pablo: "No nos cansemos de hacer el bien, porque a su tiempo cosecharemos lo que hemos sembrado, si es que no nos damos por vencidos antes. Así que, mientras tengamos la oportunidad, hagamos el bien a todos". (Gálatas 6:9-10) El Papa Francisco continúa diciendo: "La Cuaresma nos invita a la conversión, a un cambio de mentalidad, para que la verdad y la belleza de la vida se encuentren no tanto en poseer como en dar, no tanto en acumular como en sembrar y compartir el bien".

Meditando en las palabras de San Pablo, "No nos cansemos de hacer el bien", el Papa Francisco da instrucciones específicas de estas palabras. Él escribe: "No nos cansemos de orar", y agrega que "necesitamos orar porque necesitamos a Dios". Luego el Santo Padre escribe: "No nos cansemos de arrancar el mal de nuestra vida", añadiendo dos áreas específicas de concentración: "No nos cansemos de pedir perdón en el Sacramento de la Penitencia y la Reconciliación, sabiendo que Dios nunca se cansa de perdonar"; y "No nos cansemos de luchar contra la concupiscencia", en particular la tentación de "la adicción a los medios digitales, que empobrece las relaciones humanas". Finalmente, el Papa Francisco dice: "No nos cansemos de hacer el bien en la caridad activa hacia nuestro prójimo", y agrega que "La Cuaresma es un tiempo propicio para buscar, y no para evitar, a los necesitados; tender la mano, y no ignorar, a aquellos que necesitan un oído comprensivo y una buena palabra; visitar, y no abandonar, a los que están solos".

Al citar estos puntos del mensaje del Papa Francisco, espero invitarlos a encontrar formas específicas en las que puedan aplicar estas palabras a sus vidas, como también busco aplicarlas a la mía. ¡Que esta Cuaresma sea un tiempo en el que nunca nos cansemos de hacer el bien!

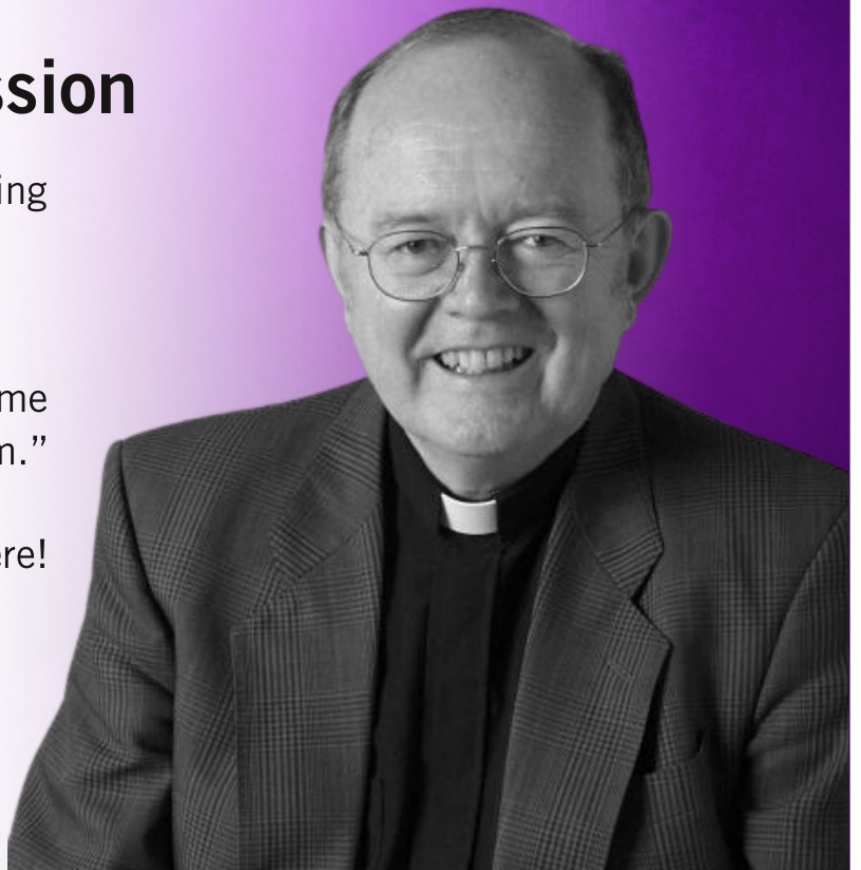
