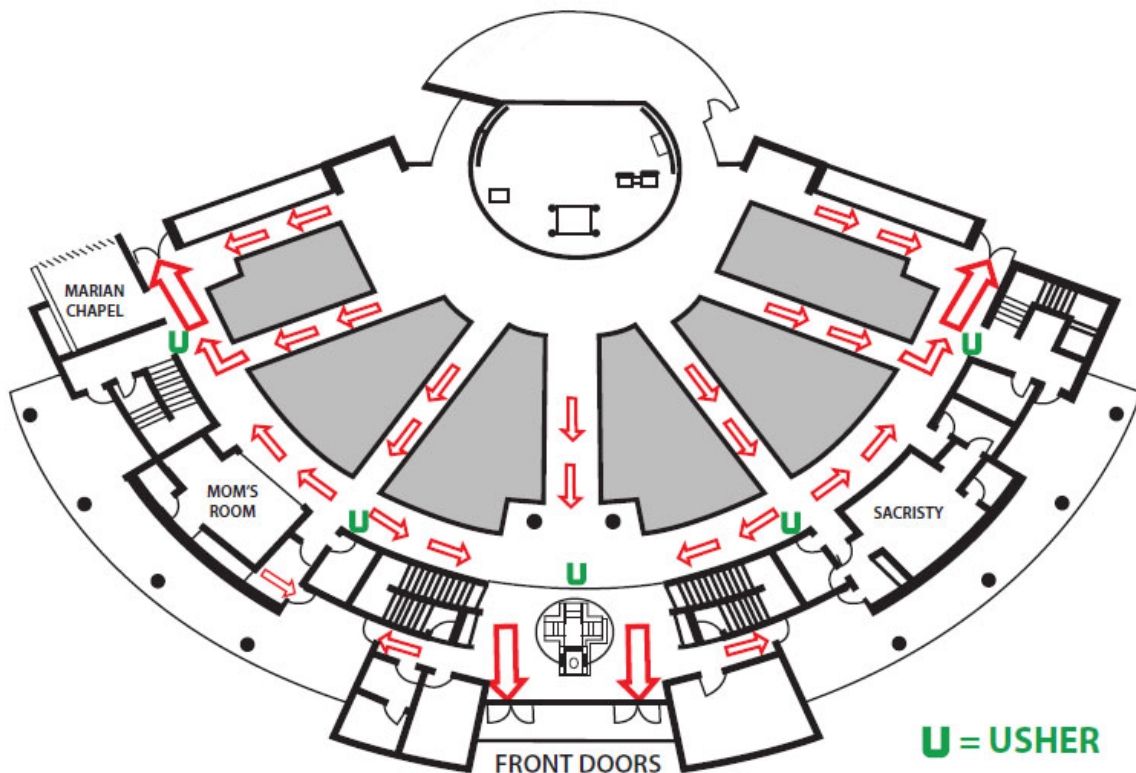
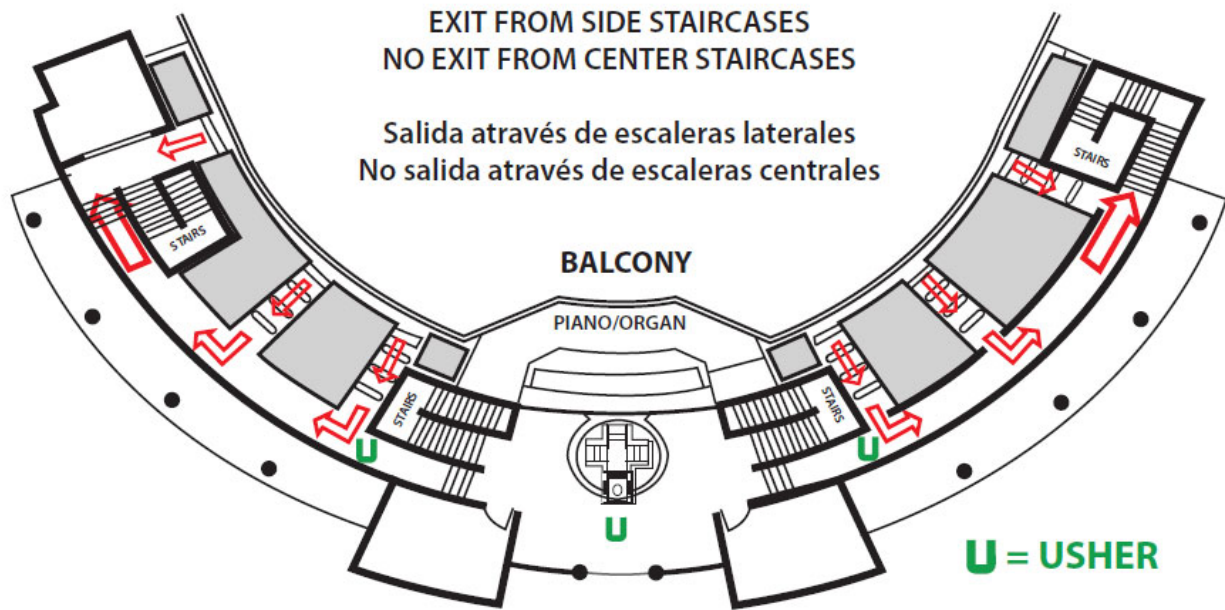

EMERGENCY Evacuation Drill at all Masses
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EVACUATION PROCEDURES

1. Remain Calm.
2. In a catastrophic event, a safe place may be under the pew until informed to evacuate the Church.
3. Consider staying hunkered down protecting your head with the pew, your hands, a book, your coat, your purse, etc.
4. When advised to EVACUATE by the Presider or other parish official, please look for your Usher (behind you in the rear/exit aisles).
5. Walk orderly and calmly, taking smaller children by the hand, and proceed to your Usher following all directions to the nearest exit.
6. Upon exiting the Church, proceed to the School-side of the parking lot. When safe, then proceed to your cars.
7. Please keep the parking lot and streets around the parish clear for emergency vehicles to arrive on the scene.
8. Account for all in your party. Report to an Usher or parish official if anyone is missing from your party.

PROCEDIMIENTO DE EVACUACION

1. Mantenga la calma
2. En un evento catastrófico, un lugar seguro puede ser debajo de su banca permanezca ahí hasta que se le informe evacuar la iglesia.
3. Considere quedarse agachado protegiendo su cabeza debajo de la banca, con sus manos, con un libro, con su abrigo, o su bolso, etc.
4. Cuando el Sacerdote u otro funcionario de la parroquia le pida que EVACUE, busque al Ujier (en los pasillos de salida posteriores a usted).
5. Camine ordenadamente y con calma, tome a los niños más pequeños de la mano, y proceda con el Ujier siguiendo todas las indicaciones hasta la salida más cercana.
6. Al salir de la iglesia, diríjase al lado izquierdo del estacionamiento de la escuela. Cuando este seguro, proceda a su automóvil.
7. Por favor, mantenga el estacionamiento y las calles alrededor de la parroquia despejadas para que los vehículos de emergencia lleguen al lugar.
8. Asegúrese que todos sus familiares estén con usted. Informe a un Ujier o funcionario de la parroquia si falta alguien en su grupo.

Sacrament of Matrimony

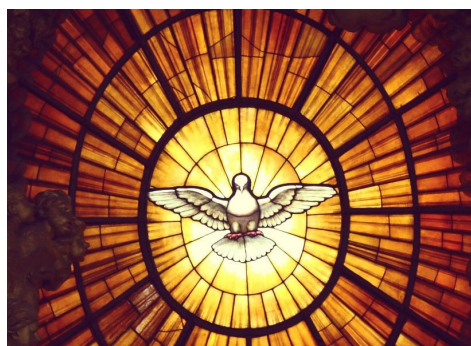

MONARCH NEWS: Once on This Island, Jr. Debuts to Sell-Out Crowds

This year's Spring Musical debuted to a sell-out audience who packed the gym to see the more than 50 Parish School students perform *Once on This Island, Jr.* According to Spring Musical director and choreographer Kasey Rojas, the show was chosen because "of its lessons in diversity and culture. The cast learned that even though the peasants were poor, they were rich in so many other ways."

Monarch Theater's Spring Musical production is an after-school program that starts in January with twice-a-week rehearsals. The week of the musical, they start tech week, where the cast practices on the full-size stage with sound, lighting and costumes. Not only does tech week prepare them for the production, but the four-hour rehearsals create a unique bond amongst the cast. The day of their first evening performance, The Parish School learners were treated to a sneak-peak of the performance allowing the cast to get out their pre-show nerves.



Audiences enjoyed three showings of *Once on This Island*, all of which sold out. The production was filled with fabulous performances, upbeat music and vibrant costumes! In addition to the actors and actresses, learners also served as directors, stage crew, wardrobe, props and dance managers. Whether they were bringing dinner during Tech Week, or assisting with hair, makeup or photography, parent volunteers were also an integral part of the show's success. The Spring Musical is a direct result of the Monarch Main Event funds at work which in 2017 supported the Arts.

Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ

Questions and Answers

What is the Holy Eucharist?

The Eucharist is a sacrament, a sacrifice, and a sacred banquet. Under the appearance of bread and wine our Savior Jesus Christ is entirely present in this sacrament, body and blood, soul and divinity. In this sacrament He offers Himself in sacrifice to the Father, and is received as spiritual nourishment.

Why is the Eucharist the center of Catholic life?

The Eucharist is the center of Catholic life precisely because Christ is the center of all our life. In this sacrament Christ gives Himself totally, that we might share His life and be bound together in His mystical body. "

Do I have to go confession before receiving Communion?

To receive the sacrament of Communion worthily one must be a baptized Catholic in the state of grace and believe what the Church teaches about this sacrament. One conscious of having committed a mortal sin must make a sacramental confession before approaching the sacrament. A mortal sin is any sin whose matter is grave and which has been committed willfully and with knowledge of its seriousness.

Do you have to fast before Mass?

Yes, the Church directs us to abstain from food and drink (except for water and medicine) for at least one hour before Communion.

Can you receive Communion if you are divorced?

By itself civil divorce is not an obstacle to Communion. However, in fidelity to the words of Jesus Christ—"Whoever divorces his wife and marries another, commits adultery against her; and if she divorces her husband and marries another, she commits adultery"—the Church maintains that a new union cannot be recognized as valid, if the first marriage was. For that reason, a person who divorces and remarries cannot receive Communion unless the Church declares that a person's prior marriage was not valid (i.e. it was nullified by the Church).

At the same time, Pope Francis reminds us that "it is important that the divorced who have entered a new union should be made to feel part of the Church. They are not excommunicated and they should not be treated as such, since they remain part of the ecclesial community."

How do I get more out of Mass?

We will get more out of Mass if we give more of ourselves to God at Mass. Mass is a holy exchange: God not only changes bread and wine into His Body and Blood but he also wants to transform us. In order for that to happen, we need to freely and intentionally offer and unite ourselves to Christ together with the bread and wine. We give ourselves to God at Mass when we give him our personal prayers, joys, suffering, and intentions. The offering of money is also important because it is the fruit of our work and a vital source of our livelihood. Giving back to God not only reflects the fact that everything belongs to him but it is a way of entrusting our life, our livelihood, to him. Get more out of Mass by giving more of yourself to God at Mass. What are you bringing to God today?

How can I participate or volunteer in honoring Jesus?
