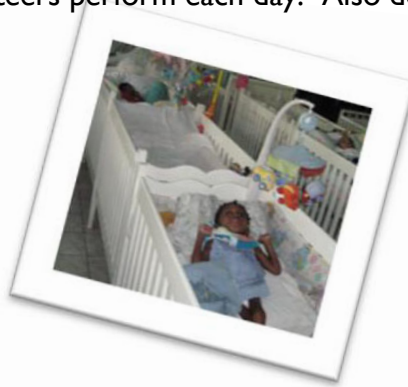
Informational Meeting ~ Thursday August 14
