Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

Eucharistic Adoration

On the first and third Monday of the month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration at San Felipe de Jesus Chapel on the first Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

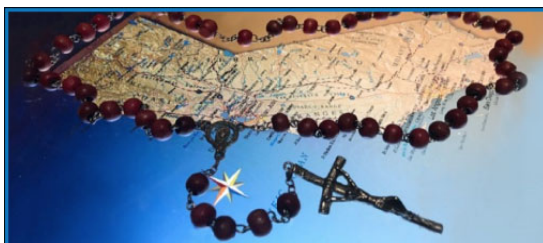
Consecration of California to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

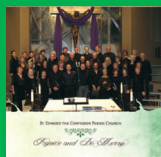

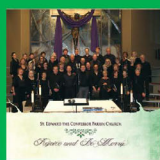

On Saturday, November 11, more than 350 parents, staff and friends of The Parish School attended the annual Monarch Main Event at the Dana Point Laguna Cliffs Marriott for an evening of fellowship and fundraising, with proceeds benefitting the school's music program, the annual Spring Musical, and art classes.

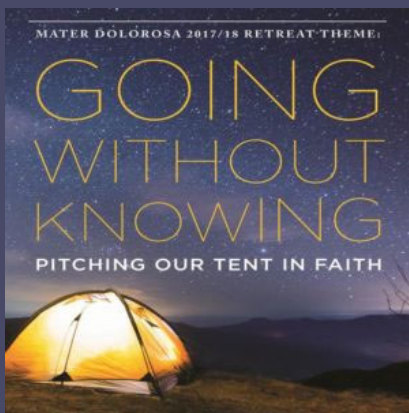

Society of St. Vincent de Paul St. Edward Conference

Who we are: The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is an international, Catholic volunteer organization composed of women and men who strive to grow spiritually by offering person-to-person service to individuals in need. In this essential way, the Society differs from charitable associations or agencies whose principal objective is not the spiritual advancement of their members but the doing of good for someone else. Vincentians come from every ethnic and cultural background, age group, and economic level but are united by their spirit of poverty, humility and sharing, which is nourished by prayer and reflection, mutually supportive gatherings.

What we do: Guided by the credo of "*No Act of Charity is Foreign to the Society*".., we offer tangible assistance to those in need on a person-to-person basis. It is our personalized involvement that makes the work of the Society unique. This aid may take the form of intervention, consultation, or often through direct dollar or in-kind service. An essential precept of our work is to provide help while conscientiously maintaining the confidentiality and dignity of those we serve. Our St. Edward Conference:

- † Provides bus passes, gift cards or funds to help with rent, medical expenses, car repair, utilities and other items for the needy and under-employed in our church area.
- † Makes home visits to evaluate our clients' physical and spiritual needs..
- † Distributes toys to needy children during Christmas.
- † Sends 20-25 children to SVP camps during the summer.
- † Provides motel stays and other accommodations for the homeless and displaced.
- † Helps find jobs for the disadvantaged.
- † Connects the disadvantaged to helpful resources.
- † Provides legal assistance thru our contacts.
- † Act as advocates for people when requested.
- † Give scholarships.
- † Helps with funerals.

Our Society Is Almost 200 Years Old



The Society of St. Vincent de Paul was founded in Paris, France in 1833 by a 20-year old student, Frederic Ozanam. Challenged by the poverty he saw on the streets, and by his contemporaries who believed the Church no longer demonstrated an active faith in works of charity, Frederic organized the first "Conference of Charity" to help the poor of all religions created by the industrial revolution, as well as create an avenue that assisted people to express their faith and grow spiritually through acts of charity. Frederic named his conferences after the great French Saint, Vincent de Paul, who was known for his heroic goodness to the poor.

Today, the Society is a Catholic, international volunteer organization with more than 800,000 members in 140 countries, and a mission to "seek and find the forgotten, the suffering or the deprived."

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul is a 501(c3) non-profit organization.
