

The California Legislature put Proposition 1 on the November ballot. Proposition 1 would amend the California Constitution to establish a right to reproductive freedom, which is defined to include a right to an abortion and to choose or refuse contraceptives. This would remove the current ban on Abortion in California after 24 weeks, and could allow for taxpayer-funded abortion up until birth.

A "no" vote on Proposition 1 keeps existing California law on abortion the way it is now.


