Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

On the first and third Monday of each month for 24 hours beginning after 8:15 a.m. Mass. Adoration in San Felipe the 1st Friday of every month 8 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

Renovating and Strengthening Our House of the Poor

On the weekend of September 27th, I presented our parish goals at all of the Masses. One of our goals is to grow more and more into a House of the Poor where the “least among us” will find in each of us as individuals, families, and a parish, the spiritual and material support they need. However, our goal is not simply to do more; instead we have been re-envisioning our purpose and approach to outreach.

On the next page of this bulletin, Deacon Al Scaduto announces a new and exciting step we are taking towards this goal. Please read it and consider how you would like to get involved. This Jubilee Year of Mercy is the perfect time to recommit ourselves to the poor by sharing the time, talent, and treasure that God has entrusted to us.

New Outreach Council – In Service to God and the Poor

Jesus’ twofold commandment of loving God and neighbor is fulfilled primarily through worship and service. Our parish has a Liturgy Committee lead by Fr. Dave Gruver and consisting of liturgical leaders such as lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, ushers, music ministers, and altar servers. The purpose of the Liturgy Committee is to help foster our full, active, conscience worship of God through liturgical prayer (primarily the Mass).

In order to help us better live out the commandment of loving our neighbor with a focus on the poor, I recently formed an Outreach Council.

The Outreach Council is a consultative body which assists the Pastor in his stewardship of the poor in local, national and international communities. The incipient Council will create and recommend a structured plan that:

- (1) includes short and long-term chartable priorities and goals
- (2) creates guidelines to – and will itself - evaluate and respond to requests for outreach assistance
- (3) focuses on outreach opportunities which provide systemic change/improvements
- (4) communicates the Outreach Plan and progress to parishioners for the purpose of providing transparency and encouraging every parishioner to be good stewards of the poor by sharing their God-given time, talent and treasure with those in need.

The members of the Outreach Council are: Deacon Al Scaduto (Chairman), Maria Schinderle, Kim Thress, Jesse Perez, and Bob Smart.

"Who of you will help the poor amongst us?"



Come join us on a compelling new venture to offer those who yearn for a more fulfilling and dignified life.

As this year comes to an end and a New Year begins, are you looking for a way to make a life changing difference for those who are suffering right here in our community?

In keeping with the theme of "House of the Poor", we are very excited about a pilot program, which will commence early next year.

St. Edward's parish is entering into this program with Family Assistance Ministries (FAM), in San

Clemente. FAM is a faith-based, nonprofit organization that has a long record of successfully aiding the poor, feeding the hungry, and sheltering the homeless in this area. Over the past few years outreach services to the poor and homeless have taken on a new dynamic. Technology has provided instant access to a wide range of resources and has enhanced case managers' ability to provide long-term care and planning to aid those who seek a path out of poverty. FAM is linked to many databases throughout Orange County and the state that gives them the ability to seek long-term solutions. Their goal is to offer personalized supportive counseling to aid clients in bridging the gap from dependency to self-sufficiency.

This partnership will augment St. Edward's Christian Services and the Saint Vincent de Paul ministries. For many years, dedicated and compassionate volunteers have administered these ministries. Their focus has been and will continue be to offer emergency assistance. They have done a remarkable job of providing food, rental assistance, hotel rooms and many other services when desperate people had nowhere else to go. This new partnership with FAM will now add another level of assistance, which up to now, was not available.

We are seeking 12 parish volunteers who are willing to serve twice a month for a 3-hour shift. It will be held at our San Felipe de Jesus Chapel midday every Friday. San Felipe was selected because it is more accessible via the OCTA bus lines, it is walking distance to some of our poorest neighborhoods and readily available to the homeless of our community.

Commencing in January, FAM will provide orientation for those who want to be case managers and/or assist in distributing food and clothing. Based on the response we receive, we hope to begin serving "the least among us" by February.

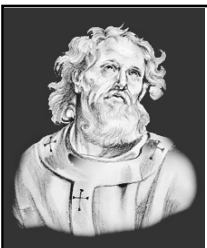

(Former Tax Collector & Patron Saint of 'Money' / Feast Day Sept 21st)
Turn Your TAXABLE RMD (Required Minimum Distributions) into Charitable Donations.

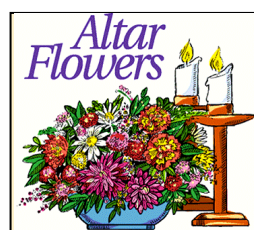
IRS rules mandate that individuals age 70 1/2 and older take RMDs from their IRA each year, regardless of whether the income is needed. These annual withdrawals are subject to ordinary income taxes. By making a charitable contribution **from your IRA**, you can satisfy your RMD amount **without reporting additional income.**

This provision may be especially attractive for retirees who don't need all the income from their IRA to meet current living expenses. 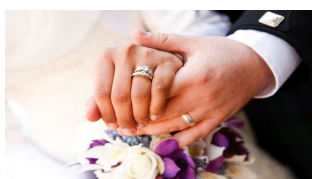
