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Our Greatest Treasure

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, often referred to as “Corpus Christi.” The Eucharist is our greatest Treasure, and is at the center of our life as Catholics. Jesus tells us clearly, “Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life.” (Jn. 6:53-54) We believe that when Jesus said “This is my body....This is my blood” during the Last Supper, he meant what he said. And he gave his Apostles and their successors the power to “do this,” that is, to continue to transform bread and wine into his living Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

We call the transformation of bread and wine into the living presence of Christ transubstantiation. The bread and wine keep their outward appearance in every respect, but the reality—the substance—is changed. After the Consecration of the Mass, they are no longer bread and wine. They are the living presence of Jesus Christ. To be sure, this is beyond our power to understand completely, although we know that with God all things are possible.

In the United States we are beginning a three-year National Eucharistic Revival: a “grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.” Our Bishops state that “the National Eucharistic Revival aims to be a movement that renews the Church by enkindling a living relationship with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.” During these three years, let’s do what we can to increase the faith and devotion that the Bishops are encouraging. Nuestro Mayor Tesoro

Este fin de semana celebramos la Solemnidad del Santísimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo, también lo conocemos como “Corpus Christi”. La Eucaristía es nuestro mayor Tesoro y está en el centro de nuestra vida como católicos. Jesús nos dice claramente: “En verdad les digo que, si no comen la carne del Hijo del hombre y no beben su sangre, no tiene vida en ustedes. El que come mi carne y bebe mi sangre tiene vida eterna”. (Juan 6:53-54) Creemos que cuando Jesús dijo: “Este es mi cuerpo...Esta es mi sangre” durante la Última Cena, quiso decir lo que dijo. Y dio a sus Apóstoles y sus sucesores el poder de “hacer esto”, es decir, de seguir transformando el pan y el vino en su Cuerpo, Sangre, Alma y Divinidad.

A la transformación del pan y del vino en la presencia viva de Cristo la llamamos transubstanciación. El pan y el vino conservan su apariencia externa en todos los aspectos, pero la realidad - la sustancia - cambia. Después de la Consagración de la Misa, ya no son pan ni vino. Son la presencia viva de Jesucristo. Sin duda, esto va más allá de nuestro entendimiento, aunque sabemos que con Dios todo es posible.

En los Estados Unidos estamos comenzando un Avivamiento Eucarístico Nacional de tres años: un “avivamiento de devoción para creer en la presencia real de Jesús en la Eucaristía”. Nuestros obispos afirman que “el Renacimiento Eucarístico Nacional pretende ser un movimiento que renueve a la Iglesia encendiendo una relación viva con Jesucristo en la Eucaristía”. Durante estos tres años, hagamos lo posible para aumentar la fe y la devoción en el Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía, que los obispos están animando.
