Cuaresma

Para serles honesto, hasta la palabra "Cuaresma" me hace sentir incómodo. Es un momento de conversión, cambio positivo, y el cambio suele ser difícil. Me gustan las cosas que son fáciles para mí. Pero la Cuaresma involucra cosas que no son fáciles. Y sin embargo, entro en esta temporada, sabiendo que las cosas más importantes en la vida involucran al menos alguna dificultad. La dificultad vale la pena, porque la meta (una unión más cercana con Jesucristo y, en última instancia, la alegría del cielo) es mayor que cualquier otra meta en la vida.

La oración es una de las tres prácticas importantes de la Cuaresma. Si no está acostumbrado a participar en una Misa durante la semana, puede considerar hacerlo durante la Cuaresma. O si no está acostumbrado a participar en la Adoración Eucarística bimensual, la Cuaresma puede ser un buen momento para probar esta maravillosa práctica. Tal vez durante la Cuaresma desarrollará la práctica de orar mientras conduce (¡siempre que preste atención al tráfico que lo rodea!). O puede reservar un número específico de minutos cada día para hablar con el Señor.

El ayuno también es una practica importante en la Cuaresma. Una de las oraciones a nuestro Padre Celestial que se puede usar durante la Misa en tiempo de Cuaresma dice: "A través del ayuno corporal, refrenas nuestras faltas, levantas nuestras mentes y nos otorgas tanto la virtud como sus recompensas". Evitar el pecado y cultivar la virtud. También nos recuerda nuestra hambre de Dios y su gracia. Podrías ayunar de algún tipo de comida, o de pasar menos tiempo en el teléfono o en el Internet y de ayunar de alguna forma de entretenimiento.

La limosna es la tercera práctica importante de la Cuaresma. Hay tantos que están en necesidad; nuestras limosnas pueden ser en forma de asistencia financiera, voluntariado para ayudar a las personas necesitadas, o quizás simplemente dar su tiempo a alguien que necesita un amigo. ¡Tenemos tanto que podemos dar!

La clave para llevar a cabo estas prácticas durante la Cuaresma es hacer resoluciones que sean específicas, prácticas y renovables. Una resolución es específica cuando decimos exactamente cómo y cuándo la llevaremos a cabo. Es práctico si somos capaces de hacerlo sin descuidar los deberes de nuestra vida diaria. Es renovable si sabemos que podemos retomar la práctica, incluso si fallamos momentáneamente en mantener la práctica.

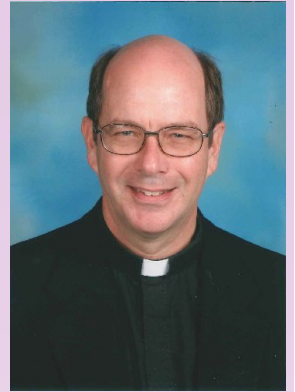
Si por alguna razón aún no ha hecho ninguna resolución de Cuaresma, ahora es el momento de hacerlo. Caminemos juntos en este viaje de Cuaresma para que podamos llegar juntos a la alegría de la Pascua, listos y capaces de recibir todas las bendiciones que Dios tiene para nosotros.

Lent

To be honest, even the word “Lent” makes me feel uneasy. It is a time of conversion, positive change, and change is usually difficult. I like things that are easy for me. But Lent involves things that are not easy. And yet I enter into this season, knowing that most important things in life involve at least some difficulty. The difficulty is worth it, because the goal (closer union with Jesus Christ, and ultimately the joy of heaven) is greater than any other goal in life.



Prayer is one of the three important Lenten practices. If you are not in the habit of participating in Mass on a weekday, you might consider doing this during Lent. Or if you are not in the habit of participating in our bimonthly Eucharistic Adoration, Lent might be a good time to try this wonderful practice. Maybe during Lent you will develop the practice of praying while you drive (as long as you pay attention to the traffic around you!). Or you might set aside a specific number of minutes each day to speak with the Lord.

Fasting is also an important Lenten practice. One of the prayers that can be used for Mass during Lent says to our Heavenly Father, “Through bodily fasting you restrain our faults, raise up our minds, and bestow both virtue and its rewards.” The discipline of doing without something we like helps us to avoid sin and to cultivate virtue. It also reminds us of our hunger for God and his grace. You might fast from some type of food, or from spending time on the phone or Internet, or from some favorite form of entertainment.

Almsgiving is the third important practice of Lent. There are so many who are in need; our alms might be in the form of financial assistance, or volunteering to help people in need, or perhaps just giving your time to someone who needs a friend. We have so much that we can give!

The key to carrying out these practices well during Lent is to make resolutions that are *specific*, *practical*, and *renewable*. A resolution is *specific* if we say exactly how and when we will carry it out. It is *practical* if we are able to do it without neglecting the duties of our daily life. It is *renewable* if we know that we can take up the practice again even if we momentarily fail in keeping the practice.

If for any reason you have not yet made any Lenten resolutions, the time to do so is now. Let’s walk this Lenten journey together so that we can arrive together at the joy of Easter, ready and able to take in all the blessings God has in store for us.

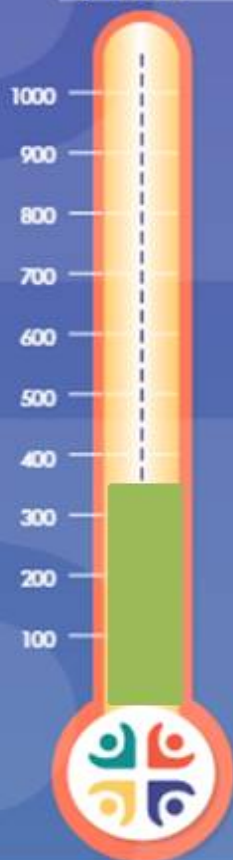

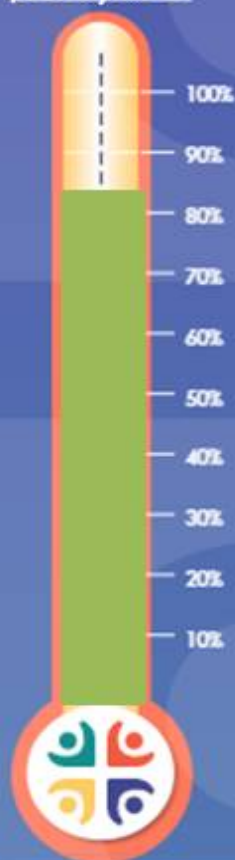

Liturgical Changes During Lent

During this penitential season, our liturgical environment is simplified to help us enter into a “desert” encounter and lead us to a more prayerful & penitential disposition. While it is not mandated by the Church, our parish incorporates praying the Apostles’ Creed in place of the Nicene Creed, and Greek (Kyrie) & Latin Mass parts (*Sanctus*, Memorial Acclamation, *Agnus Dei*) to clearly set apart the liturgical season of Lent.

Here are some additional changes you may have noticed.

- ❖ Church décor is simplified; only 2 altar candles; simple violet decorations
- ❖ Music has been toned down as well; no drums; no closing song (just simple instrumental)
- ❖ The Gloria is omitted during Lent except on Feasts and Solemnities
- ❖ “Alleluia” is not said/sung during Lent; “Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!” is used as the Gospel Acclamation
- ❖ Longer pauses before prayers and between scripture readings
- ❖ Chanted “The Word of the Lord,” “The Gospel of the Lord,” and the Our Father
