

Fr. Aristotle comes to us from San Francisco Solano Catholic Church





June 13 – St. Anthony of Padua

Born in Lisbon, Portugal with the name Ferdinand, St. Anthony entered the Augustinian order at the age of 15 and devoted himself to prayer and studies. After hearing of the martyrdom of several Franciscan friars in Morocco in 1209, Ferdinand decided to follow in the footsteps of his contemporary St. Francis of Assisi and received the religious name "Anthony." Celebrate with St Anthony's Bread (loaves of bread blessed and shared in honor of St. Anthony)


June 24 —St. John the Baptist
