Assumption

On Monday, August 15, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Because it falls on a Monday this year, the solemnity is not a holy day of obligation; but it remains an important celebration. We celebrate the fact that, at the end of her earthly life, the Blessed Virgin Mary was taken, body and soul, into heaven. As the Preface for this day states, "Rightly you would not allow her to see the corruption of the tomb, since from her own body she marvelously brought forth your incarnate Son, the Author of all life."

The Preface also calls the Assumption of Mary "a sign of sure hope and comfort to your pilgrim people." The Assumption is a sign of hope because it foreshadows the destiny towards which we are striving: to share in the glory of the Lord's Resurrection. The Assumption is a call for us to renew in our hearts the virtue of hope. The secret of being hopeful is found in the Collect of the Mass for this day: "Grant, we pray, that, always attentive to the things that are above, we may merit to be sharers of her glory."

Let's always be "attentive to the things that are above," so that we never lose our focus on what is most important in this life. It's so easy to be distracted by lesser things, but we were created for something much greater than the things around us. With eternal glory as our goal, why should we settle for anything less?

Asunción

El lunes 15 de agosto celebramos la solemnidad de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María. Debido a que cae en lunes este año, la solemnidad no es un día santo de obligación; pero sigue siendo una celebración importante. Celebramos el hecho de que, al final de su vida terrenal, la Santísima Virgen María fue llevada, en cuerpo y alma, al cielo. Como dice el Prefacio de este día: "Con razón no le permitirías ver la corrupción de la tumba, ya que de su propio cuerpo ella dio a luz maravillosamente a tu Hijo encarnado, el Autor de toda vida".

El Prefacio también llama a la Asunción de María "un signo de esperanza segura y consuelo para vuestro pueblo peregrino". La Asunción es un signo de esperanza porque presagia el destino hacia el que nos estamos esforzando: para compartir la gloria de la resurrección del Señor. La Asunción es un llamado para que renovemos en nuestros corazones la virtud de la esperanza. El secreto de la esperanza se encuentra en la Colecta de la Misa para este día: "Concedenos, oramos, para que, siempre atentos a las cosas que están arriba, merezcamos ser partícipes de su gloria".

Estemos siempre "atentos a las cosas que están arriba", para que nunca perdamos nuestro enfoque en lo que es más importante en esta vida. Es muy fácil distraerse con cosas menores, pero fuimos creados para algo mucho más grande que las cosas que nos rodean. Con la gloria eterna como nuestra meta, ¿por qué deberíamos conformarnos con algo menos?

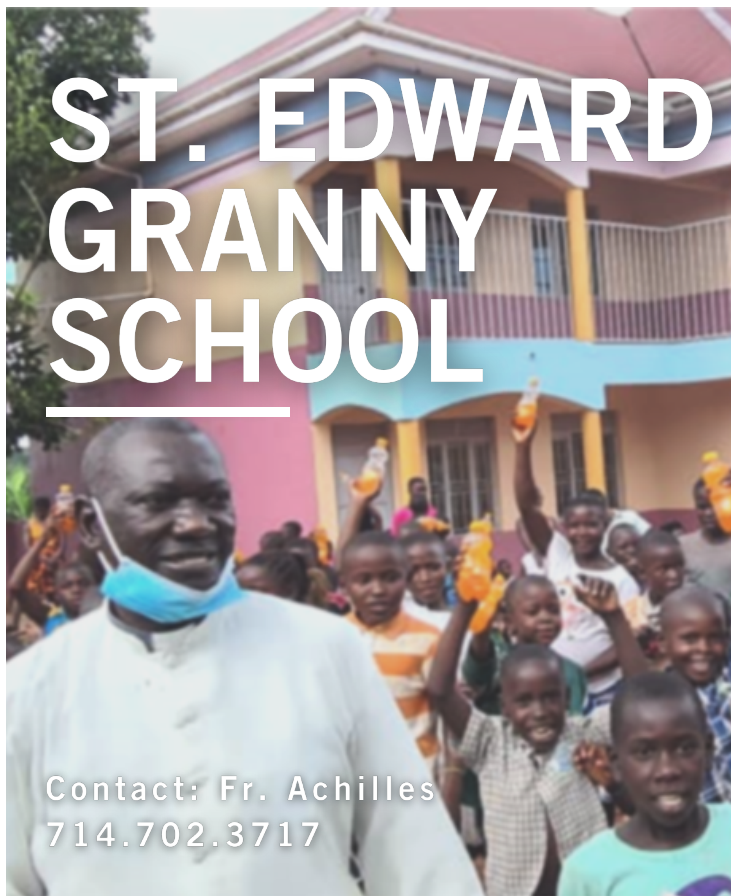

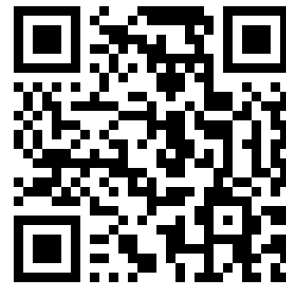
