Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

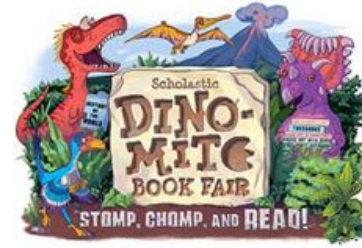

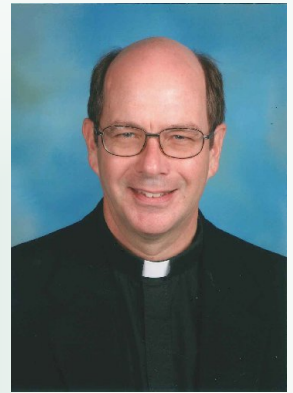

Ordinary or Extraordinary?

After last Sunday's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord, our Church's liturgy began what is called Ordinary Time. During this season, the Sunday Gospels generally follow the order in which they occur in the Bible (hence the word "ordinary," which comes from the same root as the word "order"). Unfortunately, in the English language, the word "ordinary" often refers to what is commonplace. But there is nothing commonplace about Ordinary Time.



The General Instruction on the Roman Missal tells us that during Ordinary Time "the mystery of Christ itself is honored in its fullness." The mystery of Christ is the mystery of the union of human and divine. It is the mystery of our own salvation, our grace-filled existence. It is the mystery which gives the world around us lasting significance specifically because the events of this world's history have eternal implications. Does this sound "ordinary" to you?

I would argue that this is actually "Extraordinary Time." It is a time to recognize that there literally is more to life than what meets the eye, and there is more to this world and its history than what meets the eye. It is a time to see everything in the light of eternity and in the light of the relationship between God and humankind which reaches its highpoint in Jesus Christ. May the light of Christ, which dawned on our world at Christmas and shone in great splendor on Epiphany, continue to shine on us and through us! May this be an extraordinary Ordinary Time!

Ordinario o Extraordinario?

Después de la celebración del Bautismo del Señor el domingo pasado, la liturgia de nuestra Iglesia comenzó lo que se llama Tiempo Ordinario. Durante esta temporada, los Evangelios dominicales generalmente siguen el orden en que aparecen en la Biblia (de ahí la palabra "ordinario", que proviene de la misma raíz que la palabra "orden"). Desafortunadamente, en el idioma inglés, la palabra "ordinario" a menudo se refiere a lo que es común. Pero no hay nada común en el Tiempo Ordinario.

La Instrucción General sobre el Misal Romano nos dice que durante el Tiempo Ordinario "el misterio de Cristo mismo se honra en su plenitud". El misterio de Cristo es el misterio de la unión de lo humano y lo divino. Es el misterio de nuestra propia salvación, nuestra existencia llena de gracia. Es el misterio que otorga al mundo que nos rodea una importancia duradera, específicamente porque los acontecimientos de la historia de este mundo tienen implicaciones eternas. ¿Esto te suena "común"?

Yo diría que esto es en realidad el "Tiempo Extraordinario". Es un momento para reconocer que literalmente hay más en la vida de lo que se ve a los ojos, y hay más en este mundo y su historia que lo que se encuentra en el ojo. Es un momento para ver todo a la luz de la eternidad y a la luz de la relación entre Dios y la humanidad que alcanza su punto culminante en Jesucristo. ¡Que la luz de Cristo, que amaneció en nuestro mundo en Navidad y brilló con gran esplendor en Epifanía, siga brillando en nosotros y a través de nosotros! ¡Que este sea un extraordinario Tiempo Ordinario!

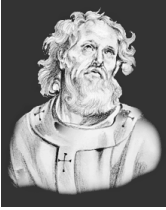
