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Spiritual Springtime

The first day of spring this year is Sunday, March 20. This reminds me that the word “Lent” comes from an Old English word that means “springtime.” Lent is literally our spiritual springtime, and all the things we associate with spring in the natural world also come into play in the supernatural world: new life, growth, and fruitfulness. In the world of gardening, we know the needs of new life: water, light, nutrients, pruning, weeding, and so on. Our Lenten practices of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving could be considered our spiritual “gardening.”

As we seek to cultivate renewed life in our souls, some kind of resolution is useful. At the beginning of Lent, I reviewed the qualities of a good resolution with the students of our school. They responded well to what I said, so I will also remind you: a good resolution is *specific*, *practical*, and *renewable*. *Specific* means that we focus on some concrete action, and we are clear about when we will perform the action. *Practical* means that the action is one that we can do without taking away from the duties of our state in life. *Renewable* means that if we momentarily fail in keeping the resolution, we can take it up again.

The third quality, that the resolution is renewable, is especially important. It’s hard to stick to a particular practice for a full forty days; but it would be a shame to give up just because of a momentary lapse. Rather, we renew the resolution and hopefully we are more vigilant in carrying it out. I hope your Lent has gone well so far, and I pray that all of us will enjoy a renewed spiritual life during this holy season.

Primavera Espiritual

El primer día de la primavera de este año es el domingo 20 de marzo. Esto me recuerda que la palabra “Cuaresma” proviene de una palabra en inglés antiguo que significa “primavera”. La Cuaresma es literalmente nuestra primavera espiritual, y todas las cosas que asociamos con la primavera en el mundo natural también entran en juego en el mundo sobrenatural: nueva vida, crecimiento y fecundidad. En el mundo de la jardinería conocemos las necesidades de la nueva vida: agua, luz, nutrientes, podar, deshierbe, etc. Nuestras prácticas cuaresmales de oración, ayuno y limosna podrían considerarse nuestra “jardinería” espiritual.

A medida que buscamos cultivar una vida renovada en nuestras almas, es útil algún tipo de resolución. Al comienzo de la Cuaresma, revisé las cualidades de una buena resolución con los alumnos de nuestra escuela. Respondieron bien a lo que dije, así que también les recuerdo a ustedes: una buena resolución es específico, práctico y renovable. Específico significa que nos enfocamos en alguna acción concreta, y tenemos claro cuándo realizaremos la acción. Práctico significa que la acción es aquella que podemos hacer sin apartarnos de los deberes de nuestro estado en la vida. Renovable significa que, si fallamos momentáneamente en mantener la resolución, podemos retomarla.

La tercera cualidad, que la resolución sea renovable, es especialmente importante. Es difícil apegarse a una práctica en particular durante cuarenta días completos; pero sería una pena rendirse solo por un lapsus momentáneo. Más bien, renovamos la resolución y ojalá estemos más vigilantes a lograrlo. Espero que su Cuaresma haya ido bien hasta ahora, y oro para que todos disfrutemos de una vida espiritual renovada durante esta temporada santa.
