Taking the Passion Personally

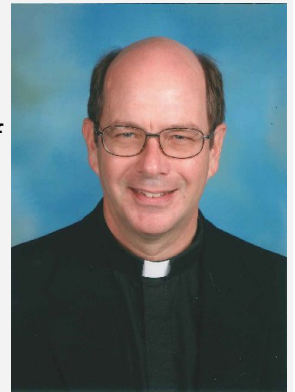
During the liturgy of Palm Sunday and Good Friday, the assembly has the unique experience of helping to proclaim the Gospel. Perhaps it feels strange to repeat the words of the crowd, calling for the crucifixion of Christ. Certainly we do not want Jesus to suffer.

Our participation in this Gospel is an invitation to take the Passion of Jesus Christ personally. One way we do this is to examine ourselves in the light of the Gospel and discern which figures in the Gospel narrative we might resemble. Are we like Peter, who spoke enthusiastically about being faithful to Christ but then deserted him when things became difficult? Are we like Judas, who traded his faithfulness to Christ for material gain? Are we like Pilate, who tried to wash his hands of responsibility for his actions? Are we like the crowd, easily swayed from praising Christ to condemning him? Are we like Simon of Cyrene, who carried the cross only under protest, because he had to?

The list of characters could go on. Hopefully we are like the Apostle John and the Virgin Mary, who remained with Jesus until the end. Hopefully we imitate Jesus himself, as he forgave his executioners from the cross. Taking the Passion personally means that we recognize our call to imitate the Lord and those who are closest to him.

Taking the Passion personally also means that we remember that Jesus suffered and died for each of us. His redemptive love for us is so great that he gave his life, and then took it up again, for each of us personally. How blessed we are to be loved so much! Gratefully we accompany the Lord throughout this Holy Week.

La lista de personajes podría continuar. Esperemos que seamos como el apóstol Juan y la Virgen María, quienes permanecieron con Jesús hasta el final. Esperemos imitar a Jesús mismo, mientras perdonaba a sus verdugos de la cruz. Vivir la Pasión de Cristo personalmente significa que reconocemos nuestro llamado a imitar al Señor y a los que están más cerca de él.

Vivir la Pasión de Cristo personalmente también significa que recordamos que Jesús sufrió y murió por cada uno de nosotros. Su amor redentor por nosotros es tan grande que dio su vida, y luego la retomó, para cada uno de nosotros. ¡Cuán bendecidos somos por ser amados, tanto! Con gratitud acompañamos al Señor durante esta Semana Santa.

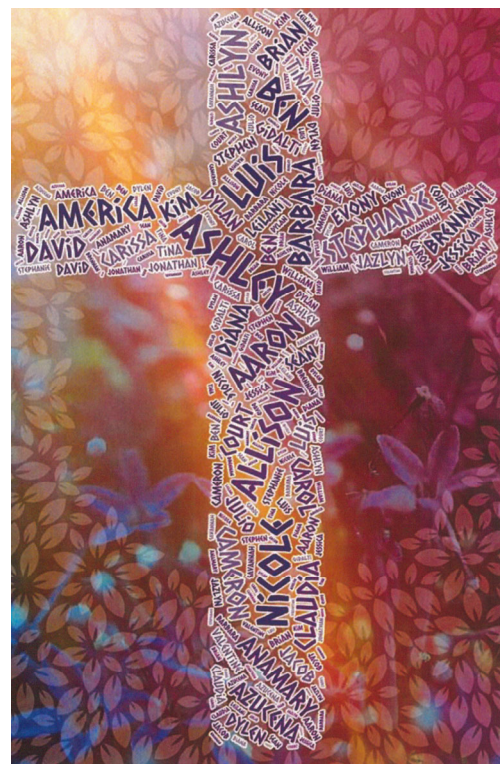

CELEBRATING LENT

Our Monarch learners celebrate the Lenten season through a variety of activities that focus on almsgiving and prayer. One of the highlights of the school year is always the Living Stations of the Cross. Produced by our 8th grade class, for three weeks, the kindergarten - 7th grade students watch as the eighth graders solemnly recreate the scenes of the passion and death of Jesus Christ.



From singing beautiful hymns, to narrating the script, to portraying each of the stations, every eighth grader plays an important role in this moving and emotional production. We would like to thank parish and school volunteer Deana Progar for designing and sewing the ornate costumes and helping to orchestrate this annual event which helps the Parish School learners prayerfully reflect on the ultimate sacrifice Jesus made for us.

The school also participated in a school-wide service project hosted by the 7th Grade - the Catholic Relief Services Rice Bowl program. This faith-in-action program allowed learners and their families to offer alms during Lent to support those locally and worldwide who bear the crosses of hunger, poverty and war. Students also learned that even small daily sacrifices during Lent help make room for God in their lives. We anxiously await Easter Sunday and Jesus' resurrection!
