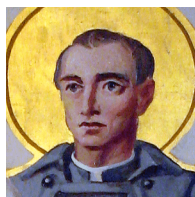

North American Martyrs

St. Charles Garnier was ordained in 1635. He served as a missionary among the Huron in Canada. Greatly influenced by his fellow missionary Jean de Brébeuf, he was known as the "lamb" to Brébeuf's "lion." St. Garnier as well as five other Jesuit missionaries, were killed in Canada and upstate New York from 1642 to 1649 in raids between Iroquois and Huron forces.



Mártires Norteamericanos

San Carlos Garnier fue ordenado en 1635. Sirvió como misionero entre los hurones de Canadá. Muy influenciado por su compañero misionero Jean de Brébeuf, fue conocido como el "cordero" del "león" de Brébeuf. St. Garnier, así como otros cinco misioneros jesuitas, fueron asesinados en Canadá y en el estado de Nueva York entre 1642 y 1649 en redadas entre fuerzas iroquesas y hurón.

St. Rafael Guízar y Valencia

was a Mexican Catholic bishop who lived in the late 19th and early 20th Century. He was known for caring for the sick and wounded during the Mexican Revolution but was persecuted and was forced to flee to Cuba. After the revolution he returned to Mexico, to continue his ministry until his death in 1938. St. Rafael Guízar y Valencia was canonized in October 15 by Pope Benedict XVI. The relic was gifted to the Diocese and Bishop Vann.



San Rafael Guízar y Valencia fue un obispo católico mexicano que vivió a finales del siglo XIX y principios del XX. Era conocido por atender a los enfermos y heridos durante la Revolución Mexicana, pero fue perseguido y se vio obligado a huir a Cuba. Después de la revolución regresó a México, para continuar su ministerio hasta su muerte en 1938. San Rafael Guízar y Valencia fue canonizado el 15 de octubre por el Papa Benedicto XVI.

St. Junípero Serra

was a Franciscan friar who traveled across Mexico and Alta California in the 18th century on a legendary mission to spread the faith. The Diocese of Orange's origins – along with the roots of Catholicism in Orange County, California, and the United States – can be traced to Serra. He converted about 5,000 Native Americans before his death in 1784. Fr. Serra died and was buried at his headquarters Mission Carmel, just outside of Monterey. St. Serra was canonized by Pope Francis in 2015.



San Junípero Serra

fue un fraile franciscano que viajó a través de México y Alta California en el siglo XVIII en una misión legendaria para difundir la fe. Los orígenes de la Diócesis de Orange, junto con las raíces del catolicismo en el Condado de Orange, California y los Estados Unidos, se pueden rastrear hasta Serra. Él convirtió a unos 5,000 nativos americanos antes de su muerte en 1784. Serra murió y fue enterrado en su cuartel general, Misión Carmel, a las afueras de Monterey. Santa Serra fue canonizada por el Papa Francisco en 2015.

RELICS ON PILGRIMAGE

Relics are classified in three categories. A first-class relic is a part of the saint's body, such as a bone. A second-class relic is a piece of the saint's clothing or something used by the saint, while a third-class relic is an object that has been touched by the saint or by a first-class relic.

The relics of Christ Cathedral are first class, and come from as far away as Vietnam and South Korea. They have been authenticated by a competent authority, including leaders at the dioceses and religious orders from where they came. The relics from Vietnamese, Korean, North American and Mexican martyrs and saints symbolize the diversity of Catholic community in Orange County.

By venerating the relics and the lives of saints, Catholics in Orange County can grow closer to their faith, and each other.

ADDITIONAL RELICS ON PILGRIMAGE YOU MAY LIKE TO VISIT

St. Andrew Dung Lac and St. Gabriel Lalemant

May 31—June 2: Blessed Sacrament, Westminster

June 12—13: St. Thomas More, Irvine

St. Andrew Dũng-Lạc was a Vietnamese priest in the 19th century who was persecuted and killed for his spiritual beliefs. He was among 117 Catholics martyred in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862.

The relic – a bone from the saint's hand – was gifted to the Diocese of Orange by Pierre Cardinal Nguyễn Văn Nhon of the Archdiocese of Hanoi. The remains of St. Andrew Dũng-Lạc, including his skull, are on display behind glass at St. Joseph's Cathedral in Hanoi.



San Andrés Dũng-Lạc fue un sacerdote vietnamita en el siglo XIX que fue perseguido y asesinado por sus creencias espirituales. Fue uno de los 117 católicos martirizados en Vietnam entre 1820 y 1862.

La reliquia, un hueso de la mano del santo, fue donada a la Diócesis de Orange por Pierre Cardinal Nguyễn Văn Nhon de la Arquidiócesis de Hanoi. Los restos de San Andres Dũng-Lạc, incluido su cráneo, se exhiben detrás de un vidrio en la catedral de St. Joseph en Hanoi.

St. Andrew Kim Taegon

The first native-born Korean priest, is among the most prominent saints in east Asia. Killed in 1846, he was among thousands of Korean Catholics who were persecuted and killed in the 19th Century for following their faith.

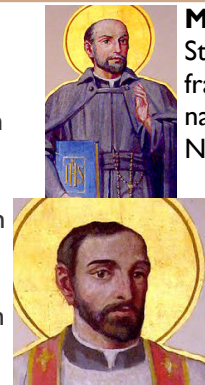
St. Andrew Kim Taegon was canonized by Pope John Paul II in May 1984 along with 102 Korean martyrs. The relic is a bone from the upper cervical vertebrae.



San Andrés Kim Taegon El primer sacerdote coreano nativo, se encuentra entre los santos más destacados en el este de Asia. Asesinado en 1846, a la edad de 25 años, a orillas del río Han, cerca de Seúl, se encontraba entre los miles de católicos coreanos que fueron perseguidos y asesinados en el siglo XIX por seguir su fe.

San Andrés Kim Taegon fue canonizado por el Papa Juan Pablo II en mayo de 1984 junto con 102 mártires coreanos. La reliquia es un hueso de las vertebrae.

North American Martyrs St. John de Brébeuf and St. Gabriel Lalemant were French Jesuit priests who lived and worked among the Native American tribes in Canada and upstate New York in the 17th Century. They were killed during conflict between the warring tribes of the Iroquois Confederacy. They were canonized as martyrs by Pope Pius XI in 1930. Along with 5 other Jesuit missionaries killed in Canada and upstate New York between 1642 and 1649, they are known collectively as the North American Martyrs.



Mártires norteamericanos St. John de Brébeuf y St. Gabriel Lalemant eran sacerdotes jesuitas franceses que vivían y trabajaban entre las tribus nativas americanas en Canadá y en el estado de Nueva York en el siglo XVII. Fueron asesinados durante el conflicto entre las tribus guerreras de la Confederación Iroquois. Fueron canonizados como mártires por el Papa Pío XI en 1930. Junto con otros 5 misioneros jesuitas asesinados en Canadá y en el estado de Nueva York entre 1642 y 1649, son conocidos colectivamente como los Mártires norteamericanos.

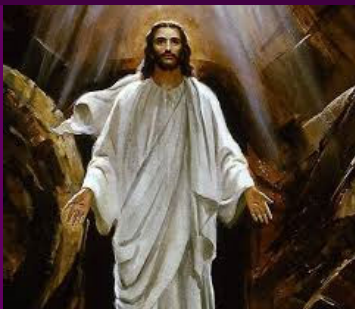

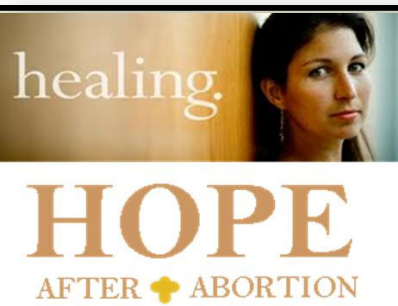

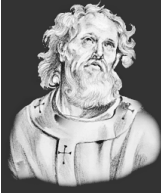
