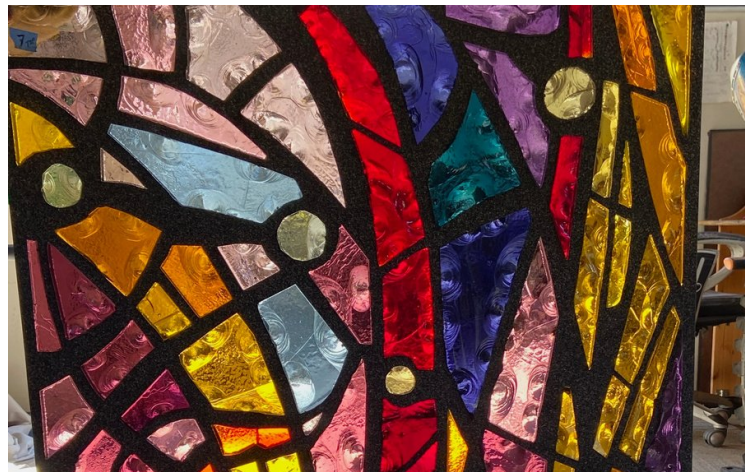

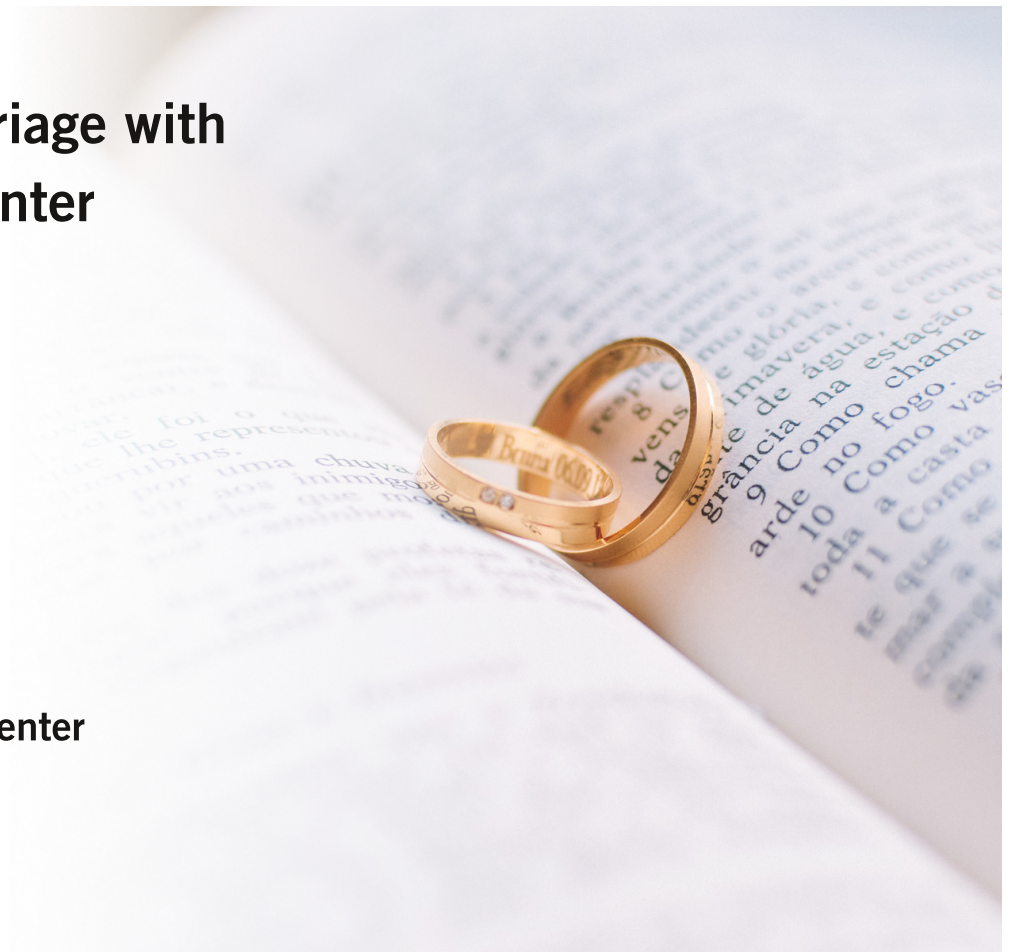

Poverty Awareness Month

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, in collaboration with the Catholic Campaign for Human Development, declared January “Poverty Awareness Month” in our nation.

Tens of millions of people in the U.S. live in a web of poverty. By federal criteria, Orange County’s poverty rate has risen to 13.5 percent of residents. For a family of four, that means an annual income below \$24,000. And Orange County’s cost of living is 46 percent higher than the national average.

The more focused California Poverty Measure, which accounts for a range of local factors, including housing prices, pegs Orange County’s poverty rate at 24.3 percent.

Children suffer the most. A third of Orange County youths under 12 live in poverty – a higher proportion than in Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego counties.
