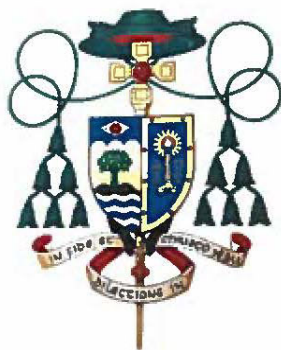
Last weekend was a wonderful example of our vibrant faith community and who we are as Church:

DECREE OF ASSIGNMENT

I, Kevin W. Vann,
Bishop of Orange in California

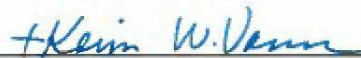
By the grace of God and of the Apostolic See, and in accordance with canon 523, hereby appoint Rev. Brendan Manson as Pastor of *St. Edward the Confessor Church and San Felipe de Jesus Chapel* in Dana Point, California.

In observation of canon 522 of the *Code of Canon Law*, the norms of the USCCB, and law particular to this diocese, I appoint him for a term of six (6) years, effective July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2021. The appointment then may be renewed for a second term at the discretion of the diocesan bishop.

I urge Fr. Manson especially to give a careful examination of canons 528-530 regarding his new pastoral duties and I entrust him to the protection and love of Our Lady of Guadalupe.

Given at the Diocesan Pastoral Center, Garden Grove, California, on this 12th day of April in the Year of Our Lord 2015.





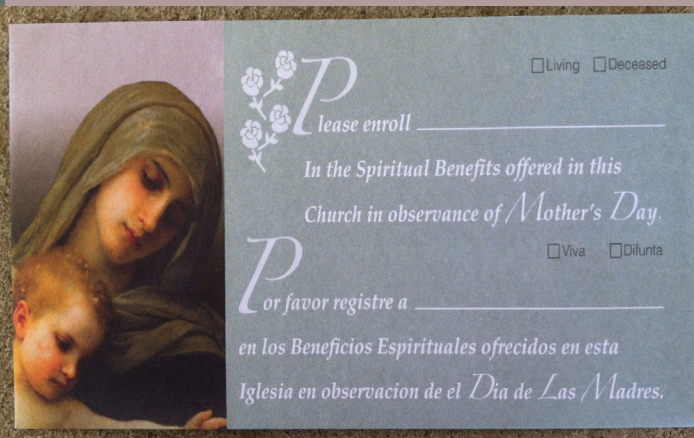

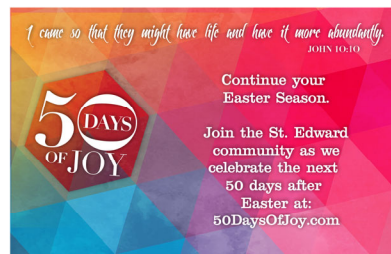
