Communion of Saints

In the Apostles' Creed we say, "I believe in...the communion of saints." In the light of some recent celebrations, it strikes me that you might find an explanation of this phrase to be appropriate. The Catechism of the Catholic Church explains the communion of saints in paragraphs 946 through 962. In brief, the "communion of saints" means that we are in union with all who are redeemed, whether they are in this world or in the next. By virtue of this unity, we can pray for one another on earth, and we can also pray for those who have died. And those who have died can pray for us.

This has special significance because last Tuesday we celebrated the Solemnity of All Saints, which honored all who are in heaven. The saints are our spiritual brothers and sisters; they can pray for us, and they give us good example. Then, on November 2nd, we celebrated All Souls' Day, during which we prayed for those who have died but are still being purified (in purgatory). Our prayers can speed their way to heaven, because we are all united in the communion of saints.

Of course, this also means we can pray and offer sacrifices for one another here on earth. Many times in his letters, St. Paul asks the early Christians to pray for him, and he promises to pray for them. As for me, I promise to pray for you, the good people of St. Edward the Confessor and San Felipe de Jesús, daily. I humbly ask you to pray for me as well.

Comunión de los Santos

En el Credo de los Apóstoles decimos: "Creo en...la comunión de los santos". A la luz de las recientes celebraciones, creo que es apropiado dar una explicación de esta frase. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica explica la comunión de los santos en los párrafos 946 al 962. En resumen, la "comunión de los santos" significa que estamos unidos con todos los que han pagado el precio por nuestra salvación, ya sea que estén en este mundo o en el venidero. En virtud de esta unidad, podemos orar los unos por los otros en la tierra, y también podemos orar por los que han muerto. Y los que han muerto pueden orar por nosotros.

Esto tiene un significado especial porque el pasado martes celebramos la Solemnidad de Todos los Santos, en la que se honró a todos los que están en el cielo. Los santos son nuestros hermanos espirituales; ellos pueden orar por nosotros, y ellos son un buen ejemplo para seguir. Luego, el 2 de noviembre, celebramos el Día de los fieles difuntos, durante el cual oramos por los que han muerto, pero aún están siendo purificados (en el purgatorio). Nuestras oraciones pueden acelerar su camino al cielo, porque todos estamos unidos en la comunión de los santos.

Por supuesto, esto también significa que podemos orar y ofrecer sacrificios unos por otros aquí en la tierra. En muchas de sus cartas, San Pablo pide a los primeros cristianos que oren por él, y él promete orar por ellos. Por mi parte, yo prometo rezar por ustedes todos los días, gente buena de San Eduardo el Confesor y San Felipe de Jesús. Al igual, humildemente les pido que oren por mí.

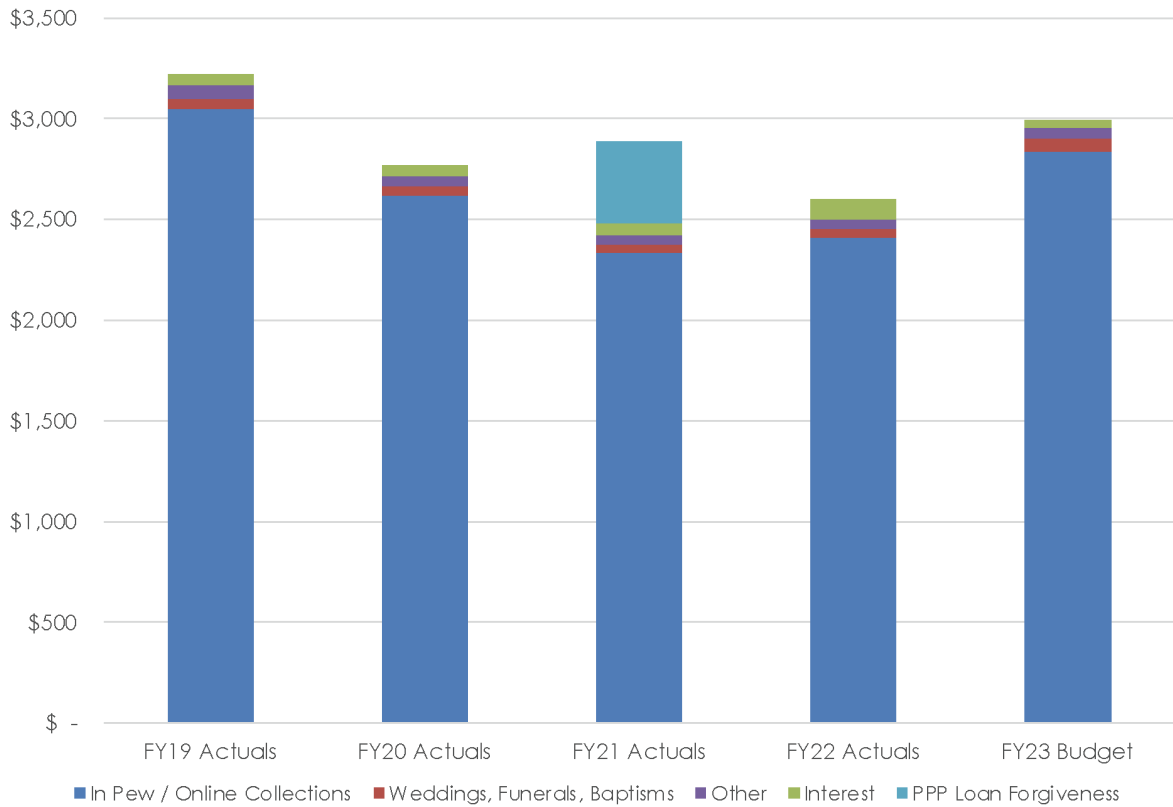

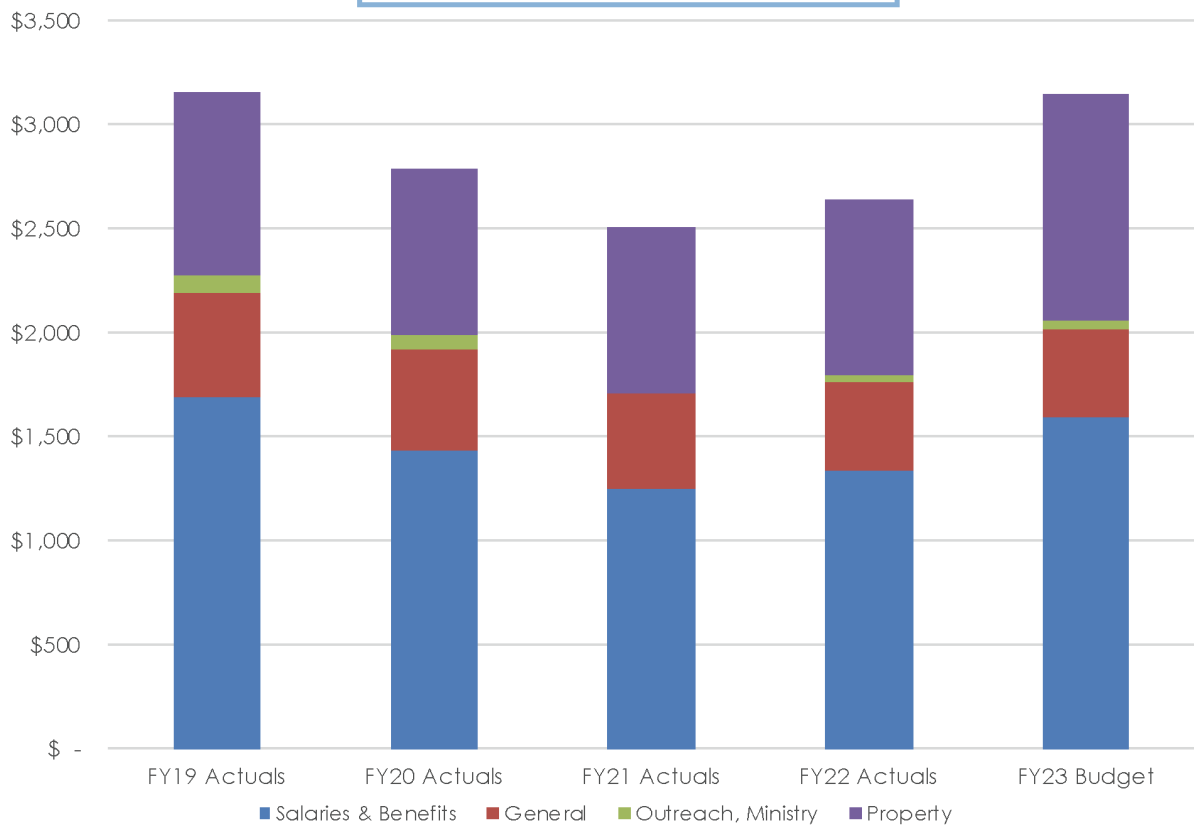
St Edward the Confessor - Church Income (Dollars in thousands)

St Edward the Confessor - Church Expenses (Dollars in thousands)



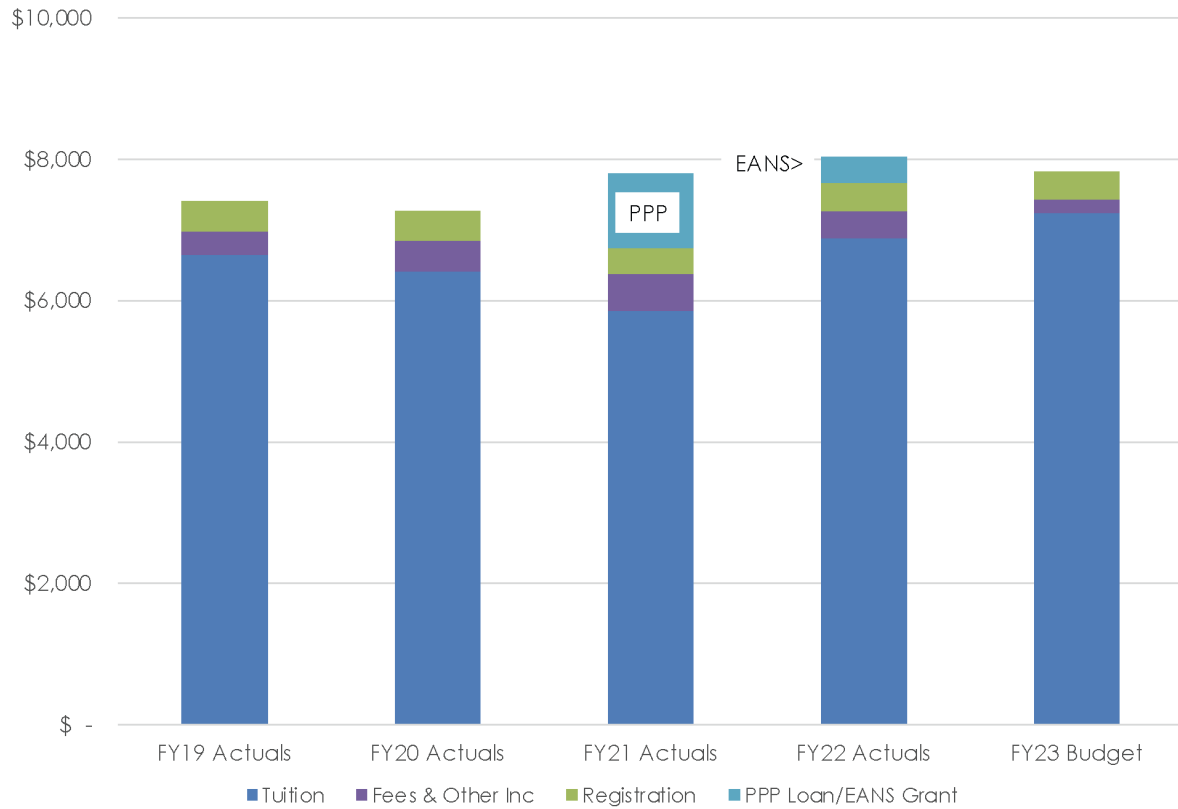

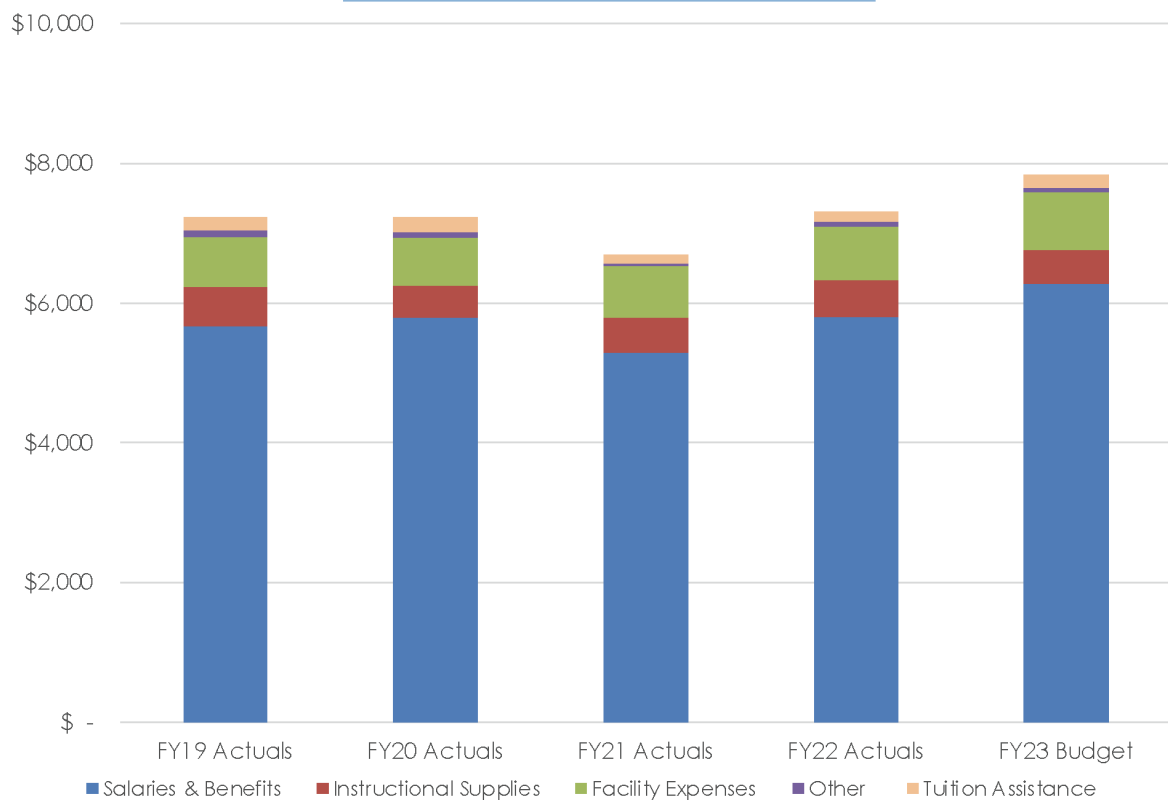
