Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

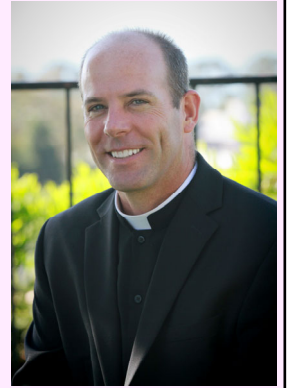
Eucharistic Adoration

Advent: a Season of Joyful Waiting, Watching and Longing

We generally don't like waiting...for anything. When we're at the store, we look for the shortest line, we like FastPass at Disneyland, FasTrak on the freeway, and sometimes we'll even pay a heavy premium to skip the line all together. Waiting can be a painful experience that tries our patience.



Advent, which means "He comes" or "He is coming", is a time of waiting, watching, and longing. And, we might just prefer to move right on to Christmas. After all, "Christmas" arrived in stores, the radio, and commercials long ago. Meanwhile, we, as Christians, are just *beginning* twenty-five days of *preparation* for the season of Christmas. So why wait?

Waiting does not mean that we stand idle. Instead, waiting, watching and longing for God are powerful ways to prepare and expand our hearts for God who wishes to renew us. If we do these things, our joy on Christmas day, during the Christmas season, and beyond, will greatly exceed the passing joy that comes with "skipping the line." Daily Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, the Rosary, and the "Blue Book" are just some ways to live the spirit of Advent.

We are also trying something new this year. Consider taking part in **25 Days of Prayer & Compassion**, a 25-day journey aimed at helping us see and serve Christ in those in need. Each day is designed to bring about an awareness of those living in poverty and give us a way of walking in solidarity with them through prayer and small activities.

A limited number of **25 Days of Prayer and Compassion** booklets are available in the parish office; however, the entire journey is available at online **HouseofPrayerandPoor.com**. You are encouraged to post pictures and comments of your daily journey on the website as we journey together to see and serve Christ, who comes to us in prayer and in the least among us.

Adviento: Un tiempo de Alegría, Anhelo Y Espera

Por lo general, no nos gusta esperar...para nada. Cuando estamos en la tienda, buscamos la línea más corta, nos gusta el FastPass en Disneylandia, FasTrak en la autopista, y a veces pagamos extra para poder saltarnos la línea y evitar esperar. Esperar puede ser una experiencia dolorosa que reta nuestra paciencia.

Adviento, que significa "venida" o "Él está viniendo", es un tiempo de espera, observando, y anhelando. Y, a veces preferimos saltarnos directamente a la Navidad. Después de todo, "Navidad" llega a las tiendas, en la radio, y anuncios por todos lados. Mientras tanto, nosotros, como cristianos, estaremos *empezando* veinticinco días de *preparación* para la temporada Navideña. Así que ¿por qué esperar?

Esperar no significa que estamos inactivos. Al contrario, esperando, observando y anhelando en Dios son maneras poderosas para preparar y expandir nuestros corazones a Dios que nos quiere renovar. Si hacemos estas cosas, durante la temporada de Navidad, y más allá, superará en gran medida la alegría que viene con "no querer saltarse la línea." Misa Diaria, Adoración Eucarística, el Sacramento de la Reconciliación, el Rosario, y el "Libro Azul" son sólo algunas maneras de vivir el espíritu del Adviento.

También estamos intentando algo nuevo este año. Considere el poder participar en **25 Días de Oración y la Compasión**, un viaje de 25 días destinado a ayudar, a ver y servir a Cristo en los más necesitados. Cada día está diseñado para tomar conciencia de todas aquellas personas que viven en la pobreza y poder caminar en la solidaridad con ellos a través de la oración y pequeñas actividades.
