Infant Baptisms are celebrated on the first and third Sundays of each month following catechesis for parents and godparents. Parents of infants should contact the Faith Formation office (949) 496-6011 to enroll.

Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

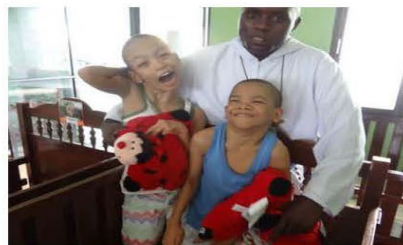
HELPING HANDS & LOVING HEARTS

GIVING HOPE & CHANGING LIVES



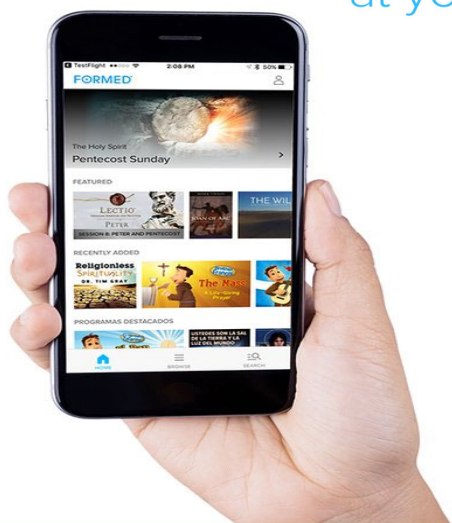
In continuing our articles on how our parishioners are reaching out and changing lives, this week will highlight those who take it upon themselves to serve the least among us even if they are halfway around the world.

The Missionaries of the Poor (MOP) is a near and dear ministry to many of our parishioners. Several years ago Fr. Ho Lung, founder of MOP, was invited to preach at our Masses and give a concert of his Caribbean praise music. It was a HUGE success. Fr. Ho Lung and the singers literally stole our hearts. Following that event, several groups of parishioners traveled to Jamaica, Haiti and the Philippines to volunteer at the MOP facilities. The experiences were life changing. However, over the years, those who can no longer physically go to MOP help serve in other ways. These “Friends of MOP”, occasionally receive a “wish List” of clothes and supplies from the brothers at the missions in the Philippine Islands. From that list they gather the requested items and ship them to MOP. This effort is done 2—3 times a year. These “friends” experience much joy when they provide gifts of love to these desperate souls. This is especially true when they see photos of the happy faces of the handicapped orphans and elderly, the brothers care for. This also includes the people living in the “basuras” (garbage dumps), who the brothers minister to weekly. These people are the poorest of the poor, but their lives are being touched by our fellow St. Edward parishioners. In keeping with St. Edward’s motto of “House of Prayer, House of Poor”, these compassionate gentle people make the Gospel come alive by becoming beggars for the Lord. 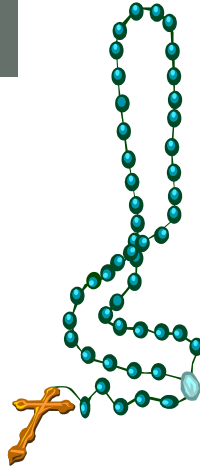

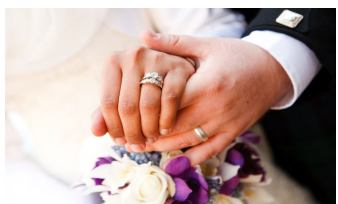

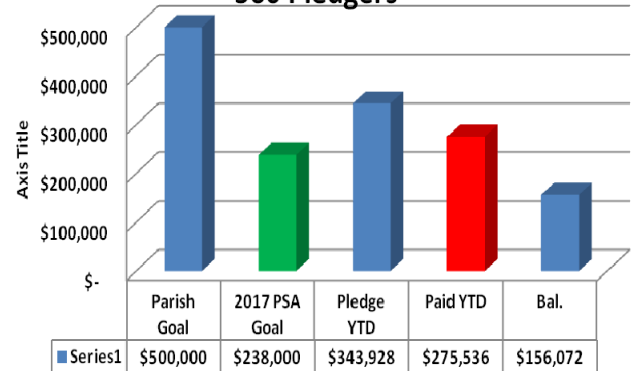
