Celebration of Christian Funerals

At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

SCHOOL NEWS: WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN THE MONARCHY

Fall is in full swing at St. Edward Parish School - learners have been busy reading, exploring, creating, playing and praying! Here's a snapshot of what's been going on at the Monarchy:

* Ukuleles have been added to our music program! 7th (and 8th graders later in the year) are learning how to use the ukulele's open strings and played their first songs using finger-picking. The ukuleles have also found a new home on the wall in the Music Room. St. Edward's own Mr. Sergio Lizarraga helped design and construct the custom storage racks that are both functional and beautiful. The sounds of the ukulele are perfect for our beach community school!



* Thanks to the annual Monarch Fund, our kiln is now fully up and running. A few of the grades are creating their hand formed pottery and ceramic pieces, then glazing them in preparation for the kiln!

* The school celebrated The Feast of St. Edward the Confessor with a preschool processional at Friday Mass. Eighth grader Nino Sindoni was chosen to be King St. Edward for his faith-filled character.



* Kindergarten hosted their annual Apple Day. This day-long adventure had students complete apple-themed cross-curriculum activities. Using their hands to manipulate, their words to explain, and their brains to think critically and creatively, students read, wrote, drew, colored, painted, calculated, weighed, and even ate to learn about apples.

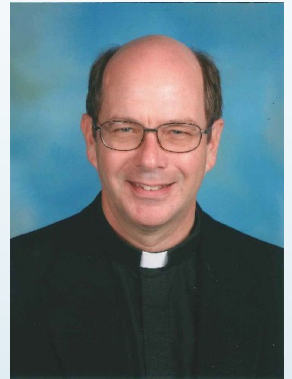

Recently I made a very embarrassing mistake.
