Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

We need people who are willing to commit for one hour a month on the first and/or third Monday of the month for the following hours:

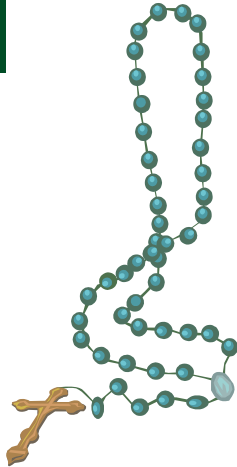

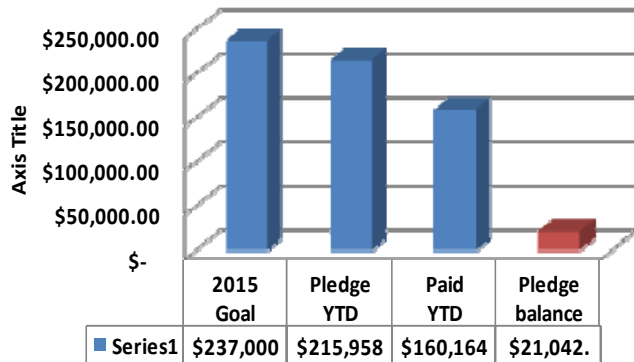

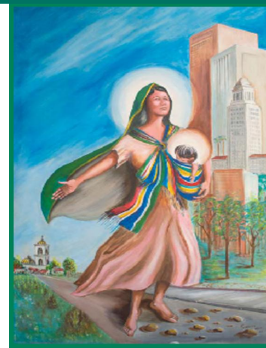

Bishop Vann welcomes you to join thousands in solidarity and prayer for humanitarian relief for immigrants and just and compassionate immigration reform. And we also want to recognize the wonderful efforts of parishes throughout Southern California that are caring for immigrants and helping them to prepare for relief and a path to citizenship.

Each parish, center, and religious community led by pastors or administrators, priests, deacons, and religious is asked to bring a delegation, and each delegation is encouraged to bring a banner identifying their parish, as well as identifying a leader who will carry the banner in the procession.

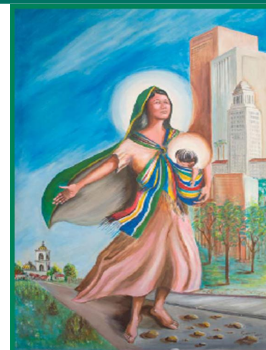
