At the time of death, a family member should contact the Parish office to arrange the date and time for the funeral liturgy.

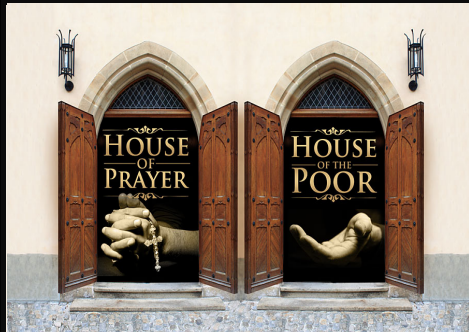
Sacrament of Matrimony

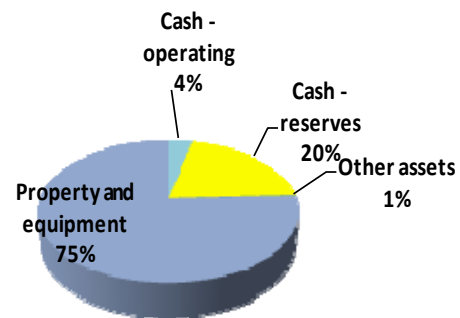

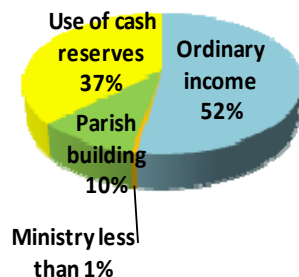

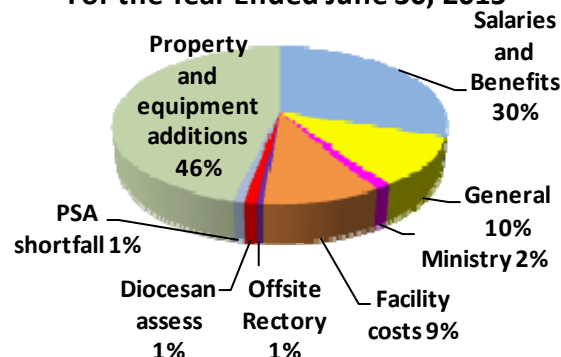

Church Operating Budget For the Year Ending June 30, 2016

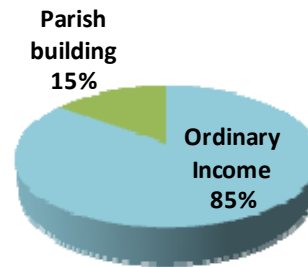

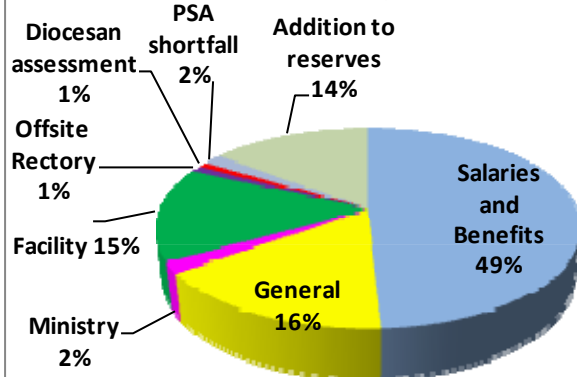

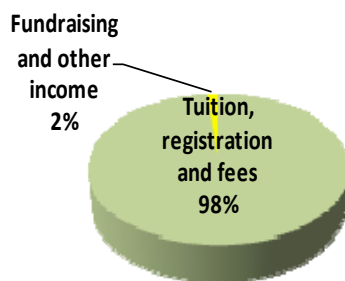
St. Edward the Confessor Catholic Church Budgeted Income For the Year Ending June 30, 2016

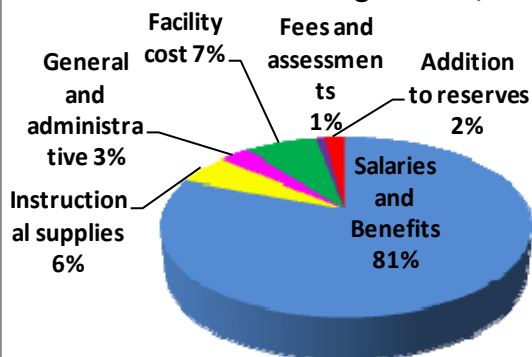

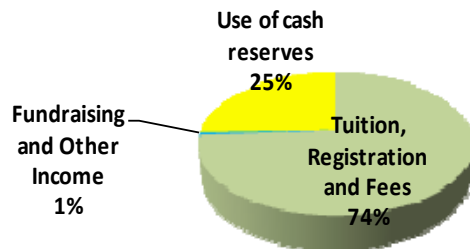

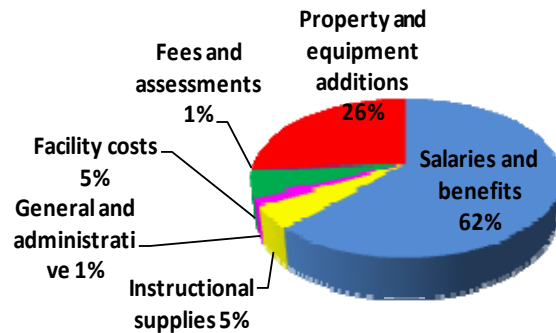

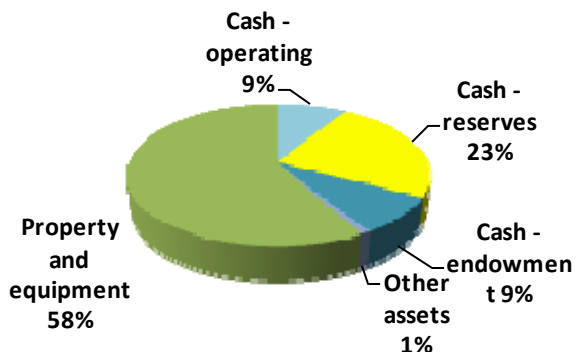

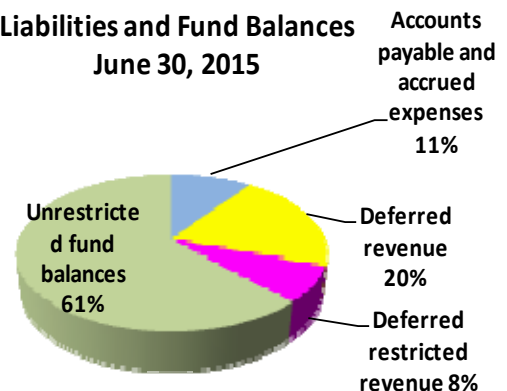

St. Edward the Confessor Catholic School **Liabilities and Fund Balances** **June 30, 2015**

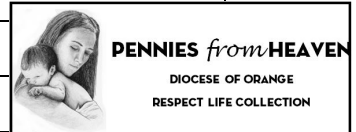

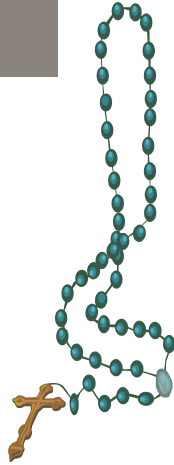

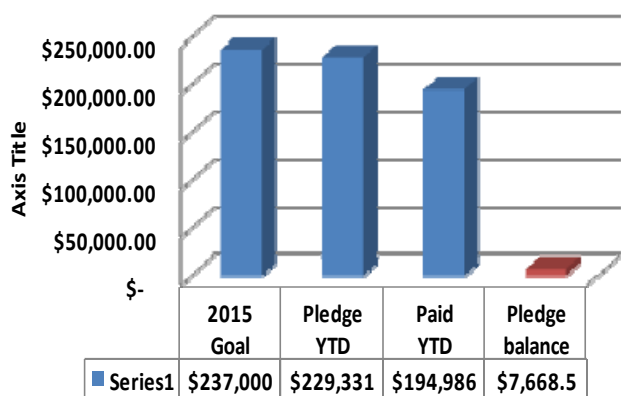
