Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please call the Parish office for more information.

Pentecost

Several years ago, I visited the beautiful city of Guanajuato, Mexico, and took in the normal tourist sites including El Museo De Las Momias (The Museum of the Mummies). The museum contains the mummified remains of over 100 people of all ages who were interred in the middle of the 19th century. Many of them were still clothed. The exhibit quickly disturbed me, and so I quickly left.



This experience reminded me of a promise God made to us through the prophet Ezekiel: "I will attach tendons to you and make flesh come upon you and cover you with skin; I will put breath in you, and you will come to life. I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. Then you will know that I am the LORD." (Ezk 37:6; 36:26)

God fulfilled this promise at Pentecost when He sent the Holy Spirit upon Mary and the apostles. Throughout the 50 days of Easter, over 500 of our parishioners received the gift of the Spirit through Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. Lent and Easter were a time for all of us to prepare to receive - or renew - the living gift of God within our bodies and souls.

Although we have received the "breath" and life of God through the sacraments, Pope Francis cautions us not to turn into "spiritual mummies" and "vagabond Christians". The Holy Father says that "spiritual mummies stray from the path of Christian life by choosing to stand still not doing evil, but not doing good." Similarly, "vagabond Christians are those who walk around aimlessly in circles and are easily distracted by worldly vanities."

On this feast of Pentecost let us ask the Holy Spirit to breathe new life in us so that we never become spiritual mummies but instead progress forward by seeking and doing the will of God, continually studying our faith, and praying and serving God in others.

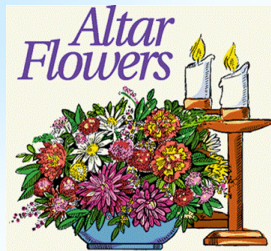

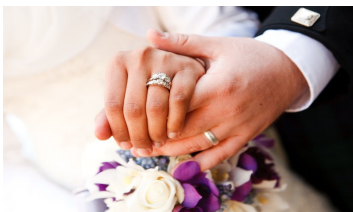

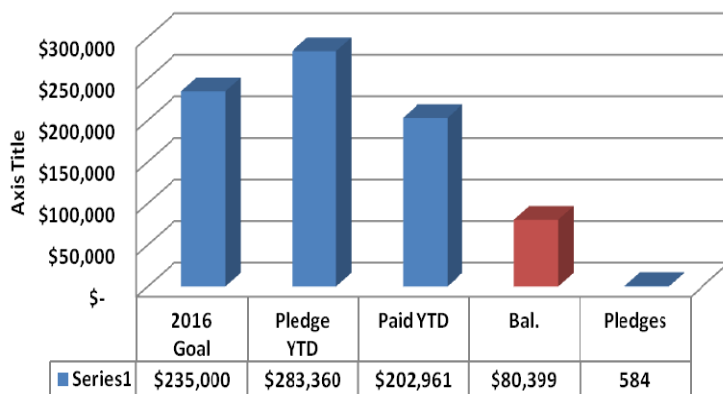
