Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Adults requesting information about full initiation and communion with the Roman Catholic Church (the sacraments of Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation) may contact the Faith Formation office at (949) 496-6011.

Sacrament of Matrimony

The Sacrament presumes active sacramental participation on the part of one or both persons. Couples must begin preparation for their Sacrament at least six months prior to their proposed wedding date. Please visit our website for information and forms or call the Parish office.

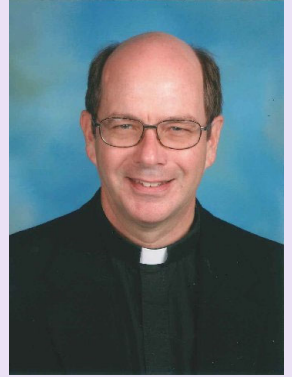

The Golden Rule

“Whatever you wish that men would do to you, do so to them” (Mt. 7:12) Jesus says these words in the Sermon on the Mount; however, the principle contained in these words goes back for centuries before Jesus. The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* calls it the “Golden Rule” (in paragraph 1789) and says that this rule applies “in every case.”



It is a simple rule to understand, but it is not always easy to apply. It does not tell us to be good only to those who respect us, or to be good only to those whom we respect. Rather, it obliges us to be good to all. And since the Golden Rule applies *in every case*, it obliges us not only to act well, but also to speak well and think well with regard to others.

How the world would be transformed if everyone followed the Golden Rule! No more unkindness, no more gossip, no more resentment, no more lack of charity! Each of us is called to examine how well we follow this fundamental moral law. Let's continue to do our best to make our parish a home for this special type of universal love.

La Regla de Oro

“Todo lo que ustedes desearían de los demás, háganlo con ellos: (Mateo 7:12) Jesús dice estas palabras en el Sermón del Monte; sin embargo, el principio contenido en estas palabras se remonta durante siglos antes de Jesús. El Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica lo llama la “Regla de Oro” (en el párrafo 1789) y dice que esta regla se aplica “en todos los casos”.

Es una regla simple de entender, pero no siempre es fácil de aplicar. No nos dice que seamos buenos solo con aquellos que nos respetan, o que seamos buenos solo con aquellos a quienes respetamos. Más bien, nos obliga a ser buenos con todos. Y dado que la Regla de Oro se aplica en todos los casos, nos obliga no solo a actuar bien, sino también a hablar bien y pensar bien con respecto a los demás.

¡Cómo se transformaría el mundo si todos siguieran la Regla de Oro! ¡No más crueldad, no más chismes, no más resentimiento, no más falta de caridad! Cada uno de nosotros está llamado a examinar qué tan bien seguimos esta ley moral fundamental. Sigamos haciendo nuestro mejor esfuerzo para hacer de nuestra parroquia un hogar especial de amor universal.

MAKERSPACE: A HUB FOR CREATIVITY & EXPLORATION

Never a day goes by where students in the Monarch Makerspace aren't collaborating, engineering, designing, exploring, building and creating. The Makerspace is a center for imagination, promoting resiliency, experimentation and creativity which many times supports curriculum they are already studying in other classes. Recent projects this year include:

- * Kindergarten learners explored color mixing after reading *The Dot*. Learners used primary colors, coffee filters, and water to create a rainbow dot in the likeness of the book.
- * 1st grade is building with different types of materials and experimenting with different types of attachments, like using Makedo tools to practice using screwdrivers, screws, and saws.
- * 3rd grade recently completed their "Hanger Re-Invention" design challenge. They used the engineering and design process to invent a new use for a metal coat hanger. Inventing is hard, and not everything turns out the way you would like, but there is always an opportunity to improve!
- * Every aspect of STREAM is used in the 4th grade "string art" spider webs! Learners researched spider webs, measured out and drew web templates, painted their wood bases, and recently began hammering nails in preparation for web spinning.
- * 5th grade will soon construct a portable solar oven that can harness enough heat to make s'mores.
- * The 6th grade semester project is to invent a new board game. Learners must decide on a board game type and theme then create all aspects of their game including game rules, cards, the board and pieces. At the end of the semester they will have a board game party!
