At the same time, we must remember that we won't be able to "hit the ground running" the day we move. It will take time to arrange things and settle in; also, contractors will still be

finishing up various aspects of the project. For this reason, I have urged the parish staff to maintain three important dispositions. First, we must be patient, knowing that the project is not complete yet. Second, we must be grateful: grateful to God for the great blessing of our new facility, and grateful to every parishioner who has contributed to it. Third, we must be positive; change is always challenging, and when we are challenged, it will be important to be positive about this new chapter in the life of the parish.

I encourage all of you to maintain the same three dispositions regarding our new Pastoral Center and Knight Hall: be patient, be grateful, and be positive. Remember, this project was in the planning stages for more than twenty years. We are blessed to see this long-time dream finally coming true. It will be worth the time it takes to finish up the details and get settled.

In the meantime, I would like you to save an important date: on Saturday, November 19th, Bishop Vann will celebrate the 5:30 pm Mass, and immediately after Mass he will bless the new Pastoral Center and Knight Hall.Following the blessing, there will be a reception and open house. The next day, Sunday, November 20th, we will continue to have open house after all Masses. What an exciting time to be a parishioner at St. Edward the Confessor and San Felipe de Jesús!
