

### Lift High the Cross

When the old Knight Hall was dismantled to make room for our new Pastoral Center and new Knight Hall, several things were saved. From inside the hall, we kept the crucifix and the statues of Mary and Joseph. They will go in the prayer room of the new Pastoral Center. From the roof of the old Knight Hall, we saved the cross, which identified the building as a church for years before our present church was constructed. The cross remained on top of Knight Hall after it ceased to be a church, since it was still a center of Catholic devotions, instruction, and other activities.

This cross will be placed in the tower on the corner of the new Pastoral Center and Knight Hall. We carefully chose the date when this will take place: this coming Wednesday, September 14, which is the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. The placement of the cross will take place after the 8:15 am Mass; if you are able to attend, it will be a historical and memorable event to witness.

Think of the sacraments that took place under that cross! So many Masses, Baptisms, First Communions, Reconciliations, Confirmations, Weddings, and Funerals! And thousands of people looked to that cross as their destination: not only the building beneath it, but also the salvation it signifies. "Far be it from me to glory except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ." (Gal.6:14)

### Levanta en Alto la Cruz

Cuando se hiso la demolición del salón Knight Hall, se salvaron varios artículos religiosos. Del interior del salón conservamos el crucifijo y las imágenes de María y José. Estas se colocarán en la sala de oración del nuevo Centro Pastoral. Del techo del antiguo Knight Hall, guardamos la cruz que identificaba el edificio como iglesia durante muchos años antes de que se construyera la iglesia actual. La cruz permaneció en la parte superior de Knight Hall después de que dejó de ser iglesia, ya que todavía era un lugar de devoción, instrucción y de otras actividades católicas.

Esta cruz se colocará en la esquina superior del nuevo Centro Pastoral y Knight Hall. Every human life, including unborn human life, is unique and unrepeatable, a person with inherent dignity and an eternal destiny. The intentional taking of any innocent human life is a grave moral evil, and people of faith and goodwill have an obligation to protect human life and oppose all attacks against human life and dignity. In CA this year, voters are faced with a choice to keep abortion law in our state as it is or to vote in favor of a new constitutional amendment that would permanently expand and vastly increase abortions in our state, without doing anything to give vulnerable women a real choice.

California law currently allows abortion for any reason up to viability (around 24 weeks of pregnancy) and late-term abortion to protect the life or health of the mother. Recent court decisions do not change that reality in California.

This year, our governor and legislative leaders have vowed to make California an "abortion sanctuary." They are making good on their promise through 20 bills expanding access to abortion and by allocating \$200 million in the state budget to pay for abortions for women in California and those seeking abortion from out of state.


The California Legislature put Proposition 1 on the November ballot. Proposition 1 would amend the California Constitution to establish a right to reproductive freedom, which is defined to include a right to an abortion and to choose or refuse contraceptives. The amendment states, "The state shall not deny or interfere with an individual's reproductive freedom in their most intimate decisions, which includes their fundamental right to choose to have an abortion and their fundamental right to choose or refuse contraceptives. This would remove the current ban on Abortion in California after 24 weeks, and could allow for taxpayer-funded abortion up until birth.

A "no" vote on Proposition 1 keeps existing California law on abortion the way it is now.






